CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

JON LESTER had his streak of seven-straight starts with a win snapped ... allowed four earned runs, his most since allowing four on May 29 at Pittsburgh.

© Is 5-1 with a 1.98 ERA (12 ER/54.2 IP) in nine starts at Wrigley Field this season.

ADDISON RUSSELL (1-for-5, 2B, 3 RBI) has doubled in consecutive games for the fourth time this season ... is batting .326 (14-for-43) with three doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI and eight runs scored in his last 11 games.

JAVIER BÁEZ (2-for-5, 2B, 2 RBI) is hitting .431 (31-for-72) with 11 doubles, a triple, three home runs, 19 RBI and 17 runs scored in his last 19 games ... leads the majors with 11 doubles since June 20.

DAVID BOTE (1-for-1, RBI, BB) notched his first-career walk-off RBI with a 10th inning walk ... has hit safely in three-straight games.

NOTES: The Cubs have won nine of their last 11 games and are a season-high 15 games over .500.

© The Cubs are 28-15 at home this season ... the .651 winning percentage at home is the club's best mark prior to the All-Star Break since 2008 (37-12/.755)

© The Cubs are 15-5 in their last 20 home games dating back to May 25 ... tied for the best winning percentage of any team during that stretch.

© The Cubs have come from behind in each of their last nine victories ... the Cubs are tied for the major-league lead with 28 come-from-behind victories this season.

© The Cubs have three walk-off victories this season and improve to 5-4 in extra-innings games ... won on their first walk-off walk since their 4-3 win on August 11, 2016 vs. St. Louis (11 innings).

© Kyle Schwarber (1-for-3, 2B, BB, 2 R) has reached safely in eight-straight games, going 9-for-23 with six walks and nine runs scored in that span.

© Ian Happ (2-for-4, R, BB) is batting .394 (13-for-33) against the Reds this season with seven runs scored, 16 walks and two RBI.

CINCINNATI REDS NOTES

EUGENIO SUÁREZ (2-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, HBP, R) extended his hitting streak to 11 games (.381/16-for-42), his longest since having a career-high 13 game streak earlier this season (June 8-23) ... homered in back-to-back games for the third time this season and 11th time in his career ... has an N.L. leading 68 RBI this season.

BILLY HAMILTON (1-for-3, 2B, 2 R, BB, 2 SB) has stolen 38 bases vs. the Cubs in his career, the most by any player vs. the Cubs since 2013 ... his 20 stolen bases at Wrigley Field are the most by any Reds player all-time ... first player in the MLB this season to steal multiple bases in consecutive games.

© Recorded seven hits in 10 at bats this series, tied for his most-career hits in a three-game series.

NOTES: The Reds lost their first series since June 15-17 at Pittsburgh ... prior to this weekend they were 4-0-1 in their last five series.

© The Reds have still won 14 of their last 20 games (.700) since June 17, the second most wins in the majors during that span behind Oakland (15).

© The Reds fall to 5-6 in extra-innings games this season.

© José Peraza (2-for-4, RBI, BB, SB) has two or more hits in seven of his last 12 games (.354/17-for-48)

© Adam Duvall (1-for-4, HR, RBI, R) has four home runs in the ninth inning this season, tied for the most in the majors.

© Luis Castillo has allowed three or more earned runs in seven of his last eight starts.

© Michael Lorenzen made his sixth appearance of at least 2.0 innings this season.
