Today's game was the first Major League game since 1908 in which both starting pitchers recorded at least 9K and allowed one-or-zero hits.

NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees won their sixth straight game...are 3-0 to start their nine-game homestand...completed a season-long stretch of games on 18 consecutive days (went 16-2)...have the Majors' second-best record (24-10, .706)...three of their last four home games have been "walk-off" wins (Andújar RBI single on Fri. vs. Cleveland, Sánchez three-run HR on 4/23 vs. Minnesota).
- Completed a three-game sweep of Cleveland, their first sweep over the Indians since 3G at Yankee Stadium from 6/3-5/13...have swept five different series this season (incl. 1G at Detroit on 4/13)...are 8-0 vs. the AL Central this season and 15-2 outside the AL East...have won their last 12 regular season games vs. AL Central teams (since 9/18/17), their longest streak over the AL Central since a 16-game winning streak from 10/1/01-7/11/02.
- **Are 15-1 in their last 16 games since 4/21, matching their best 16-game stretch since match their best 16G stretch since 1961** (also 15-1 from 9/1-17/80)...have outscored opponents 98-37 over the stretch.
- Extended their home winning streak to nine games (since 4/21), tying the Yankee Stadium record set from 8/21-9/4/10...have outscored opponents, 66-25, during the streak.
- At 24-10, have their best 34-game start to a season since going 25-9 to begin 2003.
- Are 4-8 when trailing after eight innings this season (were 5-65 in those games in 2017)...**have outscored opponents, 21-3, in the ninth inning this season.**
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-4) hit a "walk-off" three-run HR in the ninth inning, becoming **the youngest player in franchise history (21 years, 144 days) to hit a "walk-off" home run.**...previously the youngest was Mickey Mantle (21 years, 185 days on 4/32/53 vs. Boston).
 - Each of his first two career homers have been three-run homers (also Fri. vs. Cleveland)...is the seventh Yankee all-time to hit both of his first two career homers with multiple runners on base, the first since Hideki Matsui in 2003 (grand slam, three-run HR).
 - The Yankees are a **Major League-best 14-1 since he was recalled on 4/22**, with Torres starting all 15 games...is the first Major League position player in the Modern Era (since 1900) to start and be on the winning side in 14 of his first 15 big league games.
 - His 11RBI are tied for the eighth-most by a Yankee in his first 15 career games.
- **RHP Domingo Germán** (6.0IP, 0H, 0R, 2BB, 9K) made his first career Major League start (13th career appearance), tossing 6.0 hitless, scoreless innings in a no-decision...retired the first 11 batters before walking José Ramírez with two outs in the fourth...overall, retired 18-of-20 batters...was the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the club this season, the first outside the season-opening rotation's starting five...**according to Elias:**
 - Was the first pitcher since the mound was moved to 60'6" in 1893 to throw at least 6.0 hitless innings with at least 9K in his first career start.
 - Was the first Yankee ever to record a hitless start of at least 6.0IP in his first career start....was the first hitless start of at least 6.0IP by a Yankee since Phil Hughes on 5/1/07 at Texas (6.1IP).
 - Was the fourth Yankee ever to record at least 9K in his first career start, joining Hideki Irabu (9K in 6.2IP on 7/10/1997 vs. Detroit), Dan Tripple (10K in 9.0IP on 9/25/1915-G2 vs. Cleveland) and Russ Ford (9K in 9.0IP on 4/21/1910 at Philadelphia-AL).
 - Was the first Yankee to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career start since Luis Cessa (6.0IP) on 8/20/16 at Los Angeles-AL...is the first foreign-born Yankees starter since 1908 to toss at least 6.0 hitless innings.
- **Yankees pitchers did not allow a hit until Yonder Alonso singled to lead off the eighth**...over the current 15-1 stretch since 4/21, have posted a 2.06 ERA (144.0IP, 100H, 37R/33ER, 40BB, 158K, 10HR)...have allowed just 2R over the first six innings of their last five games since Tuesday.
 - **Yankees starters** have recorded scoreless starts in four of their last six games...in the last 16G, have compiled a 1.89 ERA (95.1IP, 21R/20ER).
- **RHP Dellin Betances** (1.0IP, 3H, 3ER, 2K) pitched a clean seventh inning before allowing singles to each of his 3BF in the eighth...marked his first earned runs at Yankee Stadium this season (7.1IP entering the day).
- **1B Neil Walker** (1-for-2, 2R, 1 double, 1RBI, 2BB) hit a game-tying double in the ninth...is 4-for-10 with 6BB in his last four games (was 13-for-80 with 5BB in his first 21G as a Yankee).
- **RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-3, 1BB) hit a two-run double with two outs in the eighth...each of his last 4H have been XBHs (3 doubles, 1HR).
- **CF Aaron Hicks** (2-for-4) recorded the game's first hit with a single leading off the fifth...doubled and scored the tying run in the ninth.
- Judge's double in the eighth extended **Yankees batters'** streak of games with at least one double to 28 games, tied for the team's third-longest streak since 1908 (34G, 5/12-6/19/1936; 29G, 8/11-9/10/2002).

