### FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a 10-game, 11-day road swing with the finale of this three-game set against the Arizona Diamondbacks today at 1:10 p.m. RHP **Dan Straily**, making his seventh start of the season, is facing Arizona for the third time in his career, going 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0 ip/3 er). The Diamondbacks are countering with RHP Matt Koch, who is making his first career start and appearance against the Marlins. Miami came into their current trip off a three-game homestand against the Nationals (0-3). Prior to that series, Miami completed a six-game road trip, going 1-2 against Atlanta and 2-1 against the Mets. This trip, which started in San Diego (1-3), will also see Miami in Arizona (0-2) and St. Louis (3G). The Marlins have gone 15-21 since April 24, after beginning the season 5-17. The Club has won eight of their last 20 road games after starting the year 2-8 away from Miami. The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

For the second consecutive night, the Marlins found themselves down 5-0 after three innings, eventually dropping a 6-2 decision to the Arizona Diamondbacks. Miami's first run came in the sixth, when **Starlin Castro** doubled to lead off the frame and was driven home on an RBI-triple by **Brian Anderson**. The second run came in the ninth on **Lewis Brinson**'s seventh home run of the season, his first career pinch-hit home run. **Caleb Smith** took the loss, surrendering five runs on five hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 4.0 innings.

### UP NEXT

The Marlins will enjoy the first of just three remaining off days prior to the All-Star Break tomorrow, then open a three-game series against the St. Louis Cardinals on Tuesday at 7:15 p.m. Miami, who went 2-5 against the Redbirds last season, split a four-game series in the Gateway City from July 3-6. The Marlins have gone 41-53 in St. Louis, and are 75-111 against the Cardinals all-time.

### TODAY'S TRANSACTION

The Marlins today optioned LHP **Jarlin García** to Triple-A New Orleans and selected the contract of RHP **Drew Rucinski** (#55) from NOLA. In 14 appearances with the Baby Cakes, Rucinski (Roo-sin-ski) has no record and 2.52 ERA (25.0 ip/7 er).

### ROAD REVERSAL

Prior to this season, **Dan Straily** had gone 19-20 with a 4.69 ERA (334.0 ip/174) in 62 career road appearances (57 starts). In his four road starts this season, he has posted a 1-1 record and 2.78 ERA (22.2/7). Among National League starters with at least four road starts, his ERA ranks 17th, behind league-leading Jacob deGrom (1.57).

### UNSOLVED MYSTERY

So far this season, Marlins starting pitchers have posted a 10-25 record and 4.55 ERA (296.2 ip/150 er). However, the rotation has allowed the fourth-fewest hits/9.0 in the National League at 7.92, behind Washington (6.99), St. Louis (7.57), and the Cubs (7.71). Additionally, the starting staff has allowed the fifth-fewest total base runners with 397, trailing the Dodgers (357), Philadelphia (379), St. Louis (392), and Washington (396). What's more, the staff ranks fifth in opponents average with a .237 mark, behind Washington (.212), St. Louis (.228), the Cubs (.231), and the Dodgers (.235).

### GETTING ON

Out of 58 games played, **Brian Anderson** has reached base safely in 48. He is tied with Bryce Harper and Trea Turner for eighth among National League hitters in games safely reaching base, and leads all NL rookies. Freddie Freeman has reached safely in 54 games, followed by Nick Markakis (52), Joey Votto (50), Nolan Arenado (50), Odúbel Herrera (49), Cesar Hernández (49), and Charlie Blackmon (48). Teammate Starlin Castro is tied with Trevor Story and Jose Pirela for 11 with 47.

### ROOKIE LEADER

**Brian Anderson** has appeared in all 58 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (216), runs (30), hits (62), and on-base percentage (.364); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (17); ranks second in average (.287), walks (20), and doubles (13); is tied for third in RBI (25), and triples (2); and fourth in slugging percentage (.394).

- Ranks second among National League players 25-younger in hits, behind Ozzie Albies (67).
- Owns three outfield assists in 29 G in RF - his first action at the position in his professional career. Is tied with Cincinnati's Jesse Winker for most assists among MLB rookies.
- His three assists are the most by a Marlins rookie since Marcell Ozuna (8) and Jake Marisnick (5) in 2013.
- Is on pace to record 105 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie. Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 42 first-half RBI, which would tie him with Jeff Conine for fifth-most by a Marlins rookie.

### THE CLOSER

On Thursday, **Kyle Barraclough** was named closer by manager Don Mattingly. For his career, Barraclough has recorded two career saves, with his last on April 18 vs. Colorado. Over his last 21 appearances, he has allowed just two earned runs for a 0.87 ERA (20.2 ip). For the season, he is limiting opponents to a .107 average against, ranking third among NL relievers, behind Josh Hader (.091) and Adam Ottavino (.092), while his 1.42 ERA (25.1/4) is tied for ninth.

### HITTING THE ROAD

**J.T. Realmuto** is a career .315 hitter on the road, and owns a .329 road avg. (213x648) since 2016, fourth-highest in the Majors over the stretch behind only Houston's Jose Altuve (.382; 283x740), Washington's Daniel Murphy (.337; 187x555) and Cincinnati's Joey Votto (.330; 226x685). As a team, the Marlins have posted the Majors best road average since 2014 with a mark of .260; Kansas City ranks second (.259) and Detroit third (.259).

