**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers beat the Angels last night, 5-2, and have a 3-2 record entering the finale of this 6-game, 7-day homestand against BOS (1-2) and LAA (2-0) leading up to the All-Star break...the Rangers have won 3 straight, just 4th win streak of 3+ G in 2017, longest since 5 in a row from 6/9-13...Texas has still lost 6 of 10, 7 of 12, and 11 of 20...club is still 16-12 (.571) since 6/9, 5th-best in the A.L. in that stretch and T9th-best in MLB...Texas has won 17 of 30 and 30 of 54...club has a 38-34 (.528) record beginning 4/20, 4th-best in A.L., this after opening the year at 5-10.

- At 43-44 (.494), Rangers are 8th in the A.L. in winning percentage...club is under .500 for the 10th straight day, this after a .500-or-better record on 6 of the 7 previous days...Texas has had a winning record on just 3 occasions in the last 45 days, last 39-38 on 6/27...club was 53-34/54-34 in '16.
- Team could reach .500 with a win today for 1st time since 6/28 (39-39)...club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21), and was a 2017 high 7 games under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...season best 10-G win streak 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history...the Rangers are now 5-3-2 in their last 10 overall series after winning this series.

**BREAK 'EM OFF:** Rangers enter today with a chance for a Washington/Texas franchise first: a win pct. of exactly .500 at the All-Star break...last time to be under .500 at the break was 2015 (42-46), when club came back to win the West.

- Rangers have not won all games of a series leading up to the AS break since July 7-10, 2011 vs. OAK (4-0), which was part of a 12-game win streak spanning the break that year...prior to this weekend, 2011 was also the last year the Rangers had posted even a series win ahead of the break, and it was also the last pre-break winning homestand (7-0 in 2011).
- TEX has won all games of a series 5 times in '17: 4/20-23 vs. KC (4-0), 5/10-11 vs. SD (2-0), 5/12-14 vs. OAK (3-0), 5/16-18 vs. PHI (3-0), 6/9-11 at WAS (3-0).

**IN THE STANDINGS:** The Rangers moved into 2nd place in the A.L. West with last night's win, this after club was in 4th place as recently as a loss Tues. vs. BOS...days in each position in 2017 (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-28, 3rd-25, 4th-31, 5th-13...Texas has gained ground in the A.L. West just 3x in the last 21 days, currently 15.5 games back...season-high 17.0-G deficit both Tues./Wed., team's greatest at any point since end of the 2014 season (21.0 GB)...The Rangers are still just 2.0 GB of a wild card spot in the A.L.

**AT HOME:** The Rangers have won 3 straight at Globe Life Park, this after the club dropped 5 of its previous 7 games in Arlington...Texas has still lost 10 of last 18 at home, going 9-11 in home games since 5/29 after opening year w/ a 16-8 record in Arlington...that season-opening span included an 8-0 homestand from 5/10-18, just 2nd undefeated homestand of 7+ G in Rangers history (also 8-0, 5/20-29/05)...club's 25-19 (.568) record ranks 6th in the A.L...Texas ranks 2nd in A.L. w/ both 249 R and 5.66 R/G (NYY: 251/5.98).

**VS. LOS ANGELES-AL:** Rangers are 5-3 vs. Halos in '17, winning 2 of teams' 3 series to begin the year...Texas won series 4/11-13 at LAA (2-1) and lost series 4/28-30 in Arlington (1-2)...have won 5 of last 7 since dropping 1st meeting of '17...team is now 6-2-1 in 9 series vs. Halos in 2016-17...Texas has won 9 of last 14 meetings after a 2-5 span, but is just 27-38 overall since start of 2014 after posting a 15-4 mark in 2013...season series win in 2016 (10-9) was 1st since 2013...club has won 4 of 5 series in Arlington in 2016-17, but is just 13-21 in home games vs. LAA since start of 2014...Angels lead all-time series 365-338, but Rangers have leads of 186-170 in Arlington and 104-98 at GLPIA.

