NATIONALS NEWS

WELCOME HOME!

Following a successful 4-2 road trip to kick off the 2018 season, the Washington Nationals open their home slate this afternoon against the New York Mets...The Nationals are 3-4 in home openers since 2005.

- The Nationals went 47-34 at Nationals Park in 2017.
- The opening homestand will feature visits from the Mets (3 G), Atlanta Braves (3 G) and Colorado Rockies (4 G)

SPEAKING OF NATIONALS PARK

The 2018 season will be the 11th season of baseball at Nationals Park...Opening Day 2018 will mark the seventh consecutive Opening Day sellout in the park's history.

RIZZO EXTENSION

This morning, the Washington Nationals announced a two-year contract extension for President of Baseball Operations and General Manager **Mike Rizzo**, keeping him with the club through the 2020 season.

- "Mike's commitment to our shared goal of bringing a World Championship to Washington, D.C. makes this an exciting day for our family and the Washington Nationals," said **Theodore N. Lerner**, Managing Principal Owner of the Washington Nationals. "Mike and his staff have built quite a team—one that brings excitement to our ballpark every night and gives our city something to be proud of."
- "I'm proud of the progress we've made in Washington, DC, building the Nationals from nearly expansion status into one of the winningest clubs in Major League Baseball," **Rizzo** said. "I appreciate the Lerner family for giving me the continued opportunity to see what we can accomplish in the future."

BRYCE BEING BRYCE

Bryce Harper is 6-for-18 (.333) with four home runs, nine RBI, nine walks and seven runs scored across the first six games of the season...He ranks among National League hitters in slugging percentage (1st, 1.000), home runs (T1st, 4), RBI (T1st, 9), walks (T2nd, 9), and on-base percentage (4th, .517).

- From April 1 at CIN to April 2 at ATL, Harper reached base safely in eight straight plate appearances, clubbing three home runs and walking five times during the stretch...The streak was just two shy of the Nationals record of 10, set by **Nick Johnson** from June 18-20, 2009.
- On April 2 at ATL, he walked four times in addition to his three-run home run...It was his fifth career game with at least four walks...Since 2012 (Harper's rookie year), only **Paul Goldschmidt** (6) has recorded more games of at least four walks.
- With 430 RBI for his career, Harper is just two RBI shy of tying **Ian Desmond** (432) for second-most in Nationals history behind **Ryan Zimmerman** (938).

OFFENSIVE RANKS

Washington leads the National League with 36 walks...The Nationals are tied for the National League lead in home runs (12) while ranking second in runs scored (36), slugging percentage (.464) and OPS (.836)... Nationals hitters have struck out just 47 times this season, fifth-fewest in the National League.

STARTS AT THE TOP

Through the first five games, **Adam Eaton** is 9-for-21 (.429) with two doubles, two homers, five RBI, two walks and eight runs scored...He ranks tied for second in the National League with eight runs scored and also ranks among National League hitters in batting average (T6th, .429) and on-base percentage (9th, .478).

- He led the offense in Washington's 13-7 win on Saturday afternoon, going 5-for-5 with two doubles, a home run, three RBI and one run scored...It was his first career five-hit game and was just the second time in Nationals history (2005-pres.) that a player recorded at least five hits, with three extra-base hits and three RBI (Also: **Anthony Rendon**, 4/30/17 vs. NYM).
- On Sunday, he went 2-for-5 with a home run, two RBI and two runs scored...Saturday and Sunday marked the third time he's homered in back-to-back games, first since June 25-26, 2015.

DAVEY'S DEBUT

Prior to Tuesday's loss, Washington's 4-0 record gave **Dave Martinez** one of the best starts to a managerial career in the last 25 years...According to *Elias*, since 1994, Martinez's four-game winning streak is tied for the second-best mark for a first-year manager, behind **Clint Hurdle** (6-0, 2002 Rockies)...Martinez is tied with **Brad Ausmus** (2014 Tigers, 4-0) and **Jerry Royster** (4-0, 2002 Brewers) during this span.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 5 (3-6 on this date)

2006 — **Ryan Zimmerman**'s first career big league homer is a game-tying solo shot off **Billy Wagner** to lead off the top of the ninth inning. In extra innings, Jose Guillen hits a two-run home run to spark a five-run 10th-inning outburst. Washington's 9-5 win was their first win of the 2006 campaign.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager Joe Maddon's bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#37 - STEPHEN STRASBURG - RHP