### DRAFT INFO

The 2018 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place from June 4-6. Miami will have three selections on the Opening Day of the draft (7:00 p.m., ET, MLB Network & MLB.com), beginning with the 13th overall pick in Round 1. The Marlins will follow in Round 2 with the 53rd overall selection, followed by the first Comp B selection (69th overall) to finish Day 1. Miami holds four picks in the first three rounds of the Draft, tied for the second-most among NL clubs, behind only the Cubs (5). The intervals between selections during round one will last four minutes, followed by one-minute intervals between selections for the remainder of day one. The Draft will resume at 1:00 p.m. (ET) on Tuesday, June 5th, when selections will be made for rounds 3-10, with one minute intervals between selections. Day three of the Draft on Wednesday, June 6th will begin at 12:00 p.m. (ET), featuring picks in rounds 11-40, with no time delay between selections.

Dan Straily is slated to start the finale of this three-game set this afternoon at Chase Field. It will mark just his third career start and appearance against the D-backs.

Combined to post 17 strikeouts in 12.0 innings over his two previous starts against Arizona: on July 22, 2016 at Cincinnati (W, 6.0 ip, 8 so), and September 24, 2017 for the Marlins here in Phoenix (ND, 6.0 ip, 9 so). Combined for a 2.25 ERA in those starts (3 er).

Miami had won his first five starts of the season before he suffered a 9-5 loss to the Padres in his last outing, in San Diego on May 29 (5.2 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 4 er, 4 so, hr).

However, did not walk a batter against the Friars, snapping a career-long streak of seven consecutive starts (since September 18, 2017) in which he issued three-or-more free passes.

Allowed four earned runs in his season debut on April 30, but has allowed two-or-fewer in four of his five starts since, posting a 2.93 ERA (27.2 ip/9 er) over that span.

Has held opponents to a .224 average (26x116) with 12 extra-base hits (6 2B, 6 HR) this year, with 23 strikeouts (6.54 per 9.0), but has also issued 17 walks (4.83 per 9.0).

He made four Spring Training starts, going 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (14.0 ip/2 er), before being shut down with right forearm inflammation on March 20.

Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, going 1-1 with 8.22 ERA (7.2/7). Allowed seven runs (six earned) and five hits over 2.2 innings in first start, April 13 at Daytona. Limited Lakeland to one run and six hits over 5.0 frames on April 18. Transferred to Double-A Jacksonville and made 5.1-inning start on April 24 at Tennessee, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts.

Last season, set career highs in starts (33) and strikeouts (170), leading the starting rotation in starts, strikeouts, and innings pitched (181.2).

He went 5-3 with a 3.57 ERA (90.2 ip/36 er) in 17 starts at home, and 5-6, 4.95 (91.0/50) in 16 starts on the road.

Was one of just seven NL starters to make 17-plus starts at home, tied with four others for the second-highest total, behind R.A. Dickey, Zack Greinke, and Jon Lester (18 each). Among that group, only Greinke (2.87) and Patrick Corbin (3.15) had a lower home ERA.

Struck out nine batters on September 24 at Arizona, setting a new single-season career high. He finished the game with 167 strikeouts, surpassing his previous high of 162, set in 2016 with Cincinnati.

Had one of the best starts of his career on July 7 at San Francisco. He set a career high with 8.1 innings pitched in picking up his seventh victory of the season. Allowed just four hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four. He allowed just one run, a solo home run to Denard Span, the final batter he faced. From the second out of the second inning until there were two outs in the seventh, he set a new career high by retiring 16 consecutive batters, according to *Stats LLC*. It surpassed his previous high of 14, which he set over his first two starts of 2017 (April 22-29).

In his start on July 19 vs. Philadelphia, he issued three walks. It snapped a streak of nine consecutive starts with one or zero walks, which tied Justin Nicolino (2016) for the second-longest such streak within one season in Club history, trailing Ricky Nolasco, who did so in his final 12 starts of 2008 (overall streak reached 13).

In his start on June 16 at Atlanta, he struck out eight without walking a batter. He was the only Marlins' pitcher to accomplish that feat in 2017, doing it twice (also, April 22 at San Diego). He was also the first Marlins' pitcher to have eight-plus strikeouts and no walks more than once in a season since José Fernández did it four times in 2016.

José Ureña will make his 13th start of the season on Monday when Miami opens a three-game series in St. Louis.

Will mark his fourth career start and appearance against the Cardinals. He is 1-1 with an 8.16 ERA (14.1 ip/13 er) in those outings. Allowed eight earned runs over 4.1 innings in his start against them on July 29, 2016 in Miami. Allowed three-or-fewer in his other two starts.

Will be his second start at Busch Stadium. Other was on July 4 last season, when he picked up the win after allowing two runs on three hits, two walks, and a hit batter over 5.0 innings, with a career-high tying seven strikeouts.

After opening 2018 with 5.88 ERA (26.0 ip/17 er) over his first five starts. In his seven starts since then, he has posted a 3.53 ERA (43.1/17), allowing three-or-fewer runs five times.

Team has dropped each of his 12 starts this season, and 14 straight dating back to September 26, 2017. That is the longest stretch of consecutive losses in a pitcher's starts in Club history, surpassing Brian Moehler's former record of 12, from July 26, 2005 to April 28, 2006.

Was in line for the win in his last outing, May 30 at San Diego, a 3-2 walk-off loss.
