Three Straight

The Braves need to win three straight over Los Angeles to advance to the League Championship Series after losing both games at Dodger Stadium to open this series.

Dating to June 6, 2013, a span of 43 games, the Braves have won three consecutive games over the Dodgers once.

They won at Los Angeles on May 27, 2015, before taking the first two games at Turner Field, July 20 and July 21, 2015.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Dodgers continue their National League Division Series tonight with Game 3 at Dodger Stadium...The Dodgers have won seven of the nine games between the teams this season after taking the opening two games of the DS...In those nine games, Los Angeles has outscored the Braves, 44-18.

A The Dodgers beat the Braves, 3-games-to-1, in the 2013 NLDS, the last time Atlanta was in the postseason.

A The teams' first series came June 8-10 here in Los Angeles, with the Dodgers winning two of three... The clubs met again, July 25-29 at SunTrust Park, and the Dodgers won the first three before Sean Newcomb carried a no-hitter for 8.2 innings in the final game to help the Braves win, 4-1.

A Since the beginning of 2016, the Braves are 3-7 against Los Angeles in Atlanta...Over the last five years, the Braves have won consecutive games over the Dodgers in Georgia once: July 20-21, 2015.

A LHP Sean Newcomb tossed 2.0 shutout innings in relief in Game 1 and is set for his fifth career start against the Dodgers...The lefty carried a no-hitter for 8.2 innings on July 29 against the Dodgers in his last start against them, and overall, is 1-2 with a 4.38 ERA (12 ER/24.2 IP) against Los Angeles.

A RHP Walker Buehler beat the Braves in his only career appearance against them, tossing 5.1 innings and allowing two hits and one run, earned, in a 7-3 win on June 8 at Dodger Stadium...Over his last 12 regular season starts, Buehler went 4-2 with a 1.55 ERA (13 ER/75.1 IP) and a .158 batting average against.

TWO SHUTOUTS: The Braves were shut out by Los Angeles for the second consecutive game on Friday night, losing 3-0 to fall into a 0-2 hole in the clubs' best of five division series.

A The Braves became just the second team in history to get shut out in the first two games of the postseason...The 1921 New York Giants lost consecutive 3-0 games to the New York Yankees to open the 1921 World Series before rebounding to win the best-of-nine matchup, 5-3.

A This marks the first time in Braves postseason history they have been shut out in consecutive games...It also marks just the 20th time in history a team has not scored in consecutive postseason games, and the first time since the Cubs in the 2016 LCS (also, against the Dodgers...The Cubs were blanked in Games 2 & 3 before rebounding to win in six games).

A The major league record is three straight shutouts, done twice before and last by the 1966 Los Angeles Dodgers (by Baltimore, Games 2, 3, 4)...The New York Giants also shut out the Philadelphia Athletics in the 1905 World Series (Games 3, 4, 5).

0-2: The Braves are down 0-2 in a division series for the second time in 14 different series...They dropped the first two games in 2000 to St. Louis at Busch Stadium before losing, 7-1, at Turner Field to get swept.

A The Braves have been swept in three other postseason series...The Yankees outscored the Braves 21-9 to sweep the 1999 World Series, while St. Louis won the NLCS, 3-0...The Mets beat the Braves, 3-0, in the inaugural NLCS in 1969.

A Including best-of-seven series, the Braves have never come back from a 0-2 hole...They are 0-6 in such series.

NEED TO WIN: Since the inception of the divisional round in 1995, 55 series have begun 0-2, with 10 teams (18%) rebounding from that hole to win...The last club to do so was the 2017 New Yankees...The Yankees lost the first two games in Cleveland last season, before outscoring the Indians 13-5 over the final three games to advance.

A The Dodgers have had three 2-0 series lead in the divisional round and completed the sweep each time (2008 vs. Chicago, 2009 vs. St. Louis, 2017 vs. Arizona).

SKID: The Braves have lost eight consecutive playoff rounds (including the 2012 Wild Card game), dating to the 2001 League Championship Series against Arizona... That streak is the second longest in MLB history... Only Chicago (NL) owns a longer such skid, losing 10 consecutive rounds from 1910 through 1998...Credit to Elias for the research.

A The Braves last won a playoff round in 2001, when they swept Houston in the NLDS.

A They have also dropped four consecutive playoff games and eight of the last nine...Over that nine-game span, the Braves have been outscored 47-21.

THE POSTSEASON: This series will be the Braves' 35th postseason matchup in franchise history, and their first since losing 3-1 in 2013 Division Series to the Los Angeles Dodgers...They are 78-88 (.470) all-time in the postseason, despite having outscored the opposition 657-634 (+23 run differential).

A Prior to this season, the Braves played in 13 division series (6-7), 11 league championship series (5-6), nine World Series (3-6) and one wild card game (0-1).

