TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Tribe holds a 33-16 record against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2.65 ERA (130ER/441.0IP) that ranks as the lowest intradivisional mark in MLB.

» The Indians rank 2nd in the American League this season with 158 home runs, 87 stolen bases and a .258 team batting average... they lead MLB with 332 runs scored at home.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** has hit 27 of his 28 home runs as the Tribe's leadoff hitter, the most in MLB...he also continues to lead MLB with 97 runs scored and his 65 extra-base hits are tied with **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** for the Major League lead.

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** is batting .343 (73-213) at Progressive Field this season, good for the 6th-highest home batting average in the American League...he also ranks T2nd in the A.L. with 73 hits at home and 6th with 43 home RBI.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** has gone 4-1 with a 2.33 ERA (14ER/54.0IP) in eight starts vs. the A.L. Central this season...he ranks T10th in the American League with a 3.48 ERA.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians saw a late rally come up one run short, as they fell 3-2 last night in the second of four contests vs. Minnesota at Progressive Field.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** paced the Tribe offense, going 2-for-5 and plating Cleveland's first run with a solo homer to lead off the bottom of the 8th inning...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** went 2-for-3 and scored the Indians' second run on a pinch-hit sacrifice fly by **LEONIS MARTIN**...**YAN GOMES** returned to the lineup for the first time since Friday and went 1-for-3, extending his hit streak to six games.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** took the loss in a quality start, allowing three runs on 10 hits over 6.1 innings of work...the only damage against Carrasco was a three-run homer by **Mitch Garver** in the top of the 2nd inning...walked one batter and struck out eight, increasing his season strikeout total to 146 (T9th in American League).

» **ANDREW MILLER** worked 1.2 scoreless innings and struck out a batter, logging his longest appearance since May 23 at Chicago-NL (also 1.2IP)...**NEIL RAMÍREZ** worked a scoreless 9th inning and fanned two batters.

TWIN BILLING

» The Indians are playing their fifth of six series against the Minnesota Twins, as well as their second here at Progressive Field... following this week's four-game set, the clubs will face each other one final time in Cleveland from August 28-30.

» In their first matchup at Progressive Field from June 15-17, Minnesota won two of the three games...overall, the Indians own a 6-8 record vs. the Twins this season, going 2-3 at Progressive Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 3-4 at Target Field.

CENTRAL COMMAND

» Cleveland has gone 33-16 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 10-3-2 in series play...the Indians' .673 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 2nd in the A.L. and MLB (Boston - .731).

» The Tribe has gone 19-5 in divisional home games and 14-11 on the road...Cleveland has won eight of nine divisional home games and eight of its last 10 divisional road games (since June 14).

» In 49 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.65 ERA (130ER/441.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB... seven of the Tribe's 12 shutouts this season (T1st in MLB with PIT & CHC) have come against the A.L. Central, and the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 35 intradivisional games (going 30-5 in those contests).

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland starting pitchers have combined for a 3.40 ERA this season, the 2nd-lowest mark in the American League (Houston - 2.99) and 3rd-lowest in MLB (Los Angeles-NL - 3.35).

» **CARLOS CARRASCO's** outing last night marked the 71st quality start by a Cleveland pitcher this season, 2nd-most in the Majors (Houston - 79)...represented the Tribe's 37th start with at least eight strikeouts, which also ranks 2nd in MLB behind Houston (51).

» Over Cleveland's last 12 games, Indians starters have posted a 1.94 combined ERA (17ER/78.2IP), the lowest mark in MLB since July 25...their 90 combined strikeouts also lead MLB in that span.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to start tonight vs. the Minnesota Twins... will mark his 23rd start of the season, setting a new single-season career high (previously, 22 in 2017)...also marks his 67th career appearance and 54th start.

» Clevinger will pitch tonight on regular four days' rest after making his last start on August 3 vs. Los Angeles-AL...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 7-4 loss despite recording his 13th quality start of the season (6.0IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 2HR, 0BB, 6K).

» Will face the Twins for the second time this season in tonight's game...last faced Minnesota on June 3 at Target Field (ND, 6.0IP, 7H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 3BB, 3K).

» **Clevinger has posted a 2.33 ERA in eight starts this year vs. the A.L. Central, the 4th-lowest mark by any pitcher this season against the division (min. 50.0IP)**

» Enters play tonight ranked 7th in the American League with 13 double plays induced, as well as T10th with a 3.48 ERA and 11th with 139 strikeouts.

