Non-Roster

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In Postseason 2016 made 3 scoreless apps during the Indians' run to Game 7 of the World Series...in 2015 went to spring training with the Indians as a non-roster invitee but posted a 0.92 ERA in 32 relief apps, the lowest single-season ERA in franchise history and the lowest ERA among all Major League pitchers that year who made at least 30 apps...became 1 of just 12 pitchers since at least 1914 to record an ERA of 0.92 or better over at least 30 apps...was a Midwest League All-Star in 2007 and a Florida State League All-Star in 2008...5 times was a minor league Pitcher of the Week.

2017 SEASON

- Spent the season pitching for NC Dinos in the Korea Baseball Organization.
- On 2/7/18 was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract with an invitation to Major League spring training camp.

2016: While pitching for the Indians produced career highs in almost every statistical category...in July and August was disabled with tendinitis in his right wrist...in 16 apps after he returned from the DL produced a sterling 2.57 ERA...made 1 appearance during the American League Championship Series vs the Blue Jays and 2 apps during the World Series vs the Cubs...following the season was eligible for arbitration for the first time but became a free agent after he was non-tendered by the Indians...signed a contract for the 2017 season with NC Dinos of the Korea Baseball Organization.

2015: Went to spring training as a non-roster invitee but posted a 0.92 ERA in 32 relief apps, the lowest ERA in Indians history and the lowest ERA among all Major League pitchers in 2015 who made at least 30 apps...became 1 of just 12 pitchers since at least 1914 to have an ERA of 0.92 or better over at least 30 apps...posted a 0.79 ERA in 12 spring training apps and a 1.99 ERA in 23 apps for Class AAA Columbus before he was promoted on 6/18, where he spent the rest of the season...didn't allow a run in 28 of his 32 apps with the Tribe...posted a 0.86 ERA in his last 27 apps of the season, a 0.41 ERA over his last 18 outings and a 0.00 ERA over 14 scoreless apps to finish the season...threw at least 1.0 inning in 26 of his 32 apps and 13 times threw at least 1.1ip...posted a 0.64 ERA from the eighth inning on.

2014: Went to spring training as a non-roster invitee but made the Phillies' Opening Day roster...missed time on the disabled list with a strained right quad.

2011: Earned a spot on the Twins' Opening Day roster.

2009: For the Twins, made his Major League debut on 8/15 in a 7-3 loss to the Indians (1ip, 1k)...earned his first career victory in a 10-7 win on 10/2 vs KC.

PERSONAL: In 2003 graduated from Ronald Reagan High School in San Antonio, TX, where he was an All-American his final 2 seasons after combing to finish 22-2, 0.64 with 4 no-hitters, including a perfect game...over those 2 seasons posted a strikeouts-to-walks ratio of 7.9 and 9.0-inning average of 17.4 strikeouts, 2.2 walks and 3.1 hits...was a member of Team USA's 16-under and 18-under Youth and Junior National Teams, winning a gold medal in 2001...graduated from the University of Notre Dame, where in 2007 he earned a degree in economics and led the team in strikeouts (111) and wins (9) as Big East Conference Pitcher of the Year.
