## ATLANTA BRAVES (90-71) vs PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (79-82)

Sunday, September 30, 2018 – 3:05 p.m. EDT – Citizens Bank Park – Game 162 – Home 81  
RHP Kevin Gausman (10-10, 3.93 ERA) vs LHP Ranger Suarez (1-1, 6.00 ERA)

- **YESTERDAY'S RECAP:** Behind ace Aaron Nola, the Phillies shut out the Atlanta Braves, 3-0, at Citizens Bank Park ... Nola (W, 17-6) put a bow on a fabulous season, going 7.0 scoreless innings and allowing a mere 2 hits with 8 strikeouts.
- **PROGRESS IN THE PROCESS:** With one game remaining, the Phillies, at three games under .500 (79-82), can reach the 80-win plateau for the first time since 2012 when they finished 81-81 ... As for progress from 2017, Philadelphia has improved by 28 games relative to the .500 mark when they were 31 games under .500 65-96 through 161 games ... As for run differential, the Phillies have improved by 50 runs from this time last year when they carried a -103 mark through 161 games ... Philadelphia, who matched last year's win total of 66 on August 15, didn't notch their 66<sup>th</sup> win last year until the final day of the season, October 1 against the Mets, a difference of 47 days on the calendar.
- **A STAR IS BORN:** Last night, **Aaron Nola** made his final start of a brilliant 2018 season ... Nola's 224 strikeouts in 2018 were the second-most ever by a Phillies pitcher age 25 or younger, trailing only Hall-of-Famer Grover Cleveland Alexander's 227 in 1911 (367.0 IP) ... Nola's 0.976 WHIP was the fifth-lowest ever by a qualifying Phillies pitcher, behind only Tully Sparks (0.97 in 1906), Alexander (0.84 in 1915 and 0.96 in 1916) and Charlie Buffington (0.96 in 1888) ... His 2.37 ERA (56 ER, 212.1 IP) was the lowest by a Phillie since Roy Halladay's 2.35 ERA in 2011 (no other Phillie was as low as those two since Schilling's 2.35 ERA in 1992) ... His 17 wins were tied for the most by a Phillie since Halladay's 19 in 2011 (Cliff Lee-17 in 2011, Cole Hamels-17 in 2012) ... Per Baseball Reference, Nola finished his year with 10.4 bWAR ... He is only the second Phillies pitcher in the last 50 years to post a 10-win season, the other being Hall-of-Famer **Steve Carlton** who did so in both 1972 (12.1) and 1980 (10.2) ... **Over the last 20 years, only three pitchers have posted a higher bWAR than Nola's 10.4 mark this season: Roger Clemens (11.9 in 1997 & 10.5 in 1990), Pedro Martinez (11.7 in 2000) and Randy Johnson (10.7 in 2002).**
- **CITIZENS BANK SPARK:** With a 48-32 record at Citizens Bank Park, the Phillies have assured themselves their best season at home since 2011 when they went 52-29 ... A win today would give Philadelphia their third-best ever record in this ballpark, behind only 2011 and the 2010 season when they went 54-30 in South Philly ... Philadelphia enters today's game averaging 4.59 runs per game at home which would be their highest total since 2010 (4.88 RPG) ... Despite their struggles on the road this season (31-50), Philadelphia's 48-32 record at home is third-best in the National League behind only the Cubs and Brewers (both 50-30, .625 win %) ... **Per Elias, you have to go all the way back to 1955 to find the last time the Phils finished a season at least 15 games above .500 at home and 15 games under .500 on the road (46-31 at home, 31-46 on the road).**
- **YOUTH GROUP:** The Phillies began the season with the youngest roster in MLB, and, with one game left, they have collected 976.1 innings from pitchers age 26 or younger, the second-highest total of any team in the majors (most: PIT, 1107.2 IP) ... Philadelphia's 129 games started by pitchers 26 or younger lead the majors (next: PIT, 121 GS) ... Offensively, Philly's 3,898 plate appearances by players 26 or younger rank 2<sup>nd</sup> in MLB to only the Cubs (3,953) and their 126 home runs are most (next: TEX, 125 HR).
- **NOTHING BUT RHYS-PECT:** Thursday, **Rhys Hoskins** played in his 200<sup>th</sup> career game, accruing 51 home runs and 122 walks in those 200 games ... **Per Elias, Hoskins joined NYY's Aaron Judge (61 HR, 152 BB) as the only players in MLB history to have at least 50 HR and 120 BB through 200 career games** ... Since he burst onto the scene August 10, 2017, Hoskins' 52 home runs rank 4<sup>th</sup> in MLB, trailing only NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (59 HR), OAK's Kris Davis (60 HR) and BOS' J.D. Martinez (65 HR) for the major league lead in that stretch.
- **THANK YOU FOR YOUR PATIENCE:** Philadelphia's 578 walks are its most in a season since 2009, when the club had 589 ... **Carlos Santana** (110), **Cesar Hernandez** (95) and **Rhys Hoskins** (86) are just the third trio of Phillies with 85 or more walks in one season in franchise history and the first to do so since 2006 (Bobby Abreu – 91, Pat Burrell – 98, Ryan Howard – 108) ... The only time Philadelphia had four players with 85 or more walks in a season was in 1993 when the quartet of Darren Daulton (117), Lenny Dykstra (129), Dave Hollins (85) and John Kruk (111) did so ... Santana's 110 walks are the most by a switch hitter in Phillies history and the most by any Phillies player since Pat Burrell had 114 in 2007 ... Cesar Hernandez's 95 walks would have tied the previous record for a switch hitter, held by Pete Rose in 1979.
- **CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH:** The Phillies are currently the only team in MLB without a player on the DL ... As it stands, this would be the first time since at least 1994, as far as the Phillies internal records go back, that Philadelphia finished a season without a single player on the DL.
- **TRULY AN HONOR:** Prior to today's game, the Phillies will present the Richie Ashburn & David Montgomery Special Achievement Award to Director of Minor League Operations, **Lee McDaniel** ... A 23-year Phillies employee, McDaniel is the first to receive the award since Montgomery's name was added... Montgomery, who currently serves as chairman, has embodied the spirit of the award over his 48-year accomplished Phillies career ... Perhaps his greatest legacy has been his demonstration of class, benevolence, integrity and philanthropy ... "Lee attributes how he conducts business to what he has learned from David over the years which explains, in part, why he is so deserving of this award," said Phillies President, Andy MacPhail ... "Aside from his level of professionalism, Lee's love of the game and his career accomplishments in player development, his instrumental role in establishing the academies in the Dominican Republic and Venezuela, and his tireless work during the Florida Instructional League and spring training are just a few highlights of why Lee is such a worthy recipient."
