TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Phillies play the final game of this three game series today...San Francisco shut out Philadelphia in the first two contests, marking the first time the Giants have recorded a shutout in consecutive games against the Phillies since Sept. 26, 1963 and May 19, 1964...the last time SF blanked PHI in consecutive games in the same series was May 11-12, 1960.

INSIDE THE SERIES: Despite dropping six of their last eight games to the Phillies, San Francisco has won eight of the last 11 games against Philadelphia at home...the Giants will attempt to sweep the Phillies for the first time in a three-game set since July 10-12, 2015.

PUTTING UP ZEROS: Giants pitchers have tossed 25.0-consecutive scoreless innings, dating back to the 3rd inning on Wednesday at Coors Field...the last time the Giants had starters throw 6.0-or-more scoreless innings in back-to-back games was Aug. 25, 2016 at LAD (Matt Moore) and Aug. 26, 2016 at Atlanta (Jeff Samardzija).

TODAY'S STARTERS: RHP **Dereck Rodriguez**, who will turn 26 years old on Tuesday, will make his first career Major League start and his second career appearance...made his Major League debut on Tuesday at Colorado and threw 3.1 innings, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits...he'll oppose RHP Jake Arrieta, who has posted a 5-2 record with a 1.96 ERA (10er, 46.0ip) in seven career starts against the Giants.

GIANTS VS. ARRIETA: Multiple Giants have struggled against Phillies' starter Jake Arrieta over their careers: **OF Andrew McCutchen** is hitting just .226 and his 63 PA without a home run are his second most against any pitcher...**C Buster Posey's** .056 batting average (1-for-18) in the regular season is his lowest against any pitcher (minimum 15 AB)...**IF Brandon Crawford** is hitting .125 (2-for-16), which is his third-lowest average vs. any pitcher (minimum 15 AB) (*Baseball Reference*).

HOME COOKING: The Giants have posted a 16-10 (.615) record at AT&T Park, winning each of their last four and 10 of their last 14 games...San Francisco's .615 home winning percentage ranks as the third-best figure in the National League behind the Phillies (.679) and Brewers (.621).

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Giants were 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position last night and are 10-for-their-last-49 (.204)...San Francisco's .231 average overall with RISP ranks as the third-lowest figure in the National League.

FIRST INNING BLUES: San Francisco has struggled in the 1st inning this season, allowing a total of 51 runs over their 58 games...the Giants have trailed after the 1st inning in 22 of their 58 games this season, the most in the Majors.

CRAWFORD AT THE PLATE: **IF Brandon Crawford** has 45 hits beginning May 1, tied for the second-most of any Major League player, behind Cleveland's Francisco Lindor (46)...Crawford leads all MLB with a .409 batting average (45-for-110) beginning May 1 and ranks second in OBP (.442) and seventh in OPS (1.051).

JUST SCORE 4: The Giants are 25-6 (.806) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 31 games, the Giants are 14-3 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-13 otherwise.

FEELING THE DRAFT: The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place tomorrow, June 4 through Wednesday, June 6...the Giants have the second overall selection on the first day, their highest pick in 33 years since they drafted Will Clark second overall in the 1985 draft...the Giants will be represented at the draft's headquarters - the MLB Network studio in New Jersey - by former pitcher Ryan Vogelsong and senior advisor of the Giants home clubhouse, Mike Murphy...the draft will begin tomorrow at 4:00 p.m. PT.

This Date in Giants History: June 3, 1973

The Giants rallied for four runs in the 9th to shade the Phillies, 5-4...**Dave Kingman** started the comeback with a single and **Dave Rader** homered...**Tito Fuentes** singled with two outs and **Gary Maddox** hit a 1-2 pitch for the game-winning homer.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez
6-1, 215, 25 years old (June 5, 1992)
0-0 Record, 2.70 ERA

- The 25-year-old is slated to make his first Major League start today...was added to the 40-man roster and subsequently called up on May 28...will turn 26 on Tuesday.
- Made his Major League debut on Tuesday at Colorado when he replaced **RHP Jeff Samardzija**, who left the game after 1.0 inning with a tight right shoulder...pitched 3.1 innings, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits...was removed from the game after being hit in the right shin by a 108-mph comebacker...was diagnosed with a shin contusion.
- Made nine starts for triple-A Sacramento this season, his first at the triple-A level...went 4-1 with a 3.40 ERA (19er, 50.1ip)...struck out 53 batters in 50.1 innings of work...his 53 strikeouts led the River Cats and was tied for ninth in the PCL at the time of his call up.
- Allowed 11 home runs over his nine starts with triple-A Sacramento.
- Posted a 2.87 ERA (12er, 37.2ip) over his last six starts with triple-A, all of which were quality outings.
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee and posted a 9.00 ERA (6er, 60ip) in four games (one start).
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.
- Went 23-25 with a 3.56 ERA in 81 career games (61 starts) in the Twins' system.
