**Cha-Ching!**

**Jhoulys Chacin** is 4-0 with a 2.60 ERA over his last 10 starts (55.1ip, 16er).... opponents are batting .203 (40-for-197) during this stretch....the team has gone 10-3 in his starts this season, winning 8 of his last 9 starts.

**Phillie Phanatic**

**Ryan Braun** is batting .379 (100-264) with 22 HR and 62 RBI in 66 career games against the Phillies, including .397 (50-126) with 11 HR and 34 RBI in 31 games at Citizens Bank Park.

**Tremendous Travis**

**Travis Shaw** is batting .291 (25-for-86) with 7 HR and 19 RBI over his last 24 games....overall, he is among the National League leaders in HR (T3rd, 14), extra-base hits (T4th, 28) and RBI (10th, 38).

**Yes We Cain**

**Lorenzo Cain** ranks among the National League leaders in stolen bases (5th, 11), walks (7th, 37), and OBP (7th, .389)....he also leads all NL outfielders in assists (7).

**Friday Night Lights**

The Brewers are 25-13 (.658) in night games this season....only the Mariners have a better record in night games at 27-13 (.675).

**Hader's Gonna Hate**

The Brewers are 20-0 this season in games where **Josh Hader** pitches.... he has 69 strikeouts in just 34.1 innings, most among Major League relievers, while holding opponents to a .091 batting average (10-for-110).

**Not Joshing Around**

**Josh Hader** has struck out two-or-more batters in 19 of his 20 appearances, including each of his last 12 outings....he has made 12 appearances of at least 2.0 innings, including 5 saves of 2.0 innings or more and both of his wins coming in outings of 2.0 innings or more.

**Closing in on #200**

**Ryan Braun** is 1 stolen base away from reaching #200 for his career....he ranks third in franchise history in stolen bases, trailing **Paul Molitor** (412) and **Robin Yount** (271).

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Brewers are 12-7-1 in series play....won six straight series from 5/10-5/30: at Col (3-1), at Ari (2-1), at Min (2-1), vs. Ari (3-0), vs. NYM (3-1) and vs. StL (2-1). **Game 1:** 11-9, **Game 2:** 14-6, **Game 3:** 9-8, **Game 4:** 3-2

**AT HOME:** The Brewers are 18-11 at home, going 5-3-1 in series play....after a 2-6 start, the Brewers have gone 16-5 over their last 21 home games....the team had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 19-14 on the road, going 7-4-0 in series play....are 11-7 over their last 18 road games....the Brewers had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

**MANAGER:** **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (257-266) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 10 replay challenges, going 3-7....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/3 at Chicago-AL as an out call at second base involving Jonathan Villar stood....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #45 - RHP JHOULYS CHACÍN (13gs, 4-1, 3.39)

**CHACÍN AT A GLANCE:** Jhoulys Chacin, 30, is making his 14th start of the season.....Chacin last started last Saturday at Chicago-AL and earned a 5-0 win (5.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).....he has gone 4-0 with a 2.60 ERA over his last 10 starts (55.1ip, 16er).....the team is 10-3 in his starts this season.....he has made 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting .232 (59-for-254, 5hr)..... Chacin signed as a free agent on 12/21/17.....he is signed through the 2019 season.....his name is pronounced "yo-LEASE sha-SEEN".....bio is on p. 81 of the media guide.

**LAST SEASON:** Chacin went 13-10 with a 3.89 ERA in a career-high 32 starts with San Diego.....his 13 wins and career-high 153 strikeouts led the team.....he held opponents to a .235 batting average (157-for-667, 19hr), which ranked in the NL.....the Padres went 18-14 in his starts.....he had 16 quality starts, tying Luis Perdomo for the team lead, going 10-3 with a 2.05 ERA in those starts (105.1ip, 24er).....Chacin went 9-5 with a 2.93 ERA over his last 20 starts (116.2ip, 38er).

**CAREER:** Is 63-68 with a 3.90 ERA in 208 games / 180 starts (1092ip, 473er).....is in his 10th Major League season.....has pitched for Colorado (2009-14), Arizona (2015), Atlanta (2016), LA of Anaheim (2016), San Diego (2017) and Milwaukee (2018).

**CAREER AT MILLER PARK:** Is 1-2 with a 3.72 ERA in 8 starts (48.1ip, 20er).....prior to this season had not pitched at Miller Park since 2014.....is 1-1 with a 2.79 ERA in 5 starts this season (29ip, 9er).

**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 26-38 with a 4.23 ERA in 103 games / 86 starts (506ip, 238er).....was 4-7 with a 6.53 ERA in 16 starts in 2017 (80ip, 58er).....is 3-0 with a 3.83 ERA in 8 starts this season (40ip, 17er).

**CAREER vs. PHILLIES:** Is 3-1 with a 2.13 ERA in 8 games / 6 starts (42.1ip, 10er).....earned a 2-1 win in his only start vs. Philadelphia last season on 7/8 at Citizens Bank Park (6.1ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr)..... Chacin is 2-1 with a 2.57 ERA in 5 career games / 3 starts at Citizens Bank Park (21ip, 6er).

**CAREER AT THE PLATE:** Is a .189 (56-for-296) hitter with 1 HR.....homered on 9/20/13 vs. Arizona (2-run off Randall Delgado).....has 7 walks and 66 strikeouts.

**THIS SEASON:** Is batting .143 (3-for-21).....has not walked and has 7 strikeouts.....has 1 sac bunt.....**LAST SEASON:** Batted .222 (12-for-54) with 4 RBI.....did not walk and had 11 strikeouts.....had 7 sac bunts.
