AT HOME: The Brewers are 40-26 at home, going 12-6-3 in series play.....after a 2-6 start, the team is 38-20 over its last 58 home games.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22 and a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 4/7-4/16.....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 36-35 on the road, going 10-8-4 in series play.....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11 and a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15.....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (296-302) and third full season.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach Darnell Coles (4th season), pitching coach Derek Johnson (3rd season), coach Jason Lane (3rd season), bench coach Pat Murphy (3rd season), third base coach Ed Sedar (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach Carlos Subero (3rd season) and bullpen coach Lee Tunnell (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 27 replay challenges, going 5-22.....their last challenge (lost) came on 8/30 at Cincinnati as a safe call at home plate involving Phillip Ervin stood.....went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

TODAY'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JUNIOR GUERRA (25gs, 6-9, 4.09)

GUERRA AT A GLANCE: Junior Guerra, 33, will be making his 26th start of the season and second against the Nationals....Guerra last started on Tuesday at Cincinnati and took a 9-7 loss (1.1ip, 8r, 6r, 6er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr, 1wp)....he is 0-4 with a 7.28 ERA over his last 8 starts (38.1ip, 31er)....the team is 12-13 in his starts this season....he has made 10 quality starts....opponents are batting .266 (135-for-508, 18hr)....Guerra was on the 10-day disabled list from 7/14-7/23 with right forearm tightness....he began the season at Triple-A Colorado Springs (1 start)....he was claimed off waivers from Chicago-AL on 10/7/15....bio is on p. 97 of the media guide.

YOU NEVER FORGET YOUR FIRST: When he was claimed off waivers from the White Sox on 10/7/15, Guerra became the first player acquired under GM David Stearns, who joined the team on 9/21/15.

LAST SEASON: Guerra, the Opening Day starter for the Brewers in 2017, went 1-4 with a 5.12 ERA in 21 games / 14 starts....the Brewers went 4-10 in his starts....he produced 4 quality starts....opponents batted .230 (61-for-265, 18hr)....he went 1-4 with a 5.20 ERA as a starter (64ip, 37er) and 0-0 with a 4.26 ERA in relief (6.1ip, 3er)....Guerra had a pair of stints on the disabled list, coming from 4/4-5/25 (right calf strain) and 7/9-7/17 (right shin contusion).

CAREER: Is 16-16 with a 3.87 ERA in 69 games / 59 starts (328ip, 141er)....has pitched for Chicago-AL (2015) and Milwaukee (2016-current).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 8-6 with a 2.74 ERA in 37 games / 31 starts (184ip, 56er)....is 3-3 with a 2.64 ERA in 15 starts this season (85.1ip, 25er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 8-10 with a 5.31 ERA in 32 games / 28 starts (144ip, 85er)....is 3-6 with a 6.75 ERA in 10 starts this season (46.2ip, 35er).

CAREER vs. NATIONALS: Is 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA in 3 games / 2 starts (14.1ip, 3er)....he received no decision this season on 7/24 at Miller Park as the Brewers won, 5-4, in 10 innings (6ip, 4h, 4r, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 1wp).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is batting .119 (10-for-84)....has not homered....has not walked and has 30 strikeouts....**THIS SEASON:** Is batting .061 (2-for-33)....has 13 strikeouts....has 2 sacrifice bunts.
