TRIBE HEADLINES

» **SHANE BIEBER** is due to make his third career home start today, owning a 2-0 record and 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) in his two prior starts...he is holding opposing hitters to a .207 batting average with runners in scoring position.

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** has driven in a run in each of his last seven home games...his 62 RBI on the season are T2nd in the American League, while his 38 home RBI rank 3rd in the A.L.

» The Tribe is 21-8 overall in series finales this season, including a 4-3 overall mark (3-0 at home) in rubber games...Indians starting pitchers have posted a 2.34 ERA (51ER/196.1IP) in series finales, with wins in each of their last 11 decisions.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians saw their five-game winning streak come to an end yesterday afternoon, falling by a 6-3 final score in 11 innings.

» Cleveland got on the board early, scoring one run apiece in the first two innings...Tribe's 65 1st-inning runs are T2nd in MLB, with Arizona (Colorado - 73).

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (2-for-5) and **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (2-for-5) led the Tribe offense and each recorded a multi-hit game, their 37th and 27th of the season, respectively...Lindor's multi-hit game total is tied for the MLB lead, and the duo are T3rd in the American League with 56 hits apiece at home.

» **COREY KLUBER** did not factor into the decision yesterday despite recording his MLB-leading 17th quality start of the season... Kluber scattered five hits over 7.0 shutout innings (2BB, 3K) and lowered his home ERA to 1.43 (11ER/69.0IP), which is the 2nd-lowest mark in the American League and MLB.

RAPID REMATCH

» The Indians and Athletics are squaring off for a second straight weekend, following their three-game set at the Oakland Coliseum from June 29 - July 1...the Indians dropped the first two games of that series before notching a 15-3 win in the finale...this afternoon marks the conclusion of the season series between the two clubs.

» Cleveland has won seven of its last nine games at Progressive Field vs. Oakland, outscoring the A's 55-26 over those contests.

» The Indians are currently 10-15 against A.L. West opponents this season and the Tribe is 1-5-1 in completed series, with the lone win thus far coming vs. Texas (April 30 - May 2).

LET'S START AGAIN

» **COREY KLUBER's** start yesterday marked the Indians' 56th quality start of the season, the 2nd-most such starts in MLB... Tribe's 26 quality starts at home are the 3rd-most in the Majors (Houston - 32, Philadelphia - 27).

» Cleveland starting pitchers have posted a 3.39 ERA (207ER/549.1IP) this year, the 2nd-best ERA in both the American League and MLB...Tribe starters have also done well at home, recording a 3.26 ERA (95ER/262.1IP) that is 3rd-best in the A.L. (4th-best in MLB).

FRANKIE'S ON FIRE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** continued his recent hot stretch, finishing yesterday's game 2-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored...he is batting .375 (15-40) over his last 10 games, with 16 runs scored, three doubles, four homers and 12 RBI in that span.

» Lindor's 37 multi-hit games are tied with Seattle's **Jean Segura** and Boston's **J.D. Martinez** for the A.L. lead...his 37 multi-hit games through 87 team games are the most by an Indians hitter since **Kenny Lofton** had 38 through 87 games in 1996.

» Lindor also leads MLB with 79 runs scored (the next closest hitters have 69), which is tied with **Kenny Lofton** (79 in 1999) for the 4th-most runs by an Indians batter through 87 team games in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-).

» Lindor has 50 extra-base hits and is tied with **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** and two others for the MLB lead...with eight games left before the All-Star break, Lindor and Ramírez are the first pair in Indians history and the fifth pair in MLB history with 50-or-more first-half XBH... they joined the 2003 Rockies (**Todd Helton** & **Preston Wilson**), the 2003 Cardinals (**Albert Pujols** & **Jim Edmonds**), the 2003 Blue Jays (**Vernon Wells** & **Carlos Delgado**) and the 2004 Red Sox (**David Ortiz** & **Manny Ramirez**).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1935/1997: In 1935, Cleveland Stadium hosts the third All-Star Game, with the Indians represented by outfielder **Joe Vosmik** and pitcher **Mel Harder**... Vosmik went 1-for-4 with a run scored, while Harder tossed 3.0 scoreless innings in relief to earn the save in the A.L.'s 4-1 win...62 years later, Jacobs Field played host to the 1997 Midsummer Classic...**Sandy Alomar Jr.** broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run homer in the 7th, leading the A.L. to a 3-1 victory.

TODAY'S START

The 23-year-old rookie is set to make his sixth career start in this afternoon's series finale vs. Oakland...will mark his first career start and appearance against the Athletics. Will be pitching today on regular four days' rest after his last outing on July 3 at Kansas City...earned his fourth win (6.0IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 2K). Bieber is just the third Tribe pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) with four wins in his first five career starts, joining John Farrell (1987) and Scott Lewis (2008-09)...should he win this afternoon, he will become the only Indians pitcher in the Play Index era with five wins in his first six career starts. Bieber is due to face the Athletics and a team from the A.L. West for the first time in his career this afternoon...all of his career starts have come against the A.L. Central (Detroit, Kansas City, Minnesota) and in Interleague play (St. Louis). Has won both of his home starts this year, compiling a 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) in those two outings...overall, is also holding opponents to a .207 (6-29) batting average with runners in scoring position. Bieber has 29 strikeouts across his first five career appearances, which is the 3rd-highest total in Indians franchise history, trailing Herb Score (50) and DANNY SALAZAR (32).

