TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians maintain an 8.0-game lead in the A.L. Central, the largest division lead in the Majors...Tribe's 44-37 record matches the 2017 club's pace after 81 games, though this year's division lead is greater than last year's (3.0 games).
» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is 3-2 with a 2.39 ERA in eight road starts this season, holding opposing road hitters to a .196 batting average...he has allowed two-or-fewer runs in six of his eight road starts, tops on the team and T6th in the A.L.
» Cleveland has a 19-8 record in series finales this season, **including a 6-1 mark when facing a sweep in a series finale**, outscoring opponents 42-16 in those seven contests.

STRAIGHT A'S

» The Indians are in Oakland this weekend for their first of two series this season against the Athletics...following this three-game set, the Tribe will host Oakland for three contests at Progressive Field next weekend (July 6-8).
» The Tribe went 3-4 against the A's in 2017, taking three of four contests in Cleveland (May 29-June 1) and suffering a three-game sweep at Oakland Coliseum (July 14-16)...the Indians have managed just one win in their past 10 matchups here in Oakland.
» In the rivalry between the two original members of the American League, the Indians hold an all-time record of 1,032-911-11 (.531) against the Athletics.
» In seven series against A.L. West opponents this season, Cleveland holds an 8-14 record...with last night's series-deciding setback, the Tribe is 1-5-1 in series, with the lone win coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians fell yesterday by a 7-2 final score and dropped the series...Tribe loaded the bases in the top of the 9th but could not bring a run home.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** slugged his 20th homer, a solo shot that got the Tribe on the board in the 4th...two batters later, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** made the score 2-0 with a solo homer of his own, his 24th of the year...marked the eighth time this year the pair homered in the same game (third time in the same inning).
» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** went 1-for-4 and tallied the Tribe's only other hit, a one-out single in the top of the 9th.
» **ADAM PLUTKO** was saddled with his second loss of the year, surrendering three runs on five hits (one home run) in 5.2 innings, with one walk and three strikeouts...Plutko was perfect through the first four innings and allowed just one hit through five, before the Athletics led off the 6th with four consecutive hits and scored three runs to take the lead and chase him from the game.

TODAY'S TRANSACTION

» The Indians announced the following transaction relative to the active roster today: selected the contract of **LHP MARC RZEPczynski** from Triple-A Columbus and optioned **RHP ADAM PLUTKO** to Columbus.
» The 32-year-old Rzepczynski signed with the Indians on June 18 and has appeared in six games for Columbus, posting a 3.38 ERA (1ER/2.2IP) in those outings...he began the 2018 campaign with the Seattle Mariners before being designated for assignment on June 1 and later released.
» Rzepczynski was with the Indians bullpen from 2013-15, posting a 2.70 ERA (26ER/86.2IP) in 145 relief appearances, with 90 strikeouts and 35 walks...he appeared in a career-high 73 games out of the Tribe bullpen in 2014.

REHAB AND INJURY UPDATES

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** (right elbow contusion) made his first rehab start last night for Double-A Akron, throwing 58 pitches (38 strikes) over 4.0 innings and allowing one hit and one walk while striking out four batters...Carrasco has been on the 10-day D.L. since being struck with a line drive on June 16.
» **DANNY SALAZAR** will undergo exploratory arthroscopic surgery on his right shoulder tomorrow in Arlington, Texas, with Dr. Keith Meister doing the operation...the timeframe for his rehab and return to pitching will be determined after the surgery...Salazar has been on the D.L. since March 29 with right rotator cuff tendinitis.

Richard Palacios drove in two runs, going 2-for-4 with a double...Randy Valladares tossed 3.2 hitless innings in relief.

SUNSHINE SUNDAY

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is due on the mound to wrap up this series this afternoon...will make his 17th start of the season.
» Will pitch on extended five days' rest after taking his third loss of the year on June 25 at St. Louis (5.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 4K).
» Today will mark Clevinger's third career appearance and second start against the Athletics...last faced Oakland on May 31, 2017 at Progressive Field, taking the loss despite recording a quality start (6.2IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 2BB, 7K)...owns a career 0-1 record and 7.04 ERA (6ER/7.2IP) in his career vs. the A's.
» Clevinger has been solid on the road, compiling a 3-2 record and 2.39 ERA (14ER/52.2IP) in eight road starts...**enters today ranked T6th in the American League in road ERA, as well as T5th in the A.L. with a .196 road batting average against (min. 30.0IP).**
» He has held opponents to two-or-fewer runs in six of his eight road starts this season, the most of any Tribe starting pitcher and tied for the 6th-most such starts in the A.L.