**KANSAS CITY, HERE I COME:** Rangers will have an optional workout in KC on Thursday ahead of the 3-G weekend series at Kauffman Stadium following the AS break...TEX is opening 2nd 'half' on the road for a 4th straight season, matching a club record (2005-08, 1995-98)...will be 1st time to ever face the Royals in 1st series after the All-Star break.

**THE CLIMB:** Adrian Beltre hit career HR no. 452 last night to tie Carl Yastrzemski for 38th place on the all-time list...he is also now 22 hits shy of 3000.

**THE LONG BALL:** With 2 HR last night, the Rangers have hit multiple HR in 5 straight games to match a season best (also 5, 6/24-28)...there have been just 5 streaks of 6+ G in MLB in '17, a high of 7 straight w/ 2+ HR by MIL from 6/25-7/2...Rangers' longest streak ever is 6 G, done 3x: 8/13-18/99, 6/28-7/5/02, and 8/2-7/05.

- Texas has hit HR in 30 of the last 31 games, and club's MLB-high 47 HR in 21 G since 6/17 has raised season total to **135 HR, 3rd in MLB** (143-HOU, 136-MIL)...it is also the **4th-highest pre-break HR total in club history** (147 in 2005, 137 in 2001, 136 in 2003).

- Both Texas HR last night came on the 1st pitch of the AB, this after a trio of full count HR Friday...TEX leads MLB w/ 41 1st-pitch HR in '17 (next is 34 by HOU), and Globe Life Park has hosted MLB-high 38 1st-pitch HR (next is 28 at LAA).

**SHORT ON SINGLES:** Last night was the 4th time in the last 7 G for Texas to have more XBH than singles...428 of Rangers' 707 hits (60.5%) have been singles, 3rd-lowest pct. in the A.L. to OAK (58.5%, 411/703) and CLE (60.4%, 463/766).

- TEX already has 3 G with 6+ XBH in July, this after 2 such games in each of the 1st 3 months of 2017...2 of club's 6 G with season-high 4 doubles this season have come in the Rangers' last 3 contests (Wed. vs. BOS, last night vs. LAA).

**DARVISH AND HALOS:** Yu Darvish enters today with a 9-2 record in 15 G/GS career against the Angels, having earned wins in each of his 1st 2 starts vs. LAA in 2017...he has more wins vs. LAA than any other opponent...he has also averaged 12.06 SO/9 against the Angels, the 2nd-highest figure by any pitcher against any club (15+ GS) since at least 1913.

**LONE RANGER:** The Rangers' lone 2017 All-Star, Yu Darvish, has been replaced on the A.L. roster due to his inability to pitch on Tuesday following today's start...it would mark just the 3rd time in Rangers history for a Texas player to not appear in the All-Star Game...the other instances came in 1972 and 2007...in 1972, Toby Harrah was selected but replaced by BAL's Bobby Grich due to injury...in 2007, Michael Young volunteered to A.L. manager Jim Leyland to be held back in the event of an injury or other circumstances in which he would be needed, and Young did not appear.

**SHORTS:** Last night, Drew Robinson posted 7th game by a Ranger in '17 with a HR and multiple BB...Rougned Odor has a career-best 10-G hit streak, T2nd-longest active streak in MLB (14 G-Eric Hosmer)...TEX has played 10 straight games without a save for either side, the 2nd-longest such span in the past 21 seasons (1997-2017) to only 11 G from 6/6-17/11...last night (0-for-8 w/ RISP) marked most hitless AB w/ RISP in a 9-inning TEX win since 9/23/12 at SEA (0-10)...TEX now has 11 pitchers w/ multiple wins (Ross-2nd win last night), T3rd in MLB (12-LAA/HOU).

