WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five of the last six games, seven of 11 and 14 of 19 as they continue a six-game, seven-day homestand tonight vs. the Minnesota Twins.
- Héctor Santiago, who is making his second start of the season following seven relief outings, is scheduled to start for Chicago.
- The Sox 9-21 (.300) mark is the third-worst in MLB ahead of Baltimore (8-24) and Cincinnati (8-24).
- The White Sox went 3-4 on their last trip, losing both games in St. Louis after winning three of five at Kansas City.
- Following tomorrow's series finale vs. the Twins and an off day Monday, the Sox will conclude the homestand next Tuesday and Wednesday vs. the Pirates ... the club will then take a five-game trip to Wrigley Field (5/11-13) and Pittsburgh (5/15-16).
- The White Sox went 1-5 on their last homestand vs. Houston (0-3) and Seattle (1-2) from 4/20-25.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is a season-high matching 12 games under .500 (second time) ... the club's 9-21 start is its worst since 1950 (9-21) ... the last time the Sox started with a 9-22 record was 1950.
- The White Sox 3-11 (.214) home record is the worst in MLB, and the club's worst 14-game start in Chicago since 1971 (opened the season with a 2-14 home mark).
- Chicago has lost five of the last six games, seven of the last 10 and 11 of the last 16 vs. Minnesota.
- LHP Héctor Santiago has gone 3-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER/20.0 IP), 22 strikeouts and a .119 (8-67) opponents average over his last three starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Yolmer Sánchez is hitting .327/.365/.429 (16-49) with three doubles, one triple and eight home runs in the last 12 games.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to tonight's game vs. Minnesota, Chicago placed 2B Yoán Moncada on the 10-day disabled list with left hamstring tightness and recalled INF José Rondón from Class AAA Charlotte.
- Rondón, who will wear uniform No. 20, is hitting .286 (28-98) with four doubles, two triples, four homers, 10 RBI, seven walks, 15 runs scored and a .349 OBP in 24 games with Charlotte ... he ranks among the International League leaders in hits (3rd), total bases (4th, 48), triples (T4th) and runs scored (T6th).
- Moncada left Wednesday afternoon's game at St. Louis and last night's game against the Twins with hamstring tightness.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Minnesota hit four home runs off Carson Fulmer and held the White Sox scoreless over the final five innings in its 6-4 win.
- José Abreu gave the Sox an early 2-0 lead with a two-run home run in the first before Eduardo Escobar (two), Bryan Dozier and Logan Morrison homered for the Twins in the second and third.
- Chicago added single runs in the third and fourth, and Minnesota scored one in the fifth for the final deficit.
- Fulmer fell to 2-2 after allowing five runs (four earned) on seven hits with two walks and six strikeouts in 3.2 IP ... Sox relievers allowed one run on five hits with five strikeouts in 5.1 IP.
- Yolmer Sánchez and Abreu (three RBI) both recorded three-hit efforts, and Leury García hit his first home run of the season ... the White Sox went 0-4 with RISP and left eight runners on base.

CLIMBING THE LADDER

- José Abreu last night connected on his 131st career home run, the 14th most in franchise history and second-most by a Cuban-born White Sox behind Minnie Miñoso (135).
- Abreu ranks ninth on the all-time homer list among Cuba natives ... José Cardenal ranks eighth with 138 home runs.

FAMILIAR FACE

- LHP Héctor Santiago tonight is making his first appearance against Minnesota after pitching for the club from 2016-17.
- Santiago went 7-14 with a 5.61 ERA (82 ER/131.2 IP) and 88 strikeouts over 26 games (25 starts) with the Twins.
- He was acquired by Minnesota from the Los Angeles Angels as part of a four-player trade on 8/1/16.

WHITE SOX GIVE BACK

- The White Sox held its first large-scale service event of 2018, engaging the Volunteer Corps in the organization's efforts to give back to the local community.
- Members of the VC, joined by Adam Engel, Carson Fulmer, Lucas Giolito as well as Harold Baines, Don Cooper and Bill Melton helped to enhance Armour Elementary School in Bridgeport.
- The White Sox Volunteer Corps program, which has been recognized with numerous national service awards, has grown to nearly 4,800 members who have provided more than 45,000 hours of community service since its inception

WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- Minnesota leads the season series, 2-1, with 16 games left.
- The Sox are hitting .198/.252/.365 with four home runs, own a 4.15 ERA (12 ER/26.0 IP) and have been outscored, 15-10.
- Games from 4/13-15 were postponed (see schedule at right).
- The Sox have lost five of the last six games, 11 of the last 16, and are 5-9 in the last 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Chicago went 7-12 vs. Minnesota in 2017 (4-6 at Guaranteed Rate Field) to fall to 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups.
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 426-475 ... they are 231-219 at home (117-100 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 195-256 on the road (36-41 at Target Field).

