MARLINS MINUTE

Miami is playing the first game of this three-game series at the Mets, their final series of 2018. Were swept in Washington on the first leg of this final road trip of the season, Monday-Wednesday. Miami is finishing up a 2018 campaign that saw them play the sixth-hardest schedule in the Majors, with opponents combining on a .512 winning percentage. Baltimore played the toughest (.529), followed by Texas (.520), Cincinnati (.515), San Diego (.515), and the Angels (.514).

- **RHP Jose Ureña** is making his team-leading 31st start of the season tonight. Owns a 4-5 record with a 3.55 ERA in nine career starts against the Mets. Will oppose RHP Corey Oswalt, who has combined to allow nine runs in 8.2 ip in his two starts against the Marlins this season - both coming at Marlins Park.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

The Marlins suffered the series sweep at Washington with a 9-3 loss in a rain-shortened seven-inning game. **3B Brian Anderson** went 2x4, driving in all three Marlins run with his 11th home run of the season - a three-run shot in the seventh inning. **1B Derek Dietrich** also had a pair of hits. **LHP Wei-Yin Chen** allowed five runs (four earned) in 4.0 innings pitched in his final start of the season.

JOSÉ'S HOT HAND

José Ureña is undefeated in his last six starts since August 19, going 5-0 with a 1.85 ERA (39.0 ip/8 er), 24 strikeouts and is holding opponents to a .165 batting average. Among Major League starters (min. 35 ip), his ERA is tied for sixth-lowest while his opponents average is fourth-lowest since Aug. 19.

- His 3.59 run-support average for the season ranks as the sixth-lowest among Major League starters (min. 28 GS).
- Only three Marlins pitchers have won five games in the month of September: Patt Rapp in 1995 (5-0), Javier Vazquez in 2011 (5-0), and Aníbal Sánchez in 2006 (5-1).
- His current five-game winning streak is the longest by a Marlins pitcher since José Fernández won eight straight starts from April 28-June 5, 2016, and matches his career high (May 23-June 23, 2017).
- Has won each of his three career starts at Citi Field, allowing just two earned runs in 18.1 innings pitched (0.98 ERA). Two of those wins came against Jacob deGrom (Sept. 1, 2016 and Sept. 11, 2018).

ROAD WORK

Several Marlins are among National League leaders in a handful of offensive categories on the road. **J.T. Realmuto** is T-9th in triples (3), ranks 10th in slugging percentage (.526), T-12th in runs (44), T-14th in RBI (44), T-24th in home runs (13), and 25th in average (.285). **Derek Dietrich** is 16th in SLG (.502), 20th in on-base percentage (.364), and 21st in average (.282). **Starlin Castro** ranks sixth in doubles (21) and T-17th in hits (79). **Brian Anderson** is T-17th in doubles (17) and T-20th in hits (78). **Lewis Brinson** is T-3rd in triples (4).

OH BOY, O'BRIEN!

Peter O'Brien has reached base safely in 12 of his last 14 games, with hits in nine of the contests. Has posted a .333 batting average (14x42) with three doubles, four home runs, nine RBI and six walks over the 14-game span since September 13. His .585 slugging percentage in September is ninth highest in the National League.

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (154), at-bats (582), runs (86), on-base percentage (.356), and average with RISP (.367); ranks second in hits (159), doubles (33), walks (60) and multi-hit games (45); ranks third in average (.273) and slugging (.400); ranks tied for fourth in triples (4); and ranks fifth in RBI (65).

- His 159 hits are the most by a Marlins rookie since Chris Coghlan in 2009 (162). Only Hanley Ramirez (185 in 2006), Jeff Conine (174 in 1993), Dan Uggla (172 in 2006) and Mark Kotsay (161 in 1998) have had more hits in their rookie season with the Club.
- His 86 runs are tied with Quilvio Veras (86 in 1995) for the third-most all time among Marlins rookies behind Hanley Ramirez (119 in 2006) and Dan Uggla (105 in 2006); His average with RISP is currently tied with Kevin Millar (.367 in 1999) as the second-best by a Marlins rookie in Club history, behind Miguel Cabrera (.375; 2003).

AGAINST THE METS

Miami returns to Citi Field for the second time in the last two weeks for this three-game series to close out the season. Miami is 6-10 vs. the Mets this season, but have gone 6-6 after the starting the year 0-4. Are 3-4 in Queens, taking two of three May 21-23 and dropping three of four Sept. 11-13. The Marlins are 98-117 all-time in New York, 40-50 at Citi Field, and trail the all-time series 205-225.

SIX F's OF FIELDING

The Marlins have committed just 82 errors this season, fifth fewest among NL clubs. Marks the fourth-fewest errors in Club history. Only the 2017 (73), 2015 (77) and 2003 (78) teams committed fewer errors. Miami's current .9857 fielding percentage is fifth highest in the NL and would go down as the fifth-highest in Franchise history, behind 2017 (.988), 2015 (.987), 2003 (.987), and 2013 (.986).