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#11 Yu Darvish, RHP  
(6-7, 3.56)**

**TODAY:** The 30-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 19th start of the season this afternoon in the final game before the All-Star break...has 3 lost straight for just the 3rd time in his career (career-high is 4 straight, 8/30-9/14/13)...was named an A.L. All-Star for the 4th time in his career (also 2012-13-14), most for a pitcher in Texas history... will not pitch in the Midsummer Classic due to today's start...will be working on regular 4-days' rest after he took the loss in an 11-4 Texas setback on Tuesday vs. Boston... has gone 2-5 with a 4.44 ERA (26 ER/52.2 IP) in his last 9 starts to raise season ERA from 2.76 to 3.56, still 10th in the A.L....ranks among A.L. leaders in starts (T3rd, 18), strikeouts (4th, 119), opp. avg. (6th, .220), innings (7th, 111.1), ERA (10th, 3.56), and SO/9 (10th, 9.62)...has a club-best 12 quality starts in 17 outings in 2017, T3rd-most in the A.L....offense has provided 3 total runs of support in last 4 starts and 2-or-fewer runs in 6 of his last 7 outings...was the Rangers' Opening Day starter for the 1st time in his career this season...is seeking his 1st full season since 2013...returned in 2016 from 3/17/15 'Tommy John' surgery on right elbow...has twice been Rangers Pitcher of the Year (2013-14)...has averaged 11.07 SO/9 in his career, highest in ML history among starters w/ 500+ IP...his 931 SO rank 6th in Rangers history, 2 shy of matching Colby Lewis (933) for 5th place...Rangers are 8-10 in his starts and have lost 7 of last 8.

**ALL-STAR STATUS:** Ranks among A.L. leaders in starts (T3rd, 18), strikeouts (4th, 119), opp. avg. (6th, .220), innings (7th, 111.1), ERA (10th, 3.56), and SO/9 (10th, 9.62) opponents are batting just .202 (19-94) with RISP, 9th-lowest avg. in A.L....club-best 12 quality starts in 17 outings in 2017, T3rd-most in the A.L.

• Since the 2016 All-Star break, when Darvish returned from a DL stint for the remainder of the year, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 162 IP) in SO/9 (3rd, 10.65), strikeouts (T3rd, 232), opp. avg. (4th, .218), WHIP (6th, 1.13), and ERA (8th, 3.54).

**LAST START:** Took the loss in an 11-4 Texas setback on Tuesday vs. Boston (4.1 IP, 11 H, 7 R-ER, 0 BB, 4 SO, 1 HR, 88 pitches/59 strikes)...matched career highs for hits (11 - 2x, also 8/6/12 at BOS), runs (7 - 5x, last 9/17/16 vs. OAK), and earned runs (7 - 4x, last 9/17/16 vs. OAK)...was 7th time in 118 career starts to go 4.1 IP-or-less, shortest outing since 9/4/16 vs. HOU (4.0 IP).

**VS. THE ANGELS:** Is 9-2 with a 3.45 ERA (36 ER/94.0 IP) over 15 career starts vs. the Angels, including 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in a pair of starts this season... his .818 win percentage vs. the Halos is 5th-best all-time (min. 15 GS) behind Freddy Garcia (.850, 17-3), Steve Busby (.833, 10-2), Dallas Keuchel (.833, 10-2), and Mel Stottlemyre (.826, 19-4)...has gone 7-1 with a 2.82 ERA (22 ER/70.1 IP) over his last 11 starts vs. the Halos dating back to 9/20/12...has averaged 12.06 SO/9 vs. the Angels in his career, 2nd-highest all-time for a pitcher vs. a single opponent (min. 15 GS) behind only Randy Johnson vs. SD (12.07 SO/9)...earned his 1st victory of the season on 4/13 at LAA (7.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R-ER, 2 BB, 10 SO, 103 pitches/68 strikes) in the rubber match of a 3-game series...threw 125 pitches in club's 6-3 victory on 4/29 vs. LAA (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER, 4 BB, 10 SO, 0 HR, 125 pitches/73 strikes...Rangers are 12-3 in his 15 starts vs. the Angels.