ELOY IS STREAKING

- Class AA Birmingham LF Eloy Jiménez last night went 3-5 with a double, home run (No. 5) and three RBI at Tennessee.
- He is hitting .368 (14-38) with four doubles, three homers, 12 RBI and eight runs during his current eight-game hitting streak.

PUT AWAY THE SUITCASE

- The White Sox currently are in a stretch playing 17 of 19 games in Chicago, including 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field, from 5/3-24.
- Following this six-game homestand vs. Minnesota and Pittsburgh, the Sox will play three games at Wrigley Field (5/11-13) and four-game series vs. Texas (5/17-20) and Baltimore (5/21-24).
- The club's only road games are at the Pirates from 5/15-16.
- Chicago has been outscored, 75-44, at Guaranteed Rate Field.

TWIN CITY CONNECTIONS

- Below is a breakdown of White Sox players and coaches who previously played for the Minnesota Twins:
 - ◆ LHP Héctor Santiago: Pitched for Minnesota from 2016-17.
 - ◆ OF Daniel Palka: Played in the Twins organization from 2016-17.
 - ◆ Pitching Coach Don Cooper: Pitched for the Twins from 1981-87.
 - ◆ Bullpen Catcher Mark Salas: Played for Minnesota from 1985-87.
- The following Twins previously played for the White Sox: LHP Zach Duke (2015-16), INF Eduardo Escobar (2011-12) and RHP Addison Reed (2011-13).

ONE (RUN) AND DONE

- Chicago has gone 4-9 in one-run games in 2018, the second-most in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (5-10) ... the nine one-run losses also are the second-most in baseball.
- The White Sox have scored one run or less eight times this season, tied for the fifth-most in baseball.
- The Sox were 21-23 in one-run games in 2017.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 6-7 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- Chicago has lost nine of its last 12 games vs. the AL Central at Guaranteed Rate Field, being outscored 72-45.
- The Sox are 297-384 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox lead the American League and rank second in baseball with 30 stolen bases ... the club ranks fifth in the major leagues with an 81.1 (30-37) success rate.
- Tim Anderson (2nd, 10), Leury García (T6th, 5), Adam Engel (T6th, 5) and Yoán Moncada (T13th, 4) rank among AL leaders.
- The Sox are on pace to steal 162 bases this season ... by comparison, they stole 71 bases in 2017 and 77 in 2016.

WHAT A (STAT)CAST!

- A number of White Sox players rank among the MLB Statcast leaders in 2018 ... a breakdown of categories and Sox rankings:
 - ◆ Average Exit Velocity (MPH): Yoán Moncada (6th, 95.0); José Abreu (11th, 94.2).
 - ◆ Exit Velocity on fly balls and line drives: Abreu (7th, 99.6); Matt Davidson (11th, 99.3).
 - ◆ Individual Home Run Distance: Avisail García (2nd, 481 ft.).
 - ◆ Hard Hit Percentage: Moncada (8th, 57.6); Abreu (16th, 55.2).
 - ◆ Barrels/Fair Batted Balls: Moncada (6th, 21.2); Davidson (9th, 20.6).

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,326 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the second-place New York Mets (1,322) and 45 more than Oakland (1,281), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox are 5-6 when starters make a QS this season.

NO RISP, NO REWARD

- The White Sox are tied for 12th in the American League with a .211 (51-242) average with RISP this season.
- Chicago is hitting .262 (32-122) with RISP in the last 16 games, up from .158 (19-120) over their first 14 ... the Sox have been limited to two hits or less with RISP 23 times (zero hits 10 times).

SANTIAGO AT A GLANCE

- The 30-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his ninth appearance (second start) of the season, fourth (first) at Guaranteed Rate Field and first vs. Minnesota.
- Needs three appearances for 200 in his career.
- Is 0-6 with a 8.81 ERA (31 ER/31.2 IP) and .303 (40-132) opponents average over his last eight starts ... earned his last win as a starter on 5/9/17 at the White Sox (2 ER/6.2 IP) with the Twins.
- Was signed by the Sox as a free agent on 2/15/18.
- Went 4-8 with a 5.63 ERA (44 ER/70.1 IP) over 15 games (14 starts) with Minnesota in 2017 ... missed the majority of the season due to shoulder and back injuries.
- Has gone 40-46 with a 3.99 ERA (355 ER/801.0 IP) and 698 strikeouts in 196 games (130 starts) over eight major-league seasons with the White Sox, Angels and Twins.
- Originally was selected by the Sox in the 30th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST START

- Received a no decision on 4/29 at Kansas City, allowing two runs on five hits and three walks with five strikeouts over 4.2 IP ... it was his first start since 7/2/17 at Kansas City with Minnesota.
- Held the Royals scoreless over the first three innings ... surrendered a solo home run to Cheslor Cuthbert in the fourth.
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 2-1, with the tying run on first base and two outs in the fifth ... threw 86 pitches (57 strikes) ... Chris Volstad, who relieved Santiago, gave up a single to Jorge Soler and a three-run home run to Cuthbert in the fifth ... the Sox lost, 5-4.

