**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants look to extend their season-high winning streak to six games as they face the Diamondbacks in the middle game of this three-game series...a win tonight and the Giants would be over .500 for the first time since May 15 (22-21).

**ROSTER MOVES:** Following last night's game the Giants optioned **RHP Pierce Johnson** to triple-A Sacramento...**LHP Madison Bumgarner** (#40) has returned from his rehab assignment and has been reinstated from the 60-day disabled list.

**BUMGARNER'S BACK:** **LHP Madison Bumgarner** makes his 2018 season debut tonight after having missed the previous 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand...Bumgarner is 9-10 with a 2.58 ERA in 30 games (29 starts) against Arizona...the Giants are 126-105 (.545) in Bumgarner's starts.

**STARTING STRONG:** No Giants starter has given up more than two runs in any of the club's last four games, during which the Giants have outscored the opposition 22-4.

**HOT AT HOME:** The Giants are 18-10 (.643) at AT&T Park, winning each of their last six games and 12 of their last 16...San Francisco's .643 home winning percentage ranks as the fourth-best in MLB behind Boston (.714, 20-8), New York-AL (.710, 22-9) and Philadelphia (.679, 19-9).

**WITH THE BATS:** The Giants are averaging 5.8 runs per game (29 runs) during their current five-game winning streak...the team is batting .301 during this stretch and .368 (14-for-38) with runners in scoring position.

**FIVE IS THE KEY:** The Diamondbacks are 19-0 when scoring at least five runs this season...they're the only unbeaten team in MLB...the Giants are 20-3 (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

**CRAWFORD AT THE PLATE: IF Brandon Crawford** has multiple hits in six of his last nine games and has hit safely in 18 of his last 20 contests, batting .452 (33-for-73)...Crawford has 49 hits beginning May 1, tied with Kansas City's Jon Jay for the most of any big league player...beginning May 1, Crawford leads all MLB with a .422 batting average and ranks second in OBP (.461) and seventh in OPS (1.107).

**BIRTHDAY WISHES:** Giants **RHP Dereck Rodriguez** turns 26 years old today.

**WITH THE FIRST PICK:** The Giants selected **C Joey Bart** (Georgia Tech) with the second overall selection in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft yesterday...named the 2018 ACC Player of the Year, Bart led the ACC in batting average (.359), finished second in slugging pct. (.632) and hits (79), and finished in the top 10 in home runs (16), runs scored (55), and on-base pct. (.471)...defensively, he had a career-best .992 fielding pct.

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** The Giants are 27-6 (.818) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 33 games, the Giants are 16-3 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-13 otherwise.

**IN THE BULLPEN:** Giants relievers the last five games have combined to allow one run on nine hits, three walks and 21 strikeouts in 17.0 innings pitched (0.53 ERA).

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner**  
**6-4, 243, 28 years old (August 1, 1989)**  
**0-0 Record, --- ERA**

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his first start of the 2018 season.
- Has missed all of 2018 with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- The outing was supposed to be the final tuneup for Bumgarner before he started on Opening Day.
- Had three pins inserted into the broken pinkie March 24 and had them removed April 19.
- Made just two rehab starts, one with triple-A Sacramento (3.2ip, 1bb, 8so, 47 pitches) and one with Class A Advanced San Jose (4.2ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 7so).
- Went 0-3 with a 2.89 ERA in four starts against Arizona last season and will be seeking his first win against the Diamondbacks since July 10, 2016 (a span of five starts without a win vs. ARI).
- Is just 3-7 with a 2.27 ERA in 13 starts against the D-Backs here at AT&T Park...has lost five of his last six decisions here.
- Had never been on the disabled list in his first eight Major League seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.
- The Giants are 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- Went 4-9 with a 3.32 ERA (41er, 111.0ip) in 17 starts last season, with the Giants going 4-13 in those games...tossed 6.0-or-more innings in 15 of 17 games.
- Missed three months last season (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain...sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver, CO on April 20.
- Bumgarner, who landed on the disabled list for the very first time in his career in 2017, was diagnosed with a Grade 2 left shoulder sprain and needed two months before he got back on a mound...returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated off the 60-day DL July 15...went 4-9 with a 3.32 ERA in 17 starts last season.
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36).
- Is 18 strikeouts shy of 1,500 for his career...ranks ninth on the Giants' all-time strikeouts list.

**Last Home Run:** Sept. 3, 2017 vs. STL (off RHP Luke Weaver)

**HITTING NOTES:** Batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season... has hit 17 homers in his nine-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP CHRIS STRATTON**

**2018: 7-3, 4.50 ERA / Career: 12-7, 4.07 ERA**

**NOTES:** The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 13th start of the season...the Giants are 9-3 in his outings this year, going 5-1 at home and 4-2 on the road...his seven wins are tied with Philadelphia's Aaron Nola & St. Louis' Michael Wacha for the second-most in the NL (WSH's Max Scherzer has nine)...enters tomorrow's start on a four-game personal winning streak, going 4-0 with a 4.29 ERA (10er, 21.0ip) in his last four outings...this is the longest winning streak of his career...last pitched Friday versus Philadelphia and twirled 6.0-shutout innings with four hits allowed and seven strikeouts in the Giants' 4-0 victory...marked his second start this season of 6.0-or-more innings and no runs allowed...faces the Diamondbacks for the fifth time in his career (second time in 2018)...is 1-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7er, 24.0ip) in four starts, with the Giants going 3-1 in those games...has allowed three runs or fewer in all four outings...limited Arizona to one run on five hits in 7.0 innings the last time he faced them April 18 at Chase Field, a 4-3 Giants win.
