**THE 11th HOUR:** Matt Carpenter's walk-off two-run homer last night was the 3rd of his career (5th career walk-off hit) and his 3rd career extra inning HR... six of Carpenter's last seven last-at-bat game-winning hits have come in the 11th inning (*Orf*)...the last time the Cardinals and Brewers played consecutive extra inning games was April 28-29, 2014 in which the Brewers won 5-3 in 12 innings (April 28) and 5-4 in 11 innings (April 29).

**CARDIAC CARDS:** Last night, the Cardinals became the first team to tie a game in the bottom of the ninth, then again in the 10th before winning in the bottom of the 11th in nearly four years...the last to do so were the Diamondbacks, against the Braves, June 7, 2014 (*MLB.com*).

**WAINO'S WORLD:** Adam Wainwright's 15 career wins over the Brewers are the most among active pitchers and ranks T15th all-time (**Bert Blyleven**, 1st, 23)... his 2.31 career ERA against Milwaukee ranks 2nd behind **Roger Clemens** (2.25), while his 198 strikeouts rank 6th (Blyleven, 312).

**THE O-ZONE:** Outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** began the season 0-for-8, but has hit safely in the next nine games and is currently T3rd in the National League with 15 hits. His active nine-game hit streak co-leads the N.L. with **Asdrubal Cabrera**.

**STRANDED!** Jordan Hicks stranded both of his inherited runners last night to give St. Louis a MLB-leading 30 total inherited runners, with an 80% (24/30) strand rate.. **Bud Norris** stranded the bases loaded in the 10th inning Mon night, marking the second time in a week the newly acquired pitcher has done so, both against the Brewers. Norris currently ranks 2nd in MLB in inherited runners with nine, trailing only former Cardinal, **Sam Freeman** (ATL, 10).

**SWING AWAY:** Marcell Ozuna is one of two MLB players to appear in 11 or more games this season and yet to draw a walk (48 plate appearances). The only other player is also in the stadium today, **Jonathan Villar** of the Brewers, who has yet to walk in 38 total plate appearances over his first 12 games played.

**HEATING THINGS UP:** Rookie relief pitcher **Jordan Hicks** has been lighting up the speed gun according to MLB Statcast. The 21-year old flamethrower currently has the eight fastest pitches in MLB this season topping out at 101.6 MPH (two-seam fastball) and has the highest average speed for a two-seam fastball (98.9 MPH) and sinker (98.9 MPH).

**PITCHERS WHO RAKE:** Cardinals pitchers have hit 10 homers off the Brewers of the 51 home runs they have allowed to pitchers in their history..**Adam Wainwright** and **Blue Moon Odom** (OAK, 1964-76) are tied for most of any pitcher with three.

**TAKE YOUR BASE:** Matt Carpenter has reached base safely in all 11 games to begin 2018, T2nd-longest active in MLB (**Marcus Semien**, **Freddy Galvis**, 12, 1st)...his multi-walk game last night was the 101st of his career, 11th-most in Cardinals history and four behind **Keith Hernandez** (10th, 105 games)...his 100 multi-walk games since his first full season in 2012 are ranked 6th in all of MLB.

#### MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Cardinals pitcher **Brett Cecil** and Brewers first baseman **Eric Thames** were Blue Jays teammates for parts of two seasons (2011-12).

Cardinals shortstop **Paul DeJong** graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) High School.

Cardinals pitcher **Carlos Martínez** and Brewers infielder **Jonathan Villar** were teammates for the Dominican Republic during the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Cardinals pitcher **Luke Gregerson** was a USA squad teammate of Brewers outfielders **Ryan Braun** (2013) and **Christian Yelich** (2017) during the last two World Baseball Classics.

Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** was previously a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder **Christian Yelich** (2013-17) and pitcher **Dan Jennings** (2013-14).

Cardinals pitcher **Bud Norris** and Brewers pitcher **Josh Hader** were traded for each other during the 2013 Trade Deadline (July 31, 2013, Orioles sent Hader, outfielder **L.J. Hoes** and a 2014 Competitive Balance Round A pick to the Astros for Norris).

Cardinals outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and Brewers pitcher **Jhoulys Chacín** were Rockies teammates for five seasons (2009-13).

Cardinals pitcher **Greg Holland** was teammates with Brewers outfielder **Lorenzo Cain** (2011-15) and pitcher **Jeremy Jeffress** (2011-12) while in Kansas City.

Cardinals manager **Mike Matheny** was selected by Milwaukee in the 8th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...played five seasons in a Brewers uniform (1994-98), where he made his Major League debut (April 7, 1994 vs. Oakland).

Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach for six seasons (2003-08)...oversaw a Brewers staff that ranked second in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, the lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (September 23, 2004).

Cardinals first baseman **José Martínez** recorded his first career Major League hit and RBI (9/8 vs. Milwaukee) with an infield single off right-hander **Ben Rowen**.

Cardinals Sr. Special Assistant to the GM **Red Schoendienst** played parts of four seasons for the Milwaukee Braves (1957-60).

Cardinals infielder **Greg Garcia** made his Major League debut against Milwaukee (April 28, 2014) with a pinch-hit at-bat (walk). Cardinals pitcher **Carlos Martínez** made his Major League debut (May 3, 2013) at Milwaukee.

Cardinals Director of Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB draft.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Brewers Bullpen Coach **Lee Tunnell** pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987...appeared in two games in the 1987 World Series.

Brewers Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for St. Louis (1995).

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

- Made his 5th career home opening start and took the loss against Arizona tossing 3.2 innings, his second shortest home opening day start (2012, CHI).
- His five home opening starts rank 2nd in Cardinals history behind Bob Gibson (6).

**CAREER**

- Ranks 2nd among Cardinals all-time strikeout leaders with 1,586, trailing only Bob Gibson (3,117)...his 146 career wins rank 5th all-time in Cardinals history.
- Ranks 6th among all Cardinals pitchers in franchise history with a 3.30 ERA and 8th with 1,895.1 innings pitched.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 238 career games, the most in Cardinals history (surpassed Bob Gibson & Tim Lincecum's 198 on 6/15/16) and the most for any tandem since Tom Glavine and Javy Lopez had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (*Elias*).
- Owns the most career wins at Busch Stadium III at 78 and has 3rd-lowest ERA at 2.82 (min. 200 IP).
- Has a career .650 home win pct. (78-42), 6th among active National League pitchers. The 78 home wins rank 2nd to Clayton Kershaw (80).
- His 3.30 career ERA ranks T5th (Max Scherzer) among active pitchers to Clayton Kershaw (2.36), Madison Bumgarner (3.01), David Price (3.20), Felix Hernandez (3.22).
- Among active MLB pitchers, ranks 4th in winning percentage (.640), 10th in wins (146), 20th in strikeouts (1,583), 7th in complete games (22) and 6th in shutouts (10).

**2017**

- Shared the team lead in wins (12) while making 24 appearances (23 starts) during an injury-shortened season.
- Was 8-1 with a 3.08 ERA in 11 home starts (64.1 IP). His .889 home win pct. ranked T2nd in the N.L. Was 5-0 with a 1.16 ERA (31.0 IP/4 ER) in five day starts at home.
- Was one of 12 N.L. pitchers to record perfect 1.000 fielding pct (37 total chances).
