THE GIANTS: After enjoying a day off yesterday, SF continues their six-game road trip with game one of a four-game series in Arizona tonight...the Giants are coming off their fourth sweep of the season after winning a two-game set in San Diego.

EXTRA-EXTRA: The Giants have gone into extra innings in six of their last 17 games...San Francisco is 9-5 in 16 extra-inning contests overall this season...their 16 extra-inning games and nine extra-inning wins are both tied for the most in the Majors.

INSIDE THE SERIES: San Francisco has posted a 7-5 record against the Diamondbacks this season and has won each of the last four games...the Giants have posted a 27-24 record against the National League West and have won 11 of their last 16 games in the division.

LOOKING FOR SUPPORT: LHP Madison Bumgarner, who celebrated his 29th birthday yesterday, is 0-4 over his last four starts against the Diamondbacks, despite throwing 6.0-or-more innings and allowing just two runs in each of those outings (2.67 ERA)...during that four-game stretch he's received a total of three runs of support.

TOUGH ON US: RHP Zack Greinke is 12-2 with a 2.31 ERA (30er, 117.0ip) in 18 career starts against the Giants...his 2.31 ERA ranks as the fourth-lowest figure against the Giants since the franchise moved to San Francisco (min. 15 games started) (Stats, LLC).

SAVING RUNS: San Francisco's defense improved in July as they had 14 defensive runs saved, which ranked as the fifth-most in the league...**IF Brandon Crawford** led the team with six defensive runs saved (Baseball Info Solutions).

BYE BYE JULY: After an 18-10 month of June, the Giants finished the month of July with an 11-14 record...SF pitchers posted a 3.90 ERA overall, which ranked as the seventh-best figure in the Majors, however Giants' batters hit just .239, the seventh-lowest figure in the Majors and hit a Major League-low 16 home runs.

ON THE ROAD: The Giants are 23-32 (.418) on the road this season, the third-lowest road winning percentage in the National League ahead of San Diego (.407) and Miami (.385)...however, SF has won eight of their last 14 road contests.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Giants have just three hits in 23 at-bats (.130) with runners in scoring position over their last two games and are hitting just .171 with RISP over their past five contests.

CLOSE CALLS: 15 of the Giants last 22 games have been decided by two runs or fewer with five of San Francisco's last 10 contests having been decided by one-run...the Giants have posted a 19-19 record in one-run games and a 29-30 record in one or two run games this season.

JUST SCORE FOUR: The Giants are 43-13 (.768) when they score four-or-more runs in a game and are just 12-41 (.226) when they score fewer than three runs.

• Needs just one more win to match **Tim Lincecum** for the fourth-most in SF-era history (see chart).

• SF has lost 18 of Bumgarner's last 24 road starts, dating back to June 20, 2016.

• Last pitched Friday vs. Milwaukee and was charged with his fourth loss of the year after allowing three runs (two earned) on six hits in a season-high 8.0 innings of work... the Giants lost 3-1.

• Has received a total of 21 runs of support in his 10 starts this year (3.06 RSA) and has received just four runs of support in his past four outings.

• Failed to complete 5.0 innings in his start on July 21 for the first time since April 11, 2015...the 89 straight starts of pitching 5.0-or-more innings was the longest active streak in the Majors and the best by a Giants pitcher since the mound was moved in 1893 (*Elias*).

• Is averaging 3.50 walks per 9.0 innings, the highest average of his career.

• For the season, opponents are 5-for-52 (.096) with four walks in at-bats ending with his curveball (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

• Is holding LH batters to a .162 average against (6x37) with just one extra base hit allowed (double)...has given up just one homer to a lefty in his last two seasons (2017-18) (SD's Cory Spangenberg last year).

• Is 9-11 with a 2.60 ERA in 31 games (31 starts) against the Diamondbacks...enters his outing today having lost four in a row to Arizona, going 0-4 with a 2.67 ERA...has not earned a win over the Snakes since July 10, 2016.

• Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5.

• Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.

• Had never been on the DL in his first eight MLB seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.

• SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.

• Missed three months last year (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain... sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver on April 20.

• Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36)... needs 73 strikeouts to match **Gaylord Perry** (1,606) for the fourth-most in SF-era history.

HITTING NOTES: Is 1-for-20 with one RBI this year...his last hit was a home run against St. Louis' Luke Weaver last Sept. 3...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP CHRIS STRATTON

2018: 8-6, 5.14 ERA / Career: 13-10, 4.54 ERA

NOTES: The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 20th appearance (19th start) of the season...the Giants are 11-7 in his starts, but have lost four of the last five...was optioned to triple-A Sacramento on July 7 to make room in the rotation for **RHP Jeff Samardzija** who was reinstated from the disabled list...was recalled on July 26 and moved to the bullpen...has made one appearance out of the 'pen, allowing three runs on three hits and one walk in 1.1 innings of work against the Brewers on July 26...has not pitched since...has made five starts against the Diamondbacks, posting a 1-1 record with a 3.21 ERA (10er, 28.0ip)...his last start against Arizona came on June 6...allowed three runs on seven hits over 4.0 innings of work in the Giants' 5-4 victory.