BACK TO THE ROTATION

- Has gone 36-42 with a 4.10 ERA (319 ER/700.2 IP), 607 strikeouts and a .241 (642-2,666) opponents average over 131 career starts.
- Is winless in his last eight starts, going 0-6 with a 8.81 ERA (31 ER/31.2 IP) ... earned his last win on 5/9/17 at the White Sox (2 ER/6.2 IP).

OUT OF THE PEN

- Tossed 3.1 scoreless IP in his last relief appearance on 4/24 vs. Seattle ... has thrown at least 2.0 IP in six of his seven relief outings this season.
- Surrendered a season-high three runs on three hits over 2.1 IP in his season debut on 4/3 at Toronto ... has allowed one run or less six times in 2018, including three scoreless efforts.
- Struck out four batters in relief on 4/18 at Oakland, tying a career high (4x, last 4/27/13 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Is 2-1 with a 2.32 ERA (8 ER/31.0 IP) and 27 strikeouts over his last 16 relief outings.

THAT'S A GOOD RATE

- Is 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA (2 ER/9.1 IP), eight strikeouts and a .257 (9-35) opponents average in four relief appearances at home this season.
- Has gone 3-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER/20.0 IP), 22 strikeouts and a .119 (8-67) opponents average over his last three starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Owns a 5-4 record with a 3.29 ERA (36 ER/98.1 IP) over 18 career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field and a 5-5 record with a 3.35 ERA (55 ER/147.2 IP) lifetime.

2017 REVIEW

- Was limited to just 15 appearances due to shoulder and back injuries in his second season with Minnesota.
- Went 4-1 with a 2.76 ERA (13 ER/42.1 IP) in his first seven starts from 4/5-5/9 ... was 0-7 with a 9.96 mark (31 ER/28.0 IP) in his next eight games (seven starts) from 5/14-7/2.
- Earned the win in his season debut on 4/5 vs. Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits over 5.0 IP.
- Was on the disabled list from 6/7-27 with a left shoulder strain ... was placed on the DL a second time on 7/3 with upper thoracic back pain and missed the remainder of the season.
- Made three appearances for Team Puerto Rico in the World Baseball Classic.

IN THE COMMUNITY

- In 2015, was the Angels nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award ... hosted "Santiago's Soldiers" events at Angel Stadium.
- Made multiple appearances to visit children at the Children's Hospital of Orange County (CHOC) ... participated in the Angels Adopt-A-School program, visiting students at Cambridge Elementary School, as well as making appearances with fans at Fiesta Angels and the Angels 5K and Fun Run.
- In 2013, visited students at St. Rose Elementary School in Newtown, Conn. ... was Chicago's 2013 nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award and Marvin Miller Man of the Year Award.
- In 2012-13, sponsored and supported "Santiago's Soldiers," an inner-city youth baseball team in Chicago ... participated in the Sox Celebrity Bowling Classic benefiting pediatric cancer research and visited patients at Lurie Children's Hospital.

VS. MINNESOTA TWINS

- Is scheduled to make 11th career appearance (seventh start) against Minnesota and fifth (second) at Guaranteed Rate Field ... is 3-2 with a 4.19 ERA (16 ER/34.1 IP) lifetime and 1-1 with a 0.84 ERA (1 ER/10.2 IP) in Chicago.
- Has gone 2-0 with a 5.60 ERA (11 ER/17.2 IP) over his last four starts against the Twins.
- Earned the win in his last start on 6/15/16 vs. Minnesota with Los Angeles-AL (1 ER/6.0 IP) ... earned the win in his only start vs. Twins at Guaranteed Rate Field on 9/3/12 (1 ER/5.0 IP).
- Went 7-14 with a 5.61 ERA (82 ER/131.2 IP) and 88 strikeouts over 26 appearances (25 starts) with the Twins from 2016-17.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (1-3, 5.35) is scheduled to make his eighth appearance (seventh start) of the season, fifth at home and first vs. Minnesota ... is 0-3 with a 6.50 ERA (12 ER/12.0 IP) over his last four starts.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 5/1 at St. Louis, allowing one run on a season-low two hits over 6.0 IP ... walked none and struck out four ... did not issue a walk for the first time since 8/24/16 vs. Philadelphia (6.0 IP).
- Is scheduled to make his 25th career start against the Minnesota Twins ... has gone 8-9 with a 4.32 ERA (70 ER/146.0 IP) lifetime ... suffered the loss in his last start on 8/29/17 at Minnesota (4 ER/5.0 IP) ... received a no decision in his last start at home on 8/23/17 (3 ER/6.0 IP).