LEARN: TO TAKE INSTRUCTION

The Marlins' 2018 Instructional League team hosted the Washington Nationals Instructional League team on Wednesday in the first-ever Instructional League game at Marlins Park. The teams tied 1-1 in 10 innings, combining for a total of five hits. **RHP Jorge Guzman** (Marlins' #5 prospect per MLB.com, acquired this past offseason from the Yankees) started for the Marlins, fanning three over 3.0 shutout innings. **2B Christopher Torres** (Ox2; BB, SB), acquired from Seattle this past offseason, scored the only run for the Marlins off a third baseman error in the first inning. **DH Jose Devers** (#12 prospect, acquired this past offseason from the Yankees) went 1x4 with a stolen base and **Connor Scott** (2018 first-round draft pick) had a pinch-hit at-bat.

A LOOK AHEAD TO '19

The Marlins will open 2019 Spring Training with pitchers and catchers reporting to Jupiter on Feb. 13. The first full squad workout is scheduled for Feb. 18, and the first game is slated for Sat., Feb. 23 against the Cardinals. The Marlins will open their 2019 regular season campaign at home on Thur., March 28 vs. Colorado at 4:10 p.m. Miami's first homestand will run March 28-April 3, with the Rockies (March 28-31) and Mets (April 1-3) visiting Marlins Park. The Marlins will face off against the American League Central during Interleague Play in 2019, playing host to Cleveland (April 30-May 1), Minnesota (July 30-August 1), and Kansas City (September 6-8), and traveling to Cleveland (April 23-24), Detroit (May 21-13), and the White Sox (July 22-24).

➤ José Ureña will make his 31st and final start of the season in the opener of this three-game series against the New York Mets. Has won each of his last five decisions to equal a career-best winning streak, also done from May 23-June 23, 2017. The five-game winning streak is the longest by a Marlins starter since his own. The last winning streak longer than one of his own was by José Fernández from April 28-June 6, 2016.

➤ Over his last six starts, has allowed a total of eight runs spanning 39.0 innings pitched for a 1.85 ERA. In three previous starts, which included a one-pitch outing against Atlanta on August 15, allowed 10 runs in 10.1 innings.

➤ Has allowed just three runs over his last four starts, marking the best four-start stretch of his career in terms of runs allowed. His 1.13 ERA (24.0/3) in four September starts ranks third among Major League starters (min. 24.0 ip), behind Reynaldo Lopez (0.67) and Luis Castillo (1.09).

➤ In last start, September 22 vs. Cincinnati, held Reds scoreless on three hits and a walk, while striking out two, over 5.2 innings. Left game with a strained right IT band. Marked fourth consecutive start with just four-or-fewer hits and one-or-zero runs allowed.

➤ In September 16 at Citizens Bank Park against Philadelphia, allowed just one run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts, over 5.0 innings.

➤ On September 3 vs. Philadelphia, limited Phillies to one run on four hits, while walking none and striking out seven over 7.0 innings. Marked third career start of 7.0 innings or more without walking a batter; Sept. 11, 2016 vs. the Dodgers and Sept. 20, 2017 vs. Mets.

➤ In August 19 start at Nationals Park, tossed first career complete game and first by a Marlins starter since Edinson Volquez no-hit the Arizona Diamondbacks on June 3, 2017 at Marlins Park. Needed 108 pitches to complete the game, allowing one run on two hits and two walks, while striking out four. Was eighth complete game by a Marlins starter against Washington (since 2005), and first since Ricky Nolasco on September 9, 2012 at Nationals Park.

➤ On August 15 at SunTrust Park, made one pitch before being ejected after hitting Ronald Acuna Jr. According to *Stats LLC*, he was the first starter in the live-ball era to hit a batter on the only pitch he threw. The only other starters to hit the only batter they faced were Bob Shaw (1965), Scott Elarton (2001) and John Lackey (2009).

➤ Snapped streak of 14 consecutive home starts without a win on July 29 vs. Washington. Allowed just one hit and four walks, with five strikeouts, over 6.0 scoreless innings.

➤ Trevor Richards will make his 25th and final start of the season for Miami in game two of this three-game set against the Mets. On the season, has posted 4-9 record and 4.66 ERA (119.2 ip/62 er) with Miami. Has also made six starts at Triple-A New Orleans, going 3-2 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1/9).

➤ Has established professional single-season highs in appearances (30), starts (30), innings pitched (159.0), and strikeouts (159). He previously had 146.0 innings last season between Single-A Jupiter and Double-A Jacksonville.

➤ From July 8 to August 8, recorded six straight starts with four-or-fewer hits allowed. It tied the second-longest such streak in Marlins history, behind a stretch of eight consecutive games by Dan Straily from April 11-May 20, 2017.

➤ In last start, September 23 vs. Cincinnati, tossed 7.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts. Over three previous starts, had surrendered 16 runs (14 earned) and 16 hits over 11.1 innings pitched. The 7.0 innings equaled the longest start of his Major League career, as he tossed 7.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk, and two strikeouts in third career start, April 14 vs. Pittsburgh.
