## SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (19-15) vs PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (18-15)

Monday, May 7, 2018 – Citizens Bank Park – 7:05 EDT – Game 34; Home 17  
RHP Jeff Samardzija (1-1, 5.27) vs RHP Zach Eflin (0-0, 1.50)

- YESTERDAY'S ACTION:** The Phillies lost their rubber match to the Nationals, 5-4 in walk-off fashion at Nationals Park yesterday ... Starter Jake Arrieta allowed just 1 run on 2 hits in 6.0 innings of work, walking 2 and striking out 2 ... Max Scherzer held the Phillies bats in check for the length of his outing, striking out 15 in 6.1 innings ... Philadelphia scored 3 times off the bullpen in the seventh on RBIs from Nick Williams, Rhys Hoskins and Odubel Herrera ... Maikel Franco hit his sixth home run of the season in the eighth but the bullpen surrendered four runs in the final 2.0 innings as Washington took the series.
- O-DOUBLE HERRERA:** Centerfielder **Odubel Herrera** doubled twice in yesterday's ballgame, both of which were milestone hits ... His first double was the 500<sup>th</sup> hit of his career, coming in his 476<sup>th</sup> career game ... His second double was the 100<sup>th</sup> double of his career ... **Per Elias, he reached 500 hits in his 476<sup>th</sup> game as a Phillie, the fewest games to 500 career hits as a Phillie since Chase Utley knocked No. 500 in his 474<sup>th</sup> game on 5/5/07** ... Herrera recorded his third three-hit game of the season yesterday as well, and is now one of only four National league players with 40 hits this season (Nick Markakis - 45, Ozzie Albies - 41, Asdrubal Cabrera - 41) ... He currently ranks T-2<sup>nd</sup> in the NL in batting with Cabrera (.333), trailing only Markakis (.344), and his 12 multi-hit games are T-6<sup>th</sup> in the NL ... Herrera has now reached base safely in a career-best 35 straight games (since 9/27/17), posting a .338/.391/.485 slash line over 151 plate appearances during the streak ... **Herrera, who has reached base safely in each of his 31 games to start the season, has the longest on-base streak by a Phillies player in the modern era (since 1900) to begin a season, eclipsing the previous modern-day record held by Jayson Werth in 2010 (26 G) ... His 31 straight games reaching base to begin the season are the most by any major league player since Matt Holliday began the 2015 season reaching base in 45 straight (Elias)** ... Herrera has the longest active on-base streak in baseball and the longest by a Phillies player since Chase Utley reached safely in 35 games from June 23-August 3, 2006.