» Looks to snap a career-long four-game losing streak tonight...Clevinger's last victory came on July 1 at Oakland (6.0IP, 8H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 5K).

VS. MINNESOTA | A.L. CENTRAL

» Clevinger is due to make his second start of the season against the Twins...did not factor into the decision in his prior outing on June 3 in Minnesota, allowing four runs on seven hits (two home runs), with three walks and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

» **Owns a career 1-2 record and 4.23 ERA (13ER/27.2IP) in eight appearances (five starts) in his career vs. the Twins...**this includes an 0-1 record and 4.37 ERA (11ER/22.2IP) in his five starts.

» Clevinger will face an intradivisional opponent for the ninth time this season...has compiled a 4-1 record and 2.33 ERA (14ER/54.0IP) in his eight prior starts, allowing two-or-fewer runs in seven of eight outings against a divisional opponent.

» **Clevinger's 2.33 ERA vs. the A.L. Central is the 4th-lowest mark by any pitcher this season against the division (min. 50.0IP)...**between Clevinger, **COREY KLUBER** (1.62, 1st) and **TREVOR BAUER** (1.97, 2nd), and **CARLOS CARRASCO** (2.97, 5th) Indians pitchers own four of the five lowest ERAs vs. the Central this season.

HOME COOKING

» Clevinger is due to make his 12th home start of the season tonight...owns a 3-3 record and 4.28 ERA (33R/69.1IP) in his 11 prior outings...has allowed three-or-fewer runs in six of his 10 home starts, which is tied with **CARLOS CARRASCO** for the 3rd-most such outings on the Tribe (**COREY KLUBER** - 11, **TREVOR BAUER** - 10).

» He has put together stronger numbers on the road than at home this season...is 4-2 with a 2.69 ERA (21ER/70.1IP) and .213 opponent batting average on the road compared to 3-3 with a 4.28 ERA and .266 opponent batting average at home.

» Owns a career 10-7 record and 3.96 ERA (69ER/156.2IP) in 34 games (26 starts) at Progressive Field.

2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS

» Recorded his second career start with zero walk in his last outing on August 3 vs. Los Angeles-AL, after also doing so on May 12 vs. Kansas City.

» **Set a new career high on July 22 at Texas by recording his 12th quality start of the season (previous, 11 quality starts in 2017).**

» Clevinger matched his career high with 11 strikeouts on July 9 vs. Cincinnati...marked his fourth career start with 10-or-more strikeouts...the Tribe pitching staff has 20 such starts this season, which is 2nd in MLB (Houston - 21).

» Notched his seventh win on July 1 at Oakland, holding the Athletics to three runs on eight hits (2BB, 5K) over 6.0 innings...marked his 11th quality start of the season, **matching his career high (set in 2017).**

» Finished the month of June with a 2-1 record and 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in five starts...marked his 3rd-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 5G), trailing Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA) and March/April 2018 (2.56 ERA)...his 33 strikeouts in June are his 2nd-most in a single month, behind his 39 punchouts in May of this year.

» On June 14 at Chicago-AL, set a new career-high with 11 punchouts in the Tribe's 5-2 win (7.0IP, 5H, 2R/1ER, 1BB)...combined with his start on June 19 (10K), struck out 10-or-more batters in consecutive starts for the first time in his career.

» Clevinger has also thrown 100-or-more pitches in 14 of his 22 starts this season, which is tied with HOU's **Dallas Keuchel** for the 5th-most such starts in the American League...teammate **TREVOR BAUER** leads the Majors with 24 such outings.

» **Tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...**held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts...**his two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since CARLOS CARRASCO allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).**

» Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season in the outing, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1IP on April 8 vs. Kansas City.

CAREER SNAPSHOT & 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» Clevinger is in his fourth season in the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College (FL)...**acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever Vinnie Pestano on Aug. 7, 2014...**added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.

» Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by **Baseball America**...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).

» Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA 31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.

» **Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...**went 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).

» Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.

» His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...ranked 4th on the club in wins.

» Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-86) batting average...became the first CLE pitcher since John Denny in 1981 with three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.

» **Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.**

» **POSTSEASON:** Appeared in relief in Games 2 & 4 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees...allowed two earned runs on one hit (1HR) in 0.2 innings (2BB, 2K) in the Tribe's 9-8 victory in Game 2 at Progressive Field...tossed 0.2 innings again in Game 4 in The Bronx (1H, 1R, 2BB, 1K), as the Indians lost 7-3...has no record and a 6.43 ERA (5ER/7.0IP) in six career Postseason appearances.
