TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** took the first of a four-game series against the Chicago White Sox...this was the first game for the Twins against a division opponent this season...in 2017 the Twins went 12-7 against the White Sox and 6-3 at Target Field...last season the Twins were 41-35 in their division...the three hits allowed ties the season low (3x, also March 31 and April 1).
- **JOSÉ BERRÍOS** recorded 11 strikeouts today through 6.0 innings...his 11 strikeouts tied a career-high (3x, last August 30, 2017 vs. CWS)...his 42 career-punchouts against the White Sox ranks most among any opponent he has faced...he has recorded six-or-more strikeouts in all three starts this season...this was his first outing of his career to record 10-or-more strikeouts and not allow a walk...he is the second AL pitcher to strikeout 11-or-more and not allow a walk this season (other Gerrit Cole of Houston on April 7 against San Diego).
- **JOE MAUER** (2-for-3) hit a seventh inning RBI-single up the middle off of Bummer brought his career-hit total to 2,000...he is the 3rd Twin to reach this milestone and the 7th in franchise history...has a hit in all 10 of his games to begin the season, the longest season-beginning streak of his career...has reached 24 times in 44 plate appearances this season.
- **BRIAN DOZIER** (1-for-4) doubled in the seventh extended his current hit-streak to 11 games...has a hit in 11 straight at Target Field batting .366 (15-for-41) in that span.
- **MIGUEL SANO** (1-for-3) doubled in the first inning, his seventh extra-base hit of the year...entering today he was tied for first in the category on the team with Eduardo Escobar.
- **BYRON BUXTON** (1-for-3) stole his 3rd and 4th bases of the season, extending his active stolen base streak to 28 and the team record...since July 4, 2017 is batting .339 (43-for-127) at Target Field...going into today's game this ranked sixth highest average in the AL in that span (Beltre leads with .379).

WHITE SOX NOTES:

- **THE WHITE SOX** dropped the first of four to the Twins...Chicago is now 11-20 in its last 31 games at Target Field.
- **LUCAS GIOLITO** made his third start of the season and second on the road going 6.1 innings...his five walks are a new career-high.
- **YOLMER SANCHEZ** recorded the first hit of the game for the White Sox, extending his current hit-streak to three (3-for-11, .272) and has now reached safely in nine of his 12 games.
- **TIM ANDERSON** hit a single in the top of the fifth inning has now recorded a hit in every game this season when batting 6, 7, or 8 in the lineup.