FIGHT TO THE FINISH

» The Indians will aim to avoid a sweep this afternoon...Tribe has been swept just once this season in a series of two-or-more games (May 4-6 at New York-AL).
» Cleveland has a 19-8 record in series finales this season, including a 7-6 record on the road...Tribe has gone 6-1 when facing a sweep in a series finale, outscoring opponents 42-16 in those seven prior contests.
» **Tribe starting pitchers have posted a 17-2 record with a 2.27 ERA (46ER/182.2IP) across 27 starts in series finales, including wins in each of their last nine decisions.**
» **MIKE CLEVINGER**, this afternoon's scheduled starter, will be making his sixth start in a series finale...he has gone 1-0 with a 3.41 ERA (12ER/31.2IP) in his five prior starts, with the Indians winning two of those contests.

DYNAMIC DUO

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** provided all of Cleveland's runs yesterday, each hitting a solo homer in the 4th.
» With their respective longballs yesterday, Lindor and Ramirez now both have 45 extra-base hits this season, **marking the first pair of teammates in franchise history with 45-or-more extra-base hits before July 1**...also represents the first duo in MLB to achieve the feat since 2013 (Baltimore's **Chris Davis** and **Manny Machado**)...overall on the year Lindor and Ramirez rank T2nd in the American League and T3rd in MLB in extra-base hits.
» Ramirez enters today T2nd in MLB in homers, and his **24 longballs represent the most by an Indians hitter in the first half since Travis Hafner hit 25 in the first half of the 2006 campaign.**
» Lindor's 20 home runs extended his franchise record for most longballs by a shortstop in the first half of the season...19 of his 20 homers have come from the top spot in the batting order, which is the 2nd-most in MLB (Boston's **Mookie Betts** - 20).
» Lindor & Ramirez's 44 combined home runs through 81 games is tied with three other pairs for the 2nd-most by a Tribe duo in that span, behind **Albert Belle** (26) and **Manny Ramirez** (20) in 1996.

STARTING STRONG

» **Tribe starting pitchers rank 2nd in the American League (3rd in MLB) with a combined 3.38 ERA this season**...the club's 52 quality starts this season rank 2nd in MLB (Houston - 61), while they lead the Majors with 35 starts of 7.0-or-more innings.
» Cleveland starters have also struck out 522 batters this season (2nd-most in MLB) against just 123 walks (2nd-fewest in MLB), good for a collective 4.24 K/BB ratio that is 1st in MLB and is on pace to challenge the franchise record (4.15 in 2017).

MISC. NOTES

» Since June 1, the Indians' bullpen has posted a 3.41 ERA (27ER/71.1IP), which is tied for the 7th-best relief ERA in the American League in that span...Tribe relievers are holding opponents to a .202 batting average, which is T4th-lowest in the A.L. since June 1.
» Top prospect **FRANCISCO MEJÍA** has an active eight-game multi-hit streak for Triple-A Columbus, batting .528 (19-36) during the streak, which dates back to June 23.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1951: Hall of Famer **Bob Feller** tosses the third and final no-hitter of his career, tying the then-Major League record held by **Cy Young** and **Larry Corcoran**...Feller led the Tribe to a 2-1 win over the Detroit Tigers in the first game of a doubleheader at Cleveland Stadium, allowing one unearned run and striking out five batters while walking three in his 11th win of the season...Feller finished the season with 22 wins, tops in the American League.

TODAY'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to start this afternoon's series finale in Oakland...will mark his 61st career appearance and 48th start, as well as his 17th outing of the season.
 » Clevinger will pitch tonight on extended five days' rest after taking his third loss of the season in his last start on June 25 at St. Louis...allowed two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings (2BB, 4K).
 » Is due to face Oakland for the third time in his career today, making his second start...owns a career record of 0-1 with a 7.04 ERA (6ER/7.2IP) in his prior appearances.
 » Enters play today among the American League pitching leaders in opponents grounding into a double play (12, 4th), complete games (1, 14th), day ERA (2.12, 5th), road ERA (2.39, 16th), opponent slugging percentage (.352, 9th) and ERA (3.03, 11th).

