



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**'TWAS THE PENULTIMATE GAME** The Padres fell 5-4 last night opposite the Arizona Diamondbacks in San Diego's 2nd-to-last game of the regular season...starter **Jacob Nix** was saddled with the loss (finished the season with a 2-5 record and a 7.02 ERA), and he worked 4.0 innings, allowing 4 earned runs on 5 hits and 3 bb with no strikeouts... **Eric Hosmer** logged his 9th 3-hit effort of the year, going 3-for-4 with a home run, and **Javy Guerra** had his 1st-career RBI with his single in the bottom of the 4th.

**GETTING THAT LAST W** The Padres have gone 5 straight campaigns without winning the last game of the season (their last win in game 162 came on Oct. 3, 2012 @ MIL)... with today's matchup vs. ARI, it's the 1st time the Friars have ended their regular season @ Petco Park since the 2011 season (Sept. 28, 2011 vs. CHC).

**TURN THE TIDE** **Joey Lucchesi** is in search of his 1st winning decision vs. Arizona, having gone 0-5 with a 6.85 ERA against his desert nemesis...he has gone 2-8 opposite divisional foes, with a 5.06 ERA vs. NL West teams...has a 6-1 record against all other clubs with a 2.96 ERA (18 er, 54.2 ip).

**GRAB SOME PINE** **Joey Lucchesi** has fanned 137 batters this season, the 3rd-most of any rookie in 2018 behind LAD Walker Buehler's 148 and STL Jack Flaherty's 179... Lucchesi and **Eric Lauer** (100 so) became the 1st pair of Padres rookies to surpass the 100-strikeout mark in the same season since Bob Shirley and Bob Owchinko in 1977... SD rookie starters have amassed a total of 286 so, the 2nd-most behind MIA's 334 so.

**VS. ARIZONA** In tonight's game, the Padres look to claim their first series against the D-Backs this season, having lost 3 and tied 2 series for a 5-12 overall record in '18... SD's last series win opposite ARI came on Sept. 18-20, 2017.

**FIRST WEALTH IS GOOD HEALTH** Padre rookie pitchers have combined for a 1st-pitch strike % of 61.4, ranking 6th-best in the majors and 3rd-best in the NL.

**RAY GUN DEFLECTOR** Friars with notable numbers vs. opposing starter, **Robbie Ray**: **Eric Hosmer** (.375, 3-for-8 with 2 hr and 1 bb), **Jose Pirela** (.333, 3-for-9 with 1 2b, 1 hr and 2 bb) and **Cory Spangenberg** (.333, 4-for-12)...**Wil Myers** is a career .200 hitter vs. Ray (4-for-20), but his 9 bb against him are the most he's had against any 1 Major League pitcher in his career (owns a .455 OBP vs. Ray).

**2ND HALF** Since the All-Star break, Padres relievers have owned a NL-leading 3.35 ERA (95 er, 255.1 ip), while Padres starters have the highest ERA in the NL in that time with a 5.67 mark (192 er, 304.2 ip).

**SAVIN' RUNS:** The Padres outfield have combined for 19 defensive runs saved (DRS), the 4th-most of any NL outfield...the D-Backs' 38 DRS rank 2nd in the majors behind MIL's 51.

**GROUNDERS** The Padres own a 47.3 grounder% (on offense), which is the 2nd-highest percentage in the majors this year (MIA's 48.2 %).

**UP NEXT** Padres' pitchers and catchers are scheduled to report to Peoria, Ariz. for 2019 Spring Training on Wednesday, February 13, with the club's first full-squad workout on Monday, February 18...SD will begin its 31-game schedule with their 1st game on Saturday, Feb. 23, as the away team opposite SEA @ the Peoria Sports Complex...the Padres will play 31 games next spring in Peoria, including 2 vs. Arizona...SD will cap off its spring schedule with two exhibition games @ Safeco Field against the Mariners from March 25-26...the Padres will open the 2019 season at home vs. SF on Thursday, March 28, with a 1:10 p.m. PT first pitch.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (8-9, 4.14)**

**IT'S JOEY TIME:** 25-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make the 26th start of his career and 6th of the season against the Diamondbacks...is 0-5 with a 6.85 ERA (18 ER, 23.2 IP) in his five career starts against Arizona.

