MARLINS MINUTE

Miami is playing the final game of this three-game series at Washington, their first stop on their final road trip of 2018. Following tomorrow's off-day, will wrap up the season with a three-game set at the Mets. The Marlins completed their final homestand of the season last week, going 4-2 after splitting a two-game series vs. Washington and taking three of four from Cincinnati.

- **LHP Wei-Yin Chen** is making his 26th start of the season today - his most since 2015 w/ Baltimore - in his final start of the year. Will be his fourth start against the Nationals this season and 11th of his career (12th game). Is 1-6 with a 4.84 ERA in his career against the Nats, dropping his last four decisions. Will face RHP Kyle McGowin, who is making his first career start.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Marlins lost their second straight game, falling 9-4 at Washington. **RHP Jeff Brigham** lost his fourth straight start, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 ip (4 bb, 2 k, 1 hr). **1B Peter O'Brien** hit his fourth home run of the season (all coming in his last 13 games) in the eighth inning. **SS JT Riddle** (1x4) extended his hitting streak at Nationals Park to seven games. **3B Brian Anderson** (1x4) it an RBI double in the fourth inning to put the Marlins on the board.

ROAD RULES CHALLENGE

Marlins' starter **Wei-Yin Chen** is making his 13th start of the season today. Has gone 1-8 with a 9.29 ERA (51.1 ip/53 er) away from Marlins Park, compared to a 5-3, 1.62 (78.0/14) record in 13 home starts. According to the *Stats, LLC*, that difference of 7.67 is the biggest between home and road ERA by a starting pitcher in the Majors since Houston's Dallas Keuchel had an 8.15 point difference in 2012 (11.10 on road, 2.95 at home) - min. 15 GS. Chen's lone road victory came on June 16 at Baltimore (6.0 ip, 8 h, 3 r, 3 er, bb, 2 so, hr) in a 5-4 Marlins win. Has allowed a combined 9 er in 10.0 ip over his two starts at Nationals Park this season, going 0-1.

HOME IMPROVEMENTS

Over their final 53 home games beginning June 8, Miami went 28-25. This after beginning the year 10-18 over the first 28 games at Marlins Park. The Marlins posted a 3.33 ERA (503.0 ip/186 er) over the stretch, which is the fourth-best among Major League teams behind the Rays (2.74), Dodgers (2.99) and Giants (3.22).

GAME OVER

The Marlins' postponed game against Pittsburgh - originally scheduled to be played on October 1 at PNC Field - has been canceled and will not be made up.

OH BOY, O'BRIEN!

Peter O'Brien has hit safely in seven of his last nine games and nine of his last 12 with an official at-bat. Has posted a .350 batting average (14x40) with three doubles, four home runs and nine RBI over the 12-game span since September 13. His .608 slugging percentage in September is eighth highest in the National League.

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (153), at-bats (578), runs (85), on-base percentage (.355), and average with RISP (.361); ranks second in hits (157), doubles (33), walks (60) and multi-hit games (44); ranks third in average (.272) and slugging (.394); ranks tied for fourth in triples (4); and ranks fifth in RBI (62).

- His 157 hits are the most by a Marlins rookie since Chris Coghlan in 2009 (162). Only Hanley Ramirez (185 in 2006), Jeff Conine (174 in 1993), Dan Uggla (172 in 2006) and Mark Kotsay (161 in 1998) have had more hits in their rookie season with the Club.
- His 85 runs are fourth-most all time among Marlins rookies behind Hanley Ramirez (119 in 2006), Dan Uggla (105 in 2006) and Quilvio Veras (86 in 1995); His average with RISP currently ranks as the third-best in club history behind Miguel Cabrera (2003) at .375 and Kevin Millar (1999) at .367.

VS. THE NATIONALS

The Marlins and Nationals are laying their final game of 2018 against each other today. After dropping eight of the first nine games of the season series, Miami has taken five of the last nine to close the gap at 6-12. The two teams met last Monday and Tuesday at Marlins Park, splitting a two-game series. Miami is 3-6 at Nationals Park this season, marking their seventh straight losing road season series against Washington. Have gone 57-71 all-time in D.C. The overall series belongs to Miami, including a 128-128 mark since 2005.

- The Marlins have hit .270 and scored 85 runs against the Nationals this season, their highest offensive marks against any team this season.

UP NEXT...THE METS

Miami returns to Citi Field for the second time in the last two weeks for a three-game series starting Friday to close out the season. Miami is 6-10 vs. the Mets this season, but have gone 6-6 after the starting the year 0-4. Are 3-4 in Queens this season, taking two of three May 21-23 and dropping three of four Sept. 11-13. Since the start of 2016, the Citi Field series is tied, 12-12. The Marlins are 98-117 all-time in New York, 40-50 at Citi Field, and trail the all-time series 205-225.