2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

On June 22 vs. Detroit, Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since Scott Lewis did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing Ray Benge (23.157), who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia. Bieber fanned a career-high nine Tigers hitters in the outing, becoming the first Indians pitcher since Luis Tiant in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in his first three career appearances...his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts are tied with DANNY SALAZAR (also 22) for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history. Earned his first career win on June 17 vs. Minnesota...allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned seven batters, becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts and first since DANNY SALAZAR did so in his first two appearances from July 11 - August 7, 2013. His start also marked the 19th in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) to allow 10-or-more hits and one-or-fewer runs in less than 6.0 innings of work, as well as the first since teammate CARLOS CARRASCO on September 2, 2014 vs. Detroit. Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (Brian Dozier), marking the most punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since SALAZAR fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto. Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder Dave Clark on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.

2018 MILB RECAP

This season, Bieber has compiled a 6-1 record and 1.29 ERA (11ER/76.2IP) in 12 combined starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus. Did not allow a run until his fourth start of the year, a career-long scoreless streak of 22.0 innings, dating back to his last start in 2017...overall this season, has recorded five scoreless starts and allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 11 of 12 outings. Has a 3-1 record with a 1.38 ERA (7ER/45.2IP) in seven starts with Columbus, with 42 strikeouts and just five walks allowed in his 45.2 innings...marks his first career action in Triple-A...from May 3 - June 6, did not walk a batter, a span of 30.1 innings. Tossed a rain-shortened no-hitter on May 25 at Gwinnett, striking out seven batters and walking none in the 7.0 inning outing...the lone Gwinnett baserunner reached on an error in the bottom of the 3rd...marked the 8th no-hitter in Columbus franchise history. Began the season at AA Akron, where he went a perfect 3-0 with a 1.16 ERA (4ER/31.0IP) in five starts prior to his May 3 call-up to Columbus...was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for April 5-15. Named the pitcher with the Best Control in the Indians Player Development System, according to Baseball America at the beginning of the season...also placed on the Tribe pre-season top prospect rankings in Baseball America - 5th, Baseball Prospectus - 5th and ESPN.Com/Keith Law - 10th.

AWARDS ALL AROUND

Bieber has won three total Pitcher of the Week awards at two different levels this season, twice in the International League and once in the Eastern League. Began the year with Akron and went 1-0 with zero runs allowed in his first two starts of the season (13.0IP), allowing just six hits and fanning 17 batters to earn Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors for April 5-15...was promoted to AAA Columbus on May 3 & won the IL Pitcher of the Week honor in consecutive weeks (May 14-20 & May 21-27). In 2017, was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for June 19-25, after matching his career high with 11 strikeouts on June 22 vs. Frederick (8.0IP, 3H, 1BB).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

The Orange, California native was selected in the 4th Round (122nd overall) of the June, 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of California-Santa Barbara. Posted a 23-12 record and 2.73 ERA (91ER/300.0IP) from 2014-16 for UC Santa Barbara, with 237 strikeouts and just 38 walks...earned several honors over the course of his college career, including being named 2015 All-Big West Second Team, 2016 Pre-season Big West Pitcher of the Year, 2016 All-Big West First Team and 2016 Rawlings Second Team All-American. Made his professional debut with Short-Season Mahoning Valley in 2016, making eight starts and one relief appearance for the Scrappers...after allowing one run in his first appearance on July 22, did not surrender an earned run in his final eight outings of the year, a span of 21.0 innings...overall on the year, posted a 0-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/24.0IP), with 21 strikeouts and just two walks allowed. Divided the 2017 season between A Lake County, High-A Lynchburg and AA Akron, combining for a 10-5 record and 2.86 ERA (55ER/173.1IP). Began the year with Lake County and earned his first career win on April 14 at Lansing, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out a career-best 11 batters...went 2-3 with a 3.10 ERA (10ER/29.0IP) in five starts with the Captains prior to his promotion to Lynchburg on May 5. Did not factor into the decision in his first five starts with the Hillcats, posting a 3.38 ERA (12ER/32.0IP) in those outings. After taking a loss on June 6 at Salem, won his next four starts, a then-career long streak...went 4-0 with a 1.05 ERA (3ER/25.2IP) in those outings, with 29 strikeouts...won the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week award for June 19-25, after matching his career high 11 punchouts on June 22 vs. Frederick...overall went 6-1 with a 3.10 ERA (31ER/90.0IP) in 14 starts for the Hillcats. Was called up to AA Akron on July 24 and finished the season with the RubberDucks...earned his first career Double-A win on August 4 at Reading, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on six hits, with zero walks and seven strikeouts...posted a 2-1 record and 2.32 ERA (14ER/54.1IP) in nine starts for Akron. In 2017, led all pitchers in the Indians organization with 173.1 innings pitched and ranked among the organizational leaders in ERA (2.86, 2nd), strikeouts (162, 2nd) and wins (10, T4th).
