FISH BITES

Miami, which was rained out last night here in New York and in Pittsburgh on Sunday, opens a four-game set against the Mets tonight at Citi Field. Right-hander **José Ureña** will make the start for Miami; he is 3-5 with a 3.81 ERA (54.1 ip/23 er) in 12 career appearances (eight starts) vs. the Metropolitan. New York will counter with right-hander Jacob deGrom, who is 4-5 with a 3.68 ERA (93.0/38) in 15 career starts against the Marlins. Miami opened this 10-day, 10-game road trip by dropping two games in Pittsburgh. After this four-game series, they close out the trip with a three-game weekend set in Philadelphia. The Marlins are coming off a 3-3 homestand against the Blue Jays (1-2) and Phillies (2-1). **Programming note:** the Marlins have three remaining games that will be heard on 610AM WIOD: September 15 at Philadelphia, Sept. 22 vs. Cincinnati, and Sept. 29 at Mets.

VS. THE METS

Miami plays seven of its final 19 games this season at Citi Field, beginning with this four-game series. The clubs also finish their 2018 Championship Season slates with a three-game series here from September 28-30. Miami won the only series these clubs have played at Citi Field this season, taking two-of-three from May 21-23. Since the start of 2016, the Citi Field series is tied at 11-11; Miami is batting .266 collectively over those 22 games, with a staff ERA of 3.43, while the Mets are batting .228 with a staff ERA of 3.75. The Marlins are 97-114 all-time in New York, 39-47 at Citi Field, and trail the all-time series 204-222.

THE CLOSER

With Sunday's game being rained out, the Marlins and Pirates will make up the postponed game on October 1 at PNC Park, time TBD. It will mark the first time in Marlins history that a postponed game will be made up after the final regularly scheduled game of the season. The closest the Marlins had come was in 2008, when a May 15 rain out in Cincinnati was made up on September 22, the start of a regularly scheduled five-game road trip to Washington and the Mets to conclude the season. In addition, with yesterday's rainout the Marlins have lost consecutive games due to weather for the first time since losing three in a row from Sept. 3-5, 2004, when Hurricane Francis washed out a three-game series against the Cubs at Dolphins Stadium.

FISHING FOR THE TRIFECTA

José Ureña has gone 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (12.0/1) in his two career starts at Citi Field. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, only Ryan Dempster has ever won more than his first two career starts for the Marlins at the Mets in Club history. Dempster won all five of his starts in Flushing as a Marlin from 2000-'02, posting a 3.27 ERA. For his career, he won all six of his starts here, adding the final victory in 2012 with the Cubs.

TEAM EFFORT

Since July 1, Marlins outfielders have combined for 15 outfield assists, second-most in the Majors behind Pittsburgh (16). Six different players have recorded at least one assist during that stretch: **Brian Anderson** (4), **Derek Dietrich** (3), **Rafael Ortega** (3), **Magneuris Sierra** (3), Garrett Cooper (1) and **Austin Dean** (1). Only Baltimore and Texas have had more outfielders record an assist during that stretch (seven each) while the White Sox have also had six outfielders record an assist over that span. For the season, the Marlins have recorded 25 outfield assists, surpassing their total from all of last year. Only Pittsburgh (30), the Cubs (28), and Cincinnati (26) have more among NL squads this season.

BACK IN FORM

Since returning from the 10-day disabled list (right hip inflammation) on September 1, **Lewis Brinson** has posted a hit in six of seven games, going 11x26 (.423) with four multi-hit games. He recorded at least one hit in each of his first six games back, extending his overall hitting streak, which began on July 2, to eight games, which marked a new career high. He hit .406 (13x32) with two doubles, a home run, and four RBI during the streak, which was snapped Saturday after going 0x4.

CATCH & HIT

J.T. Realmuto hit his 19th and 20th home runs of the season last Tuesday vs. Philadelphia, extending his single-season career high. His 17 home runs as a catcher rank as the second-most by a Marlins backstop in Club history, two behind Charles Johnson's 19 in 1997. His 59 RBI when behind the plate are the fourth-most in a single season in Marlins history, behind Ivan Rodriguez (82 in 2003) and Johnson (69 in 2001 and 63 in 1997). Realmuto leads qualified MLB catchers in runs scored (61) and doubles (26), ranks tied for first in hits (109), is second in slugging (.497), third in average (.282), is tied for third in home runs, and fourth in RBI (all numbers are as catcher).