SIX F's OF FIELDING

The Marlins have committed just 81 errors this season, fifth fewest among NL clubs. Marks the fourth-fewest errors in Club history. Only the 2017 (73), 2015 (77) and 2003 (78) teams committed fewer errors. Miami's current .9858 fielding pct. would go down as the fourth-highest in Franchise history, behind 2017 (.988), 2015 (.987) and 2003 (.987).

The Marlins' 2018 Instructional League team is hosting the Washington Nationals Instructional League team today at Marlins Park (first pitch at 1:10 p.m.). **The event is not open to the public, but is open to the media.** Miami's Instructional League roster includes several of the Marlins' top prospects, including OF **Connor Scott** (Marlins No. 4 prospect, per MLB.com; 2018 1st round pick); RHP **Jorge Guzman** (No. 5; 2017 trade acquisition); RHP **Edward Cabrera** (No. 6; international free agent); C **Will Banfield** (No. 7; 2018 Competitive Balance Round B); INF **Jose Devers** (No. 12; 2017 trade acquisition); INF **Osiris Johnson** (No. 13; 2018 2nd round); and OF **Tristan Pompey** (No. 15; 2018 3rd round).

Wei-Yin Chen is making his 26th and final start of the season in the finale of this three-game series at Nationals Park. Has gone 4-4 over his last eight decisions after beginning the season with a 2-7 record in his first nine.

Finished his home season with just 51 hits allowed over 13 starts (78.0 ip), marking the fifth-fewest hits allowed at home in Club history (min. 10 GS), tied with Josh Beckett (2002) and Tony Saunders. Livan Hernandez allowed 47 in 10 starts in 1997; Al Leiter allowed 48 over 12 starts in '97; A.J. Burnett surrendered 49 hits in 11 starts in 2004; and Dan Straily gave up 50 in 11 starts this season.

His 1.62 ERA (78.0/14) at home this season ranks as the fourth-lowest in a single season in Franchise history. José Fernández posted a 1.19 ERA in 2013, followed by Josh Johnson (1.57 in 2010), and Henderson Alvarez (1.60 in 2014).

He leads all National League starters in home ERA (min. 10 home starts), ahead of Jacob deGrom (1.66), Walker Buehler (2.12), and Dereck Rodriguez (2.15).

Of his 13 starts at Marlin Park, he limited opponents to one or zero runs 10 times. He allowed a season-high four runs twice (June 11 vs. SF and August 12 vs. NYM), and three runs once (July 24 vs. ATL).

On the road, has a 9.29 ERA (51.1/53) in 12 starts. According to *Stats LLC*, the 7.67 difference in home/road ERA is the largest gap for any pitcher in the Majors since Dallas Keuchel had an 8.15 difference (11.10 on road/2.95 at home) in 2012 (min. 15 GS at home and on road).

Pitched to a 1.54 ERA in four August starts, the lowest monthly ERA (min. 4 GS) of his career. His previous low was a 2.05 ERA in five starts in September 2014. His August ERA ranked 10th among Major League starters (min. 4 GS), behind leader Cole Hamels (0.69).

In last start, September 21 vs. Cincinnati, tossed 7.0 shutout innings and allowed just three hits and no walks. Marked second career start with at least 7.0 shutout innings and no walks allowed; also June 11, 2014 vs. Boston (7.0 ip, 4 h, 7 so).

Tied a career high with 8.0 innings pitched on September 1 vs. Toronto. Marked longest start since going 8.0 innings on July 12, 2015 vs. Washington. Limited Blue Jays to just three hits and one run while walking none and striking out seven.

On August 25 vs. Atlanta, limited Braves to six hits, while walking two and striking out a season-high 10, over 6.0 shutout innings. Tossed season-high 109 pitches and has reached 100-pitch mark in three of his last five starts. His pitch total in the game was the most since throwing 111 on September 26, 2015 at Boston. Has broken 100-pitch plateau nine times dating back to the start of 2016 (51 starts). Over his first four Major League campaigns, eclipsed 100-pitch mark 54 times in 117 starts.

José Ureña will make his 31st and final start of the season in the opener of this three-game series against the New York Mets. Has won each of his last five decisions to equal a career-best winning streak, also done from May 23-June 23, 2017. The five-game winning streak is the longest by a Marlins starter since his own. The last winning streak longer than one of his own was by José Fernández from April 28-June 6, 2016.

Over his last six starts, has allowed a total of eight runs spanning 39.0 innings pitched for a 1.85 ERA. In three previous starts, which included a one-pitch outing against Atlanta on August 15, allowed 10 runs in 10.1 innings.

Has allowed just three runs over his last four starts, marking the best four-start stretch of his career in terms of runs allowed. His 1.13 ERA (24.0/3) in four September starts ranks third among Major League starters (min. 24.0 ip), behind Reynaldo Lopez (0.67) and Luis Castillo (1.09).