**AT GLOBE LIFE PARK:** Has gone 3-4 with a 4.57 ERA (31 ER/61.0 IP) in 10 G/GS this season in Arlington, quality starts in 6 of 10...home ERA is over 2 full runs higher than road ERA figure (2.32)...has lost 3 of last 4 home starts, with a 7.48 ERA (18 ER/21.2 IP) over that span...opponents are batting .241/.302/.431/.733 at GLPIA compared to .191/.276/.287/.563 away from Arlington.

**RISP MANAGEMENT:** Opponents are 12-for-30 (.400) w/RISP over his last 4 starts, including 6-for-9 by the Red Sox on Tuesday...his .202 (19-94) opp. avg. with RISP is still 9th-lowest in A.L....an infield single by SD's Matt Szczur on 5/10 ended a string of holding opponents to 0-for-36 with RISP dating to Sept. 2016...the 0-for-36 w/ RISP span set a club record, surpassing an 0-for-35 w/ RISP run by Charlie Hough in '89 (credit STATS LLC)...was also the longest streak in MLB at the time.

**BY THE NUMBERS:** Has issued 37 BB, T11th-most in A.L., and 8 wild pitches are T3rd-most in the A.L....has 10 GDPs this season, this after 10 GDP induced over 39 GS from 2014-16...2 GDPs last 9 G, 3 in last 11 G...opponents batting .132 (32-243) in counts w/ 2 strikes w/ 9 XBH (6 2B, 3 HR)...batters leading off an inning: .129 (13-101) w/ 11 BB and 35 SO...opposition batting .172 (25-145) in 1st PA; .270 (40-148) in 2nd PA; .223 (25-112) in 3rd PA; 0-for-5 in 4th PA...Lucroy has caught 8 starts (3.08 ERA), and Chirinos (3.94 ERA) has caught 10 total starts - including 7 straight from 5/16-6/18...has allowed 24 of his 45 runs overall this season on home runs...allowed a 3-R HR in back-to-back starts on 5/27 at TOR (Bautista) and 6/2 vs. HOU (Correa) to account for his only runs allowed in those 2 defeats...prior to those outings, had allowed just 2 3-R HR in his 1st 110 career starts (has never allowed a grand slam)...retired 15 of final 16 BF in win on 4/23 vs. KC...threw 73.7% strikes (70 of 95) on 5/16 vs. PHI, 2nd-highest pct. of his career...outing 6/12 at HOU was 4th career start of 7.0+ IP, one-or-zero hits allowed - all against the Astros...only pitcher since 1900 whose 1st 4 starts allowing one-or-fewer hits all came against same opponent (credit Elias)...matchup w/ Masahiro Tanaka on 6/23 at NYY was 2nd time since 1893 for both SPs to allow no runs and 3 or fewer hits with at least 9 strikeouts.

**STRIKEOUTS:** Has averaged 11.07 SO/9 in his career, highest in ML history among starters w/ 500+ IP...next-closest starter on the list is Randy Johnson (10.61)...his 931 SO rank 6th in Rangers history, 2 shy of matching Colby Lewis (933) for 5th place... holds club single-month strikeout records for 4 of the 6 months (April, May, June, August)...has averaged 9.62 SO/9 this season, which would be his lowest figure in any season by nearly a full strikeout (current low is 10.4 in 2012).

• Finished June 2017 with 43 SO, T5th-highest June total in Rangers history, and Darvish also holds 1st (57 SO in June 2014) and 3rd place (46 SO in June 2013)...his 41 SO in April 2017 were 3rd-highest April total in club history, shy of his club-record 58 SO in April 2013.

• Has all 3 10-K games by Rangers in 2017...since the start of 2012, Darvish is T4th in MLB with 31 10+ SO outings, trailing only Scherzer (54), Sale (47), and Kershaw (42)...his 31 10+ SO games rank 2nd in franchise history (Nolan Ryan - 34)...fanned a career-high 15 on 8/12/13 at HOU.
