**THEY SEE ME ROLLIN':** Yesterday, the Padres defeated the Cardinals 5-3, claiming their second consecutive game vs. St. Louis and splitting the series at two games apiece...it was their second consecutive day-game win and their third overall this season (3-8)...starter **Clayton Richard** logged a career-high tying 10 strikeouts (June 30, 2010 vs. COL), earning his 53rd win as a Padre and tying Dave Dravecky for the third-most wins by a Padre southpaw...Richard pitched 8.0 innings in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career (August 19-25, 2012)...the last Padre starter to do so was Andrew Cashner (Sept. 15-20, 2014).

- **SS Freddy Galvis** logged his 10th multi-hit game of the season, going 2-for-2 yesterday with a double, an RBI and a run scored.
- **2B Jose Pirela** is riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .368 (7-for-19) with three doubles and two RBI in that time.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Today, the Padres optioned INF **Carlos Asuaje** to El Paso (AAA) and selected the contract of OF **Franmil Reyes**...Reyes will wear No. 32.

**YOU'VE GOT A FRAN IN ME:** 22-year-old **Franmil Reyes'** first appearance will be his debut...his 14 home runs entering today lead all of baseball (Majors and minors), and this season with El Paso (AAA), he's hit .346 (45-for-130) with seven doubles, a triple 14 home runs, 38 RBI, 34 runs scored and 21 walks.

**LOCKED AND LUCCHESI'D:** Rookie starter **Joey Lucchesi** has faced Colorado twice this season and has not given up an earned run in either of his two starts...he's one of just five pitchers in MLB history to have accomplished such a feat vs. COL...he's 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 11.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts to four walks in his first two career starts against the Rockies.

**PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME:** **Joey Lucchesi's** three pickoffs lead all of MLB...along with **Eric Lauer's** two, their five combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo since 2009, when **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** combined for six pickoffs...San Diego pitchers have combined for seven pickoffs, the most in the Majors.

**YOU SHALL NOT REACH BASE:** The Padres bullpen has a 1.20 WHIP this season...that is the third-lowest mark among NL teams and is tied with NYY for the fourth-lowest mark in Majors this year.

**SHUT IT DOWN:** The Padres have combined to convert 11 of 14 save opportunities, and their 78.6 save percentage is the second-highest in the ML behind ATL's 81.8 percent...**Brad Hand** has converted 11 of 13 save opportunities for a 84.6 percent.

**THE 'PEN IS STRONG WITH THIS ONE:** Yesterday afternoon, the Padres bullpen worked just 1.0 inning (Brad Hand's ninth) for the second time this season (May 8 vs. WSH)...in the last 10 games (since May 3), the SD bullpen has posted a 2.23 ERA (10 ER, 40.1 IP), the third-best ERA in that time.

**MIRA COMO CAMINA CORDERO:** OF **Franchy Cordero** has walked in consecutive games for the second time this year...he's reached base via hit or walk in 16 of his last 17 games and has accrued 11 walks with a .408 OBP in that time.

**SO EXTRA:** **C A.J. Ellis** has extra-base hits in each of his last three games with an at-bat (all three were doubles)...that ties his career-high extra-base hit streak, done just once before (April 2-5, 2013)..., he's reached base safely via hit or walk in seven consecutive games for the first time since he reached in eight straight from May 9-June 1, 2016.

**PADRES ON DECK:** For San Antonio (AA), **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, the Padres' No. 1-ranked prospect by the MLB Pipeline, went 2-for-3 Sunday afternoon with two walks, a stolen base and a run scored to raise his batting average to .233...the Missions' 11-game winning streak was snapped with a 10-3 loss to Frisco.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#37 LHP JOEY LUCCHESI (3-2, 2.98)**

**LET'S GO FUEGO:** 24-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make his ninth career start and third of the season against the Colorado Rockies in Game 1 of this brief two game set.

- His 2.98 ERA (14 ER, 42. IP) ranks 12th in the NL...he is one of just 12 qualifying NL starting pitchers to have an ERA under 3.00

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the Padres' 2-1 victory in his last outing on 5/9 vs. WSH, tossing 5.0 IP of one-run ball.

- He has now tossed at least 5.0 IP and three runs-or-less in six of his eight starts.

**NOT SO ROCKY:** Is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 11.0 IP) with 15 strikeouts to four walks in his first two career starts against the Rockies.

- Is one of just five pitchers to have not given up a run in either of his first two starts (also: Christian Friedrich in 2016, Jacob deGrom in 2014, Matt Harrison in 2012 and Johan Santana in 2009).
- In his second career start on 4/10 at COL, he became just the seventh pitcher in Padres history to not allow a single earned run in at least 6.0 IP at Coors Field (last: Christian Friedrich, 6/12/16)...it has been done eight times, with Oliver Perez twice (7/7/02 and 9/7/02).

**PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME:** Lucchesi's three pickoffs lead all of MLB...along with Eric Lauer's two, their five combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo since 2009, when **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** combined for six pickoffs.

- Cory Luebke recorded the most pickoffs by a rookie in Padres history (four in 2011)...besides Richard's and Geer's three apiece in 2009, the only other Padres to have three pickoffs during their rookie campaigns are current bullpen coach Doug Bochtler in 1995 and Ryan Buchter in 2016.

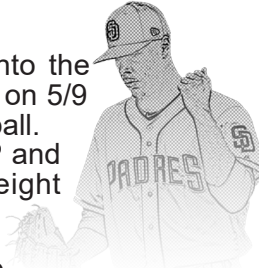
**JOEY LU'KK'HESI:** Among all ML starting pitchers, his .267 strikeouts to batters face ratio ranks 17th in the majors and tied for ninth in the NL

- His 9.78 SO/9 IP ratio ranks 26th among all ML pitchers and 14th in the NL.

**LEADER OF THE PACK:** He currently leads all qualifying rookies in ERA (2.98), opponent average (.239) and OBP (.298), ranks second in IP (42.1) and strikeouts (46).

**APPRECIATE THE HELP:** Lucchesi's 6.38 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) ranks 12th in the majors and his 30 total runs of support are tied for the 12th-most in the National League.

- He received 11 runs of support on 4/28 vs. NYM in the Padres' 12-2 victory, but two runs or less in four of his eight starts.

**THROUGH 4, UNDER 2.00:** Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was Odrisamer Despaigne in 2014 (1.35).

**FIRST IN CLASS:** Made his Major League debut on 3/30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**...teammate LHP Eric Lauer became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Lucchesi made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 ER, 181.0 IP) and 204 SO against 36 BB.

**JORDAN'S TURN:** In his last outing on 5/10 vs. STL, RHP **Jordan Lyles** allowed two runs (one earned) while striking out six and walking one...it was his first start since 9/29/17 at SF

- Is limiting opponents to a .211 (19-for-90) batting average.
- Owns a 2.65 ERA (5 ER, 17.0 IP) in eight games at home this season while limiting hitters to a .234 clip.
- Prior to being named to the rotation on 5/7, his 19.2 IP ranked tied for sixth among all Major League relievers.
- Held opponents scoreless in 10 of his 13 relief outings this season and tossed more than 1.0 inning on seven occasions.

- His hometown, Koloa, Hawai'i, was recently struck with nearly 50 inches of rain in 24 hours, flooding the Koloa community...has agreed to match up to \$5,000 to reach his \$10,000 goal to go towards the Hawaii Community Foundation and their relief efforts...
