CARDINALS NOTES

- **Jack Flaherty** made his seventh start of the season, first against the Marlins in 2018 and in his career (0-1)...had held his opponents to three runs or less (7 total) in his first five starts this season and has allowed 10 in his last two starts.
- **José Martínez** tallied his 9th three-hit game this season...has hit safely in his last five straight games vs. MIA (9-16, .563)...recorded his first RBI since 5/26 at PIT...has three doubles in his last four games.
- **Harrison Bader** snapped an 0-for-9 with a double to center in the 4th inning, his first hit of the month.
- **Yairo Muñoz** collected his 11th RBI in his last 10 games with a sac fly in the 4th inning...first Cardinals shortstop to commit three errors in a game since **Aledmys Díaz** (5/13/16 vs. LAD).
- **Tommy Pham** has two multi-hit games in his last three games.
- **Preston Guilmet** allowed a home run in each of his last two appearances (2nd time career: 5/29-31/2014)...had not allowed more than two home runs in any of his previous three MLB single seasons.
- **Matt Carpenter** hit his 238th career double, moving past **Matt Holliday** into sole possession of 22nd place in Cardinals history.
- **Jedd Gyorko** made his first pitching appearance of his MLB career...is the first Cardinals position player to pitch in a game since **Ruben Tejada** (5/20/16 vs ARI, 11-7 loss).
- **The Cardinals** suffered their largest margin of defeat this season (8 runs)...committed multiple errors for the 12th game this season and tied their season-high with three errors (5th game)...surrendered a season-high 11 runs, double-digit runs for the first time this season and were the last team to do so in the Major Leagues in 2018 beating the Diamondbacks by two days (6/4)...allowed 10 extra base hits for the first time since 4/16/2016 vs. Cincinnati...surrendered 18 or more runs over a two-game period against the same team for the first time since 6/17-18/2017 at Baltimore (15 & 8).

MARLINS NOTES

- **Wei-Yin Chen** made his eighth start of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and second career start vs. the Cardinals (0-0)...has not pitched 5.0 or more innings in 5 of 8 starts this season.
- **Derek Dietrich** posted a career-high four hits...has hit safely in 7 of 8 games on the current road trip (15-29, .517) including two home runs and four multi-hit games...scored multiple runs in consecutive games for the first time this season.
- **Brian Anderson** has an extra base hit in four straight games, tied with **Derek Dietrich** for the longest streak by a Marlins player this season (5/21-25)...has a hit in 10 of his last 11 games vs. N.L. Central opponents (15-41, .366)...has reached base safely in 51-of-61 games this season.

- **Starlin Castro** rapped out a career-high three doubles in a game, the first Marlins player with three doubles in a game since **Christian Yelich** (7/26/17 at TEX)...tallied his 18th career four-hit game...extended his hitting streak to eight games (13-36, .361).
- **JT Riddle** has hit safely in his last six games vs. STL, all coming at Busch Stadium (9-23, .391)...collected his first RBI that did not come via a home run this season.
- **Lewis Brinson** connected on his 2nd multi-home run game of the season (last: 4/19 at MIL) and in his career...5th instance a Marlins player has multiple home runs in a game this season (Rojas, Realmuto, Bour).
- **J.T. Realmuto** has three extra base hits in a game marking the first Marlins player this season and first since **Giancarlo Stanton** (8/25/17 vs. SD - 2 HR, 2B) and the first without the aid of a home run since **Marcell Ozuna** (7/26/17 at TEX)...hit his 16th career triple since he arrived in the league in 2014, the most among MLB catchers (14th as catcher)...9th career game with two doubles and first with two doubles and a triple.
- **Drew Rucinski** earned his first Major League win...made his second appearance of the season...has stranded all three inherited runners...was his longest outing since throwing 3.0 innings vs. BOS (5/6/17).
- The **Marlins** smacked 10 extra base hits becoming the 9th instance an MLB team had 10 extra base hits in a game this season and the 10th game in team history (last: 8/22/17 at PHI - Game 1 of DH), with one of those games against the Cardinals (6/15/1994)...scored a season-high 11 runs (last game with 10 or more runs: 9/30/17 vs. ATL) and a season-high 17 hits...had two players with three extra base hits in the same game since July 26, 2017 at TEX (**Christian Yelich & Marcell Ozuna**)...scored seven or more runs in back-to-back games against the Cardinals for the 3rd time in club history with the last time June 15-16, 2013 losing 13-7 and winning 7-2 at Marlins Park (last time in St. Louis was June 14-15, 1994 winning 7-0 and 13-3)...won two straight road games for the first time since winning three from 5/22-28 (2 at NYM & 1 at SD)...have won 4 of their last 5 games at Busch Stadium...have tied or won their last three series at Busch Stadium III.