HOT CORNER IS ON FIRE

Marlins third basemen have not committed an error over their last 83 games, marking the longest errorless streak at third in Franchise history. Martín Prado has made 25 starts at third in that time, while **Miguel Rojas** has made 24 starts (27 appearances), **Brian Anderson** 20 starts (25 appearances), and **Yadiel Rivera** 14 starts (24 appearances). Miami third basemen lead the Majors in fielding percentage with a .979 mark, committing just seven miscues in 339 total chances.

ALL AROUND ANDY

Brian Anderson leads all Major League rookies in games (140), at-bats (533), runs (77), average with RISP (.369), and on-base percentage (.356); ranks second in hits (144), doubles (30), walks (58), and multi-hit games (42); ranks third in RBI (58) and average (.270); fourth in slugging (.394); tied for fifth in triples (3); and tied for 13th in HR (10). On the defensive side, he leads all NL rookie outfielders (min. 45 GS) with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, tied with Harrison Bader for most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton. His five total errors this season are fifth-fewest by a NL rookie (min. 60 GS), and he is the only rookie on that list to spend significant time at two different positions (49 GS at 3B; 89 GS in RF).

- He is on pace for 167 hits this season, which would rank as the fourth-most by a National League rookie since 2007, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, Troy Tulowitzki's 177 in '07, and Matt Duffy's 169 in '15, and would be the 11th-most by an NL rookie since 2000.
- He recorded 109 hits before the All-Star break, tying Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.
- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season. Since 1958, 34 rookies have recorded 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games and went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*

The Miami Marlins yesterday introduced the Marlins Charity Derby, which is open to all 501c3 non-profit organizations in Broward, Monroe, Miami-Dade and Palm Beach counties. The non-profits are able to select any eligible remaining Marlins home game(s) and request complimentary community tickets in increments of 50 tickets, with the goal of a 90 percent redemption rate. The organizations may request up to three increments, increasing their opportunity to win. For each increment that has a 90 percent redemption rate, the non-profit will receive one entry into the 2018 Marlins Charity Derby Sweepstakes, up to three entries total. The sweepstakes winner will receive a \$4,500 gift from the Miami Marlins. Sweepstakes drawing will be held on September 23, 2018.

➤ José Ureña will make his team-leading 28th start of the season in the opener of this four-game series against the Mets at Citi Field. This will mark his 12th start of the season on the road, where he has gone 3-3 with a 4.72 ERA (61.0 ip/32 er).

➤ Suffering from the second-lowest run support average of any starter in the National League (min. 20 GS) at 3.40 (5.31 on the road). Only eight starts this season has he left the game with more run support than runs allowed, and he has allowed three-or-fewer runs 15 times. His RSA of 3.40 is currently the fifth-lowest among Marlins starters with a min. of 25 starts all-time, higher than only Nathan Eovaldi (2.70 in 2014), Josh Johnson (2.92 in 2012), Anibal Sánchez (3.16 in 2011), and Charlie Hough (3.22 in 1993).

➤ Over his last three starts, has allowed a total of six runs spanning 22.0 innings pitched for a 2.45 ERA. In three previous starts, which included a one-pitch outing against Atlanta on August 15, allowed 10 runs in 10.1 innings.

➤ Making ninth career start and 13th appearance against Mets, posting 3-5 record with 3.81 ERA (54.1/23). Will mark third start against New York this season; took losses on April 9 and August 10 at Marlins Park. In four previous appearances (two starts) at Citi Field, owns a 2-0 record and 2.40 ERA. Last appearance at Citi was May 7, 2017, earning the win after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings. Allowed one hit and one walk, while striking out two.

➤ In last start, September 3 vs. Philadelphia, limited Phillies to one run on four hits, while walking none and striking out seven over 7.0 innings. Marked third career start of 7.0 innings pitched without walking a batter; Sept. 11, 2016 vs. the Dodgers and Sept. 20, 2017 vs. Mets.

➤ On August 19 at Nationals Park, tossed first career complete game and first by a Marlins starter since Edinson Volquez no-hit the Arizona Diamondbacks on June 3, 2017 at Marlins Park. Needed 108 pitches to complete the game, allowing one run on two hits and two walks, while striking out four. Was eighth complete game by a Marlins starter against Washington (since 2005), and first since Ricky Nolasco on September 9, 2012 at Nationals Park.

➤ On August 15 at SunTrust Park, made one pitch before being ejected after hitting Ronald Acuna Jr. According to *Stats LLC*, he was the first starter in the live-ball era to hit a batter on the only pitch he threw. The only other starters to hit the only batter they faced were Bob Shaw (1965), Scott Elarton (2001) and John Lackey (2009).