VS. OAKLAND | A.L. WEST

» Clevinger is due to make his second career start (third appearance) against the Athletics this afternoon...owns a 0-1 record and 7.04 ERA (6ER/7.2IP) in his prior appearances.
 » Last faced the A's on May 31 at Progressive Field...recorded a quality start but took the loss as the Tribe fell 3-1, allowing three runs on five hits (two home runs) over 6.2 innings, with two walks and seven strikeouts...other appearance against Oakland came on August 23, 2016 in Oakland...tossed 1.0 inning of relief, allowing three runs on four hits, with zero walks and two strikeouts.
 » Today will mark his sixth start of the season against the American League West division...has compiled a 1-2 record and 4.55 ERA (15ER/29.2IP) in his five prior starts...his victory came on April 2 at Los Angeles-AL in his first start of the season, when he held the Angels to four hits scattered across 5.1 innings (2BB, 5K)...the two losses both came against the Astros, on May 18 in Houston and May 24 at Progressive Field.
 » Owns a 4-4 mark and 3.30 ERA (30ER/71.0IP) in 15 career appearances (12 starts) against the A.L. West...his 7.2 career innings pitched vs. the Athletics are his 2nd-fewest vs. any team in that division, ahead of his 6.0 career innings vs. Seattle.

RAY OF SUNSHINE ON THE ROAD

» Clevinger will make his ninth road start of the season tonight and has found success away from Progressive Field this season.
 » Has compiled a 3-2 record and 2.39 ERA (14ER/52.2IP) on the road this year...enters today ranked T6th in the American League (T10th in MLB) in road ERA.
 » **Is holding road opponents to a .196 batting average, which is tied for the 5th-lowest mark in the A.L. and tied for the 11th-lowest in MLB (min. 30.0IP).**
 » Has also limited opposing offenses to two-or-fewer runs in six of his eight road starts this season, which leads the team and is T6th in the A.L.
 » In 2017, went 7-3 with a 2.45 ERA (17ER/62.1IP) in 12 games (11 starts) on the road...owns a 11-7 career road mark and 3.28 ERA (51ER/140.0IP) in 29 appearances (24 starts).

LAST TIME OUT | 2018 RECAP

» Clevinger suffered his third loss of the season in his last start at St. Louis on June 25...marked his first career appearance against the Cardinals...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits, with two walks and four strikeouts.
 » Finished the month of June with a 2-1 record and 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in five starts...marked his 3rd-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 5G), trailing Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA) and March/April 2018 (2.56 ERA)...his 33 strikeouts in June are his 2nd-most in a single month, behind his 39 punchouts in May of this year.
 » **Fanned 10 batters on June 19 vs. Chicago-AL, recording his third career game (all this season) with 10-or-more strikeouts...**the Tribe pitching staff has 17 such starts this season, the most in MLB.
 » On June 14 at Chicago-AL, set a new career-high with 11 punchouts in the Tribe's 5-2 win (7.0IP, 5H, 2R/1ER, 1BB)...combined with his start on June 19 (10K), struck out 10-or-more batters in consecutive starts for the first time in his career.
 » Clevinger has also thrown 100-plus pitches in 11 of his 16 starts this season, which is tied for the 5th-most such starts in MLB...teammate **Trevor Bauer** leads the Majors with 17 such outings.
 » **Tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...**held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts...his two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since **Carlos Carrasco** allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).
 » Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season in the outing, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1IP on April 8 vs. Kansas City.

CAREER SNAPSHOT & 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» Clevinger is in his fourth season in the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College (FL)...acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever **Vinnie Pestano** on Aug. 7, 2014...added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.
 » Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by **Baseball America**...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).
 » Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA (31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.
 » **Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...**went 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).
 » Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.
 » His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...ranked 4th on the club in wins.
 » Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-86) batting average...became the first CLE pitcher since John Denny in 1981 with three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.
 » **Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.**
 » **POSTSEASON:** Appeared in relief in Games 2 & 4 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees...allowed two earned runs on one hit (1HR) in 0.2 innings (2BB, 2K) in the Tribe's 9-8 victory in Game 2 at Progressive Field...tossed 0.2 innings again in Game 4 in The Bronx (1H, 1R, 2BB, 1K), as the Indians lost 7-3...has no record and a 6.43 ERA (5ER/7.0IP) in six career Postseason appearances.
