## HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs are 22-14 (.611) since May 28, the third-best NL record behind the Dodgers (.676; 23-11) and Cubs (.629; 22-13).
- ♦ Arizona is 15-8 in its last 23 home games vs. Padres.
- ♦ **Zack Godley** has gone 4-2 in 7 starts @ Chase Field this season.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** is batting .384 (43-for-112)/.477 OBP/.768 SLG with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 11 homers, 28 RBI and 19 walks in his last 28 games.
- ♦ **Jake Lamb** has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games, batting .333 (18-for-54) with 3 doubles, 1 homer and 7 RBI.
- ♦ **Jon Jay** has reached base safely in 6 of his last 10 plate appearances (5 hits and 1 HBP).
- ♦ **David Peralta** has a 6-game hitting streak (.360; 9-for-25).

## LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- ♦ The D-backs lost the series opener vs. Padres, 6-3.
- ♦ **Ketel Marte** went 2-for-4 with a double and a home run and 2 RBI...**Jake Lamb** was 1-for-4 with a RBI.
- ♦ **Shelby Miller** suffered the loss after allowing 5 runs (3 ER) and striking out 7 in 5.1 innings.

## LÓPEZ NAMED TO MLB ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME

- ♦ Double-A RHP **Yoa López** (World Team) has been named to the MLB All-Star Futures Game on July 15 @ Nationals Park.
- ♦ López has gone 2-4 with 6 saves, a 3.38 ERA (14 ER in 37.1 IP), .187 opponent average and 55 strikeouts (13.3 SO/9.0 IP) in 27 games with the Generals...in his last 6 appearances, he has posted a 0.90 ERA (1 ER in 10.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts.

- ♦ Arizona is 11-9 vs. NL West @ Chase Field and 20-14 overall this season.

## LAMB FARING BETTER VS. LEFTIES

- ♦ **Jake Lamb** has gone 5-for-12 (.417) in his last 5 games vs. lefties, compared to a .143 average (3-for-21) to start the season.
- ♦ His .250 average and .337 on-base pct. vs. southpaws are up from .144/.269 in 2017 and .164/.279 in 2016.

## THE RIGHT STUFF FOR MARTE

- ♦ **Ketel Marte**, a switch-hitter, is batting .306 (33-for-108) with 12 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 17 RBI and a .909 OPS while batting right-handed.
- ♦ Marte's .909 OPS vs. left-handers is the third best among switch-hitters, trailing Francisco Lindor/CLE (1.042) and Aaron Hicks/NYY (1.001) and ahead of Jeimer Candelario/DET (.882) and Jurickson Profar/TEX (.881).

## MAC ATTACK

- ♦ **T.J. McFarland**, who leads all NL relievers with 54.1 innings, has posted a 0.64 ERA (1 ER in 14.0 IP) over his last 9 games.
- ♦ McFarland's 54.1 innings are the second most by a D-backs reliever before the All-Star Break, trailing Byung-Hyun Kim (58.1 in 2001) and ahead of Josh Collmenter (53.0 in 2013).

## GODLEY AT A GLANCE

- ◆ Fourth season with the D-backs.
- ◆ Acquired from the Cubs on Dec. 9, 2014, with RHP Jeferson Mejia, for C Miguel Montero.
- ◆ Cubs 10th-round pick in the 2013 draft.

## THINGS TO KNOW...

- ◆ His 9 wins this season are tied for fourth in the NL with Zack Greinke and Miles Mikolas/STL, behind Max Scherzer (10), Jon Lester (11) and Aaron Nola (11).
- ◆ Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 4 of his last 5 starts since June 10.
- ◆ Has gone 4-2 in 7 starts @ Chase Field this season.
- ◆ Last year was 3-3 with a 2.58 ERA (20 ER in 69.2 IP) and a .188 opponents average in 11 starts before the All Star break.

## LAST START

- ◆ Took the loss on July 1 vs. Giants, allowing 7 runs on 9 hits in 4.0 innings .

## VS. PADRES

- ◆ Is making his 11th career appearance (7 starts)...is 2-3 with a 5.23 ERA (24 ER in 20.2 IP).
- ◆ Has a won each of his last 2 decisions @ home vs. Padres since July 5, 2016.
- ◆ Earned the win on April 21 @ Chase Field, allowing 2 earned runs on 6 hits with 8 strikeouts.

## INSIDE THE NUMBERS

- ◆ Limiting opponents to a .200 average with RISP/2 outs (9-for-45). compared to a .270 average with RISP (26-for-95).
- ◆ 42 of 58 runs have come in innings No. 1-4.
- ◆ Opponents are 5-for-39 (.128) in an 0-2 count.

## GODLEY'S PLAN

- ◆ Is 8-2 when issuing 3 or fewer walks (11 games), posting a 3.78 ERA (27 ER in 64.1 IP).
- ◆ Has allowed 2 or fewer earned runs in 4 of his last 5 starts since June 10.
- ◆ The top of the order is batting .290 (37-for-128) while the bottom of the order is batting .169 (17-for-106).

## COOL UNDER PRESSURE

- ◆ Is limiting the opposition to a .241 average (41-for-170) with runners on base, compared to .302 (57-for-189) when the bases are empty.
- ◆ Has allowed just 8 extra-base hits with runners in scoring position (140 total at-bats).

## PLAYER PROFILE

- ◆ As a senior at University of Tennessee, in 2013, he led the SEC in complete games (6) and innings (108.1) and has second in strikeouts (98).
- ◆ Nickname is the "Bull" because his teammates at Tennessee called him that due to his demeanor on the mound and his sprints on and off the field.
- ◆ Is an avid bass fisherman...has accidently sunk 2 boats.
- ◆ Roomed the majority of the 2017 with Andrew Chafin in his 42-foot RV.
- ◆ Was an alternate on the 2012 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, appearing in 4 games.
- ◆ Married to Autumn.

## STAYING GROUNDED

- ◆ This season, has posted a 52.0 ground ball pct., the sixth-best mark in the NL and ninth-best in the Majors. (min. 15 starts).
- ◆ Since 2016, ranks seventh among all pitchers with a 2.44 ground ball to fly ball ratio (485/199) and ninth with a 54.1 ground ball pct. (min. 40 starts).

## 18+ OUTS

- ◆ Is 5-2 with a 2.29 ERA (13 ER in 51.0 IP), 49 strikeouts, 17 walks and a .214 opponents average in 7 starts this season of 6.0+ innings.
- ◆ Is 18-6 with a 2.65 ERA (59 ER in 200.1 IP) in 31 career starts when throwing 6.0+ innings (D-backs are 22-9).

## 2018 CURVEBALL INFO

- ◆ Ranks second among Major League starters by throwing a curveball 39.5 pct. of the time (652 total), behind only Lance McCullers Jr./HOU (44.8 pct.; 743 total).
- ◆ Has a 39.7 pct. swing-and-miss rate on his curveball, the second-best mark in the NL behind Jon Gray/COL (42.9 pct.).
- ◆ Totaled 68 strikeouts with his curveball, the most in the NL and third most in the Majors, behind Charlie Morton/HOU (81) and Lance McCullers/HOU (72).
- ◆ Opponents are hitting .209 against his curveball, the sixth-best mark in the Majors and second-best in the NL behind Aaron Nola/PHI (.187) [min. 85 AB].