**LAST TIME OUT:** His last time out on 9/23 at LAD, he allowed a career-high seven earned runs in the Padres' 14-0 defeat.

- Is now 2-8 with a 5.06 ERA in his 14 career starts against NL West opponents...has a 6-1 record against all other foes.
- His current 4.14 ERA is the first time all season (besides after his first start) that his ERA has been above 4.00.

**THE 5.0 MARK:** He's worked at least 5.0 innings in 5 of his last 6 starts...Lucchesi has made 18 starts this season in which he's worked at least 5.0 innings, owning a 2.86 ERA (31 er, 97.2 ip) and an 8-4 record in those outings...the Padres are 10-8 when he gets to the fifth frame.

**GET TO 6.0:** He has reached the 6.0-inning mark on five occasions...in those starts, he is 4-0 with a 1.17 ERA (4 er, 30.2 ip)...the Padres are 4-1 in those starts.

**20-PLUS START CLUB:** Is one of just 20 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in a single season in Padres franchise history...along with fellow rookie southpaw **Eric Lauer**, its the first time the Padres have had two rookies make 20-or-more starts since 1977... it's now been done so on five occasions (also: 1969, 1972 and 1974).

- The Padres have now had a rookie reach the 20 start mark in three consecutive seasons, with **Dinelson Lamet** making 21 in 2017 and **Luis Perdomo's** 20 in 2016...prior to 2016, the last Padre rookie to make 20 starts was **Justin Germano** in 2007.
- His 25 starts are tied for the fifth-most among rookies this season.

**BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE:** Lucchesi and Lauer are the first pair of Padres rookie starters to record 100+ strikeouts in the same season since Bob Shirley and Bob Owchinko in 1977.

**NO WALKS FOR YOU:** Lucchesi's 43 walks allowed this year are tied for the sixth-fewest of any NL hurler who has made at least 25 starts.

**COMING UP CLUTCH:** With RISP this season, Lucchesi has a .230 opponent average (20-for-87) with five extra-base hits allowed (two doubles and three homers)... opponents have a .290 OBP in such scenarios.

- Opponents are hitting .195 (8-for-41) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

**PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME:** Joey has recorded three pickoffs and fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with 10...their 13 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history, and the Padres' 19 pickoffs rank second in the majors (also: Chicago White Sox) and trail only the Chicago Cubs' 20.

**SHOWING HE BELONGS:** The Padres selected Lucchesi to the Major League roster to start the club's second game of the season on March 30...he went on to allow three earned runs or fewer in eight of his first nine career outings from March 30-May 14, posting a 3-2 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 er, 47.1 ip) and 9.13 SO/9 IP.

- Missed 32 games from May 14-June 20 with a right hip strain, and he went 1-3 with a 3.60 ERA over his final five starts of the first half, limiting hitters to a .187 average.

**THROUGH FOUR, UNDER 2.00:** Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was **Odrisamer Despaigne** in 2014 (1.35).

**FIRST IN CLASS:** Made his Major League debut on March 30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**....teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 er, 181.0 ip).

**LOOK BACK AT IT:** The left-hander was named Padres Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after pitching to a combined 11-7 record with a 2.20 ERA (34 er, 139.0 ip), 148 SO against 33 walks and a .200 opponent average in 24 appearances (23 starts) between Lake Elsinore (A) and San Antonio (AA).

- His eight wins are the most by a Padres reliever in a single season since Scott Linebrink also tallied eight wins in 2005.
- This season, he's relied on four primary pitches: Sinker (67.2%), Slider (20.7%) and Curve (10.9%) and four seamer (1.1%).