Tall, powerful right-handed pitcher is a three-time All-Star who is Washington's all-time (2005-present) leader in wins (85) and strikeouts (1,295)... On May 10, 2016, he inked a seven-year contract extension that will keep him with the Nationals through the 2023 season...Is 80-42 with a 3.07 ERA in 173 starts since Sept. 6, 2011, his return from Sept. 3, 2010 right elbow surgery...When starting, Washington is 118-67 (.654) since 2010... Since 2012, he ranks among active pitchers in opp. SLG (3rd, .350), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 10.5), opp. AVG (6th, .224), strikeouts (7th, 1,127), opp. OBP (7th, .280), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.44), and ERA (8th, 3.12).

AGAINST THE METS: Faces the New York Mets for the 17th time...Since the start of the 2016 season, is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (12 ER/44.0 IP) in seven starts...In that same stretch, has pitched to a 2.18 ERA (5 ER/20.2 IP) in three home starts...Faced the Mets four times in 2017...Went 1-1 with a 2.96 ERA (8 ER/24.1 IP)...Allowed just one home run in the four starts (Conforto; 4/29 vs. NYM).

LAST START: Opened his 2018 season by tossing 6.1 innings while allowing one earned run as Washington topped Cincinnati, 13-7, on March 31... The lone earned run came via fourth inning home run by **Scott Schebler**.

2017 NOTES

- Put together a strong first half of the season en route to being named an All-Star for the third time in his career.
- Was a finalist for the National League Cy Young Award...Capped 2017 being named National League Pitcher of the Month in September.
- Ranked third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a career-best 2.52 ERA...Ranked second in the NL in FanGraphs.com WAR (5.6).
- Also ranked in NL in home runs per 9.0 IP (1st, 0.67), opp. SLG (1st, .317), opp. OPS (2nd, .581), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opp. OBP (3rd, .265), and opp. AVG (3rd, .204).
- Coupled with Max Scherzer (2nd, 2.51) and Gio Gonzalez (5th, 2.96), Strasburg (3rd, 2.52), helped the Nationals become the first team with three starting pitchers ranking in the top five in the NL in ERA in 21 years (since the 1996 Atlanta Braves), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*.
- On May 27 at San Diego, he struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 shutout innings.
- On Aug. 19 at San Diego, he returned from a three-week stint on the disabled list...He went 5-1 with a 0.84 ERA (5 ER/53.2 IP) in his final eight starts of the regular season following reinstatement...He racked up 63 strikeouts, allowed just 10 walks and surrendered only one home run.
- All told, went 6-1 with a 0.86 ERA in 10 starts after the All-Star break...Via *Elias*, it was the second-lowest post-ASB ERA in MLB history for any pitcher with at least 10 starts...Jake Arrieta had a 0.75 ERA after the break in 2015.
- Recorded a 35.0 scoreless innings streak from that first start back from the DL in San Diego (Aug. 19) that ran until Sept. 17, when an unearned run ended the historic stretch...It was the longest consecutive scoreless innings streak in franchise history (Nationals/Expos) and, per *Elias*, the longest for any player in the Major Leagues since 2015 (**Greinke**, 45.2 IP; **Kershaw**, 37.0 IP).
- Was dominant in the NLDS...Was saddled with the loss in Game 1 despite striking out 10 batters in 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, BB, 10 SO).
- He pushed aside a virus that had made him ill for much of the week, to rack up 12 strikeouts (re-setting his own Postseason franchise record for single-game strikeouts) over 7.0 scoreless innings in Washington's Game 4 victory.
- Became the second pitcher in MLB Postseason history to record a win with 12 or more strikeouts while his team faced elimination...Via the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the first such pitcher was **Joe Coleman**, who struck out 14 in a shutout to help the Detroit Tigers stave off elimination against the Oakland A's in Game 3 of the 1972 ALCS.
- Also per *Elias*, became just the third pitcher in Major League history to post multiple 10-plus strikeout games and no earned runs in a single Postseason series, joining **Sandy Koufax** (1965 World Series vs. MIN) and **Justin Verlander** (2013 ALDS vs. OAK).