CLEVELAND INDIANS NOTES

- The Indians are 0-3 on their five-game road trip, dropping three straight games for the first time this season...are 3-7 in their last 10 games since 4/28...are 6-9 on the road this season...are 10-15 outside the AL Central this season (4-6 vs. the AL East, 5-8 vs. the AL West, 1-1 vs. the NL Central).
 - Were swept in a series of at least two games for the first time since going 0-2 at Boston from 7/31-8/1/17 and swept in a series of at least three games for the first time since 7/14-16/17 at Oakland (0-3)...were swept by the Yankees for the first time since 6/3-5/13 at Yankee Stadium (0-3).
 - Went 8-10 on their just-concluded stretch of 18 games in 17 days.
 - Are 9-6 in their last 15 regular season games at Yankee Stadium but 13-21 in 34 regular season games at the venue.
- **RHP Mike Clevinger** (7.1IP, 1H, 2ER, 4BB, 10K) did not record a decision despite striking out a career-high 10 batters (previous: 9K, three times, last on 8/26/17 vs. Kansas City)...threw 116 pitches, setting a career high...matched his fewest hits allowed in a start in his career (also 1H on 8/13/16 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 5/7/17 at Kansas City)...was his first career start vs. the Yankees (second appearance).
 - Had his scoreless streak on the road snapped at 21.1 innings when Neil Walker scored on Brett Gardner's RBI single in the eighth inning...his 2ER today marked his first runs allowed on the road this season...in three road starts in 2018, is 2-0 with a 0.83 ERA (21.2IP, 2ER).
 - Over his last five road starts dating back to 9/1/17 at Detroit (Game 2), is 4-0 with a 0.80 ERA (33.2IP, 3ER) in those games.
 - Over his last 15 games overall (11 starts) since 8/26/17, has gone 8-1 with a 1.94 ERA (79.0IP, 17ER).
- **RHP Cody Allen** (0.2IP, 4H, 3ER, 1BB) recorded the loss...has pitched on three of the last four days.
- **Cleveland batters** did not collect their first hit of the game until **1B Yonder Alonso** (1-for-3) singled to lead off the eighth inning...went 3-for-13 with RISP in this series.
- **SS Francisco Lindor** (1-for-4, 1R) hit an RBI double in the eighth inning, extended his hitting streak to nine games...is the longest hitting streak by an Indian this season...is batting .419 (18-for-43) with 11R, 4 doubles, 4HR, 10RBI and 3BB in that span.
 - Has recorded an extra-base hit in each of his last seven games, the second-longest such streak of his career (10G from 9/7-16/17).
 - Seven of his last 10 hits have gone for extra bases (3 doubles, 4HR)...has 9RBI in his last six games.