- BE LIKE MAIK:** Third baseman **Maikel Franco** has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 games (4/20-current) and has five multi-hit games in that stretch, including three of the last four ... He is slashing .347/.365/.653 in those 14 games ... Franco has now homered four times in his last eight contests, driving in at least one run in 7 of those 8 games, including four straight ... It is the seventh time in his career he has driven in a run in four straight games, and he is two short of his career-long such streak (6 G, 7/1-6/16) ... Franco is now T-4<sup>th</sup> among NL players in RBI this season (26), trailing CHI's Javier Baez (29), ARI's A.J. Pollock (29) and WSH's Bryce Harper (28) ... His four homers since 4/28 trail only WSH's Matt Adams (5) among NL players in that span.
- RHYS LIGHTNING:** **Rhys Hoskins** has now reached base safely in 29 of his 32 starts this season, and 20 of his last 22 games overall (since 4/13) ... Yesterday, his RBI double gave the Phillies the lead, and it was his 10<sup>th</sup> go-ahead RBI of the season ... **His 10 go-ahead RBI are tied for second most in baseball with DET's Nick Castellanos and OAK's Jed Lowrie, trailing only ARI's A.J. Pollock (11)** ... Since making his ML debut on August 10, 2017, Hoskins has posted a .984 OPS over 352 plate appearances ... That ranks 5<sup>th</sup> among all National League players with at least 300 plate appearances in that span, trailing only CHI's Kris Bryant (1.003), COL's Nolan Arenado (.996) & Charlie Blackmon (.991), and STL's Tommy Pham (.990)
- CAUGHT OFF GUARD:** Catcher **Jorge Alfaro** has thrown out four of five attempted base stealers in his last five games (including three straight base stealers) after only throwing out two of his first 17 ... With his recent surge behind the plate, he is now tied for the league lead in catcher caught stealing (6) with MIA's Bryan Holaday, and is T-3<sup>rd</sup> in baseball behind only BAL's Chance Sisco (8) and OAK's Jonathan Lucroy (7).
- THEY MIGHT BE GIANTS:** The Phillies and Giants square off for the first time this year, with Philadelphia going 2-0-1 in the last three series matchups ... Philadelphia has won five of their last seven games at home against San Francisco (since 6/7/15) after going just 3-11 against them at Citizens Bank Park from 7/27/11-6/6/15.
- ENTER STRANDMAN:** The Phillies bullpen has successfully stranded 31 of their last 35 inherited runners (4/9-current) and their 88.6% strand rate is easily tops in the majors over that stretch (next: SF, 33-39, 84.6 %) ... Overall this season, the Phils pen has stranded 38 of the 50 runners they have inherited and their 76.0% strand rate ranks T-4<sup>th</sup> among all major league bullpens (best: LAA, 80.9 %) ... Individually, **Luis Garcia** has stranded all 12 runners he has inherited.
- PHILLIE SPECIAL:** After getting off to a 1-4 start, the Phillies have gone 17-11 in their last 28 games (4/5-current) and their .607 winning percentage over that span is fifth-best among any major league team (best: BOS & NYY, .714).

**LAST START:** 5/1 at MIA: ND, 6.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, 4 SO ... Eflin vs Garcia ... A bloop double would end Eflin's bid for perfection and a solo home run from Justin Bour would break the shutout attempt ... The Phils rallied on a Rhys Hoskins RBI double before the Marlins took the game and the series in the 10th.

**TONIGHT'S START:**

- Quite a Debut:** Making his first start since last August, Eflin was perfect through his first 5.0 IP of his first start of the season 5/1 at MIA ... He finished with just the third start of his career in which he has gone at least 6.0 IP and allowed 3 H or fewer ... The others were CG SHO (9.0 IP, 3 H) on 7/22/16 at PIT, and 4/23/17 vs ATL (7.0 IP, 3 H)
- Efficient Eflin:** Completed his 6.0 innings in 72 pitches in his debut, making him the first starter to finish an outing of 6.0 + IP in 72 or fewer pitches since 8/24/16 (Eickhoff, 6.0 IP, 71 pitches) ... He is the only ML starter to do so this season and first since Felix Hernandez completed 6.0 IP on 70 pitches on 9/25/17
- Walk Away:** Has walked only 9 batters in his last 69.1 IP (since 2<sup>nd</sup> inning of 2017 debut – walked 3 in first inning), an average of 1.17 BB/9.0 IP ... Has walked 1 batter or none in more than half of his career starts (13 of 23) and 2 or fewer in 19 of 23 ... His 9 starts with 0 walks are more than all Phillies pitchers since 2016 aside from Jeremy Hellickson (13) and Jerad Eickhoff (12), despite Eflin making only 23 starts in that span
- 2018 Minors:** Began the season with Lehigh Valley (AAA) before being recalled on 4/30 by PHI ... Posted a 1.69 ERA (3 ER, 16.0 IP), in his first 3 starts of the season with LHV, allowing 1 ER in each ... Did not walk a batter in 2 of his 4 total starts
- vs NL West:** 1-4, 6.52 ERA (36 ER, 49.2 IP) in 9 starts ... Has a 10.04 ERA (29 ER, 26.0 IP) in last 5 starts vs NL West clubs