SLUMPING: Dating to September 26, the Braves are 1-6 in their last seven games, and scored more than one run in a game one time (September 28 at Philadelphia, 10 runs)...Over their last 36 innings, they have scored one time and are hitting .124 (15-for-121) with three extra-base hits (three doubles).

A In this series, the Braves have zero walks and 15 strikeouts.

Tonight's Game

- A Makes his 31st start of the season and the 50th of his career.
 - A Went 8-2 and pitched to a 2.59 ERA (25 ER/87.0 IP) over his first 15 starts of the season...Among N.L. starters with at least 85.0 innings in that span, his ERA ranked fifth lowest.
 - A In the 15 turns that followed, went 4-7 with a 5.42 ERA (46 ER/76.1 IP)... His ERA ranked second highest among 54 National League pitchers with at least 70.0 innings in that span.
- A Set for his first career postseason start...Made his playoff debut with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief in Game 1 at Dodger Stadium on Thursday.
 - A Becomes the first left-handed pitcher to start a playoff game for Atlanta since Mike Minor did so in Game 2 of the 2013 NLDS, also versus Los Angeles... That start by Minor is the last playoff game that Atlanta has won.
- A Makes his fifth career start, sixth appearance, against the Dodgers...Is 1-2 with a 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP) and 32 strikeouts over his first five outings.
 - A Came within one strike of a no-hitter in his last start versus the Dodgers, July 29 at SunTrust Park...Chris Taylor hit a two-strike single to left with two outs in the ninth for the Dodgers' first hit.
 - A Newcomb's performance was the longest a Braves pitcher took a no-hit attempt since Shelby Miller also went 8.2 no-hit innings on May 17, 2015 at Miami...Miller allowed a first-pitch single to Justin Bour.
 - A Miller and Newcomb are the only two pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to lose a no-hitter with two outs in the ninth inning, according to research from the Elias Sports Bureau.
- A In 18 games, 17 starts, following an Atlanta loss, went 8-4 with a 3.35 ERA (36 ER/96.2 IP) and a .231 opponents' batting average...The Braves were shut out, 3-0, on Friday night.
 - A Newcomb's eight wins following a loss tied for ninth most in the majors, while his 3.35 ERA was sixth lowest among pitchers with as many starts following a team defeat.

2018 Recap

- A His 12 wins were second most on the Atlanta staff, trailing just Mike Foltynewicz... Became the first left-hander to win 12 games for Atlanta since Mike Minor won 13 in 2013.
 - A The Braves logged just 33 wins by left-handed starters from 2014-2017, tied for fifth fewest in the National League.
- A His 81 walks on the season tied for fourth most in the majors.
 - A Has 22 starts in his career in which he walks no more than two batters, and is 10-6 with a 3.53 ERA and a .295 opponents' on-base percentage.
 - A In 27 career starts in which he walks at least three batters, is 6-12 with a 4.55 ERA while opponents reach base at a .366 clip.
- A Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 8/23 at MIA, to defeat the Marlins 5-0.
 - A Went 4-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24.0 IP) in his four starts against Miami this season...Became the third Atlanta starter in franchise history to beat the Marlins four times in a single season, joining Tom Glavine and Greg Maddux, who both did so in 2002.
- A Held Miami to four hits and one run, 7/23 at Marlins Park...Stopped a season-worst three-game losing streak, and stopped a five-game skid by Atlanta in his starts.
- A Made 19 starts before the All-Star break in his first full major league season, going 8-5 with a 3.51 ERA and 97 strikeouts.
- A Set career lows in innings pitched (2.2) and pitches (70), 7/3 at NYY...Allowed a then season high-tying five earned runs.
- A Finished the month of May 5-0 with a 1.54 ERA (6 ER/35.0 IP) and no home runs allowed...Atlanta went 5-1 in his six starts.
 - A His five wins in the month were most in the majors, while his 1.54 ERA ranked sixth best in the N.L...His batting average against of .158 was the lowest in the league among qualifying pitchers.
- A Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a career-low one hit, 5/13 at MIA...The start was his third consecutive scoreless turn.
 - A Became the first Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to allow two hits or fewer and no runs in three consecutive starts.
- A Earned his first win of the season, 4/8 at COL, after allowing just five hits in 6.0+ scoreless innings...Did not walk a batter for the first time in his career.
 - A Walked at least one batter in each of his first 20 career games...Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two other pitchers opened their careers with longer streaks of walking at least one batter - Pete Smith (29 games) and Tom Glavine (27 games).

- A Selected by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim in the first round (15th overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.
- A Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with SS Erick Aybar, RHP Chris Ellis and cash considerations, from the Los Angeles of Anaheim in exchange for SS Andrelton Simmons and C Jose Briceno on 11/12/15.
