TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** won the fourth game of the four game series against the Orioles and complete the sweep...this marks the second series sweep of the season for the Twins, the other a two-game series at St. Louis May 7-8...this is the first time the Twins have swept the Orioles at home in a four game set...improve to 2-5 when entering a series finale with a chance to sweep...the last four game sweep the Twins had was September 21-24, 2017 at Comerica Park against the Tigers...marks their ninth series win of the year and their second of the year over Baltimore...are 6-1 against them this year and 20-8 in their last 28, winning three of their last four series against the O's...improve to 9-11 against the AL East...are now 24-20 at Target Field, including four in a row...recorded a home run for the fifth consecutive game...tied a season-high in the sixth inning with eight runs scored, done one other time April 11 vs. Houston.
- **JAKE ODORIZZI** earned his fourth win of the season, improving to 4-6...the win today snapped a four game losing streak, tying his career-long...he threw 6.0 shutout innings and allowed five hits...this was his sixth quality start of the season and the third time this season he has not allowed a run to score.
- **MAX KEPLER** (2-for-3) with a single in the second inning, extended his hitting streak to four games...hitting .429 (6-for-14) during the streak...has now recorded a hit in 13 of 14 career games vs. Baltimore, hitting .388 (19-for-49) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs and 16 RBI.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (1-for-5) has now hit safely in five of seven games since making his season debut on July 2...hitting .269 (7-for-26) this season.
- **ROBBIE GROSSMAN** (2-for-4) extended his hitting streak as a starter to five games, hitting .348 (8-for-23) during the streak...recorded his 15th multi-hit game of the season and third of July.
- **MITCH GARVER** (1-for-3) hit his fourth home run of the season in the fifth inning, a two-run shot to left field scoring Max Kepler...since June 6 is hitting .357 (20-for-56).
- **EDUARDO ESCOBAR** (1-for-4) recorded his 14th home run of the season, a two run homer to right field, he ranks second on the Twins in homers behind Rosario (18).
- **BRIAN DOZIER** (2-for-4) hit his 13th home run of the season and recorded his 18th multi-hit game of the season...this marks the second time this season that he has recorded a double and home run in the same game, other May 10 at Los Angeles-AL...this was his 164th career home run, passing Tom Brunansky to move into sole possession of ninth on the Twins all-time home run list.

ORIOLES NOTES:

- **THE ORIOLES** fall to 0-6 on the current road trip, the third time this season they have gone 0-6 on a road trip, others April 13-19 and May 1-6...now are 12-36 on the road overall...have lost 13 of their last 14 games...drop to 6-1 against the Twins this season and 156-158 in Minnesota...is the 14th time being swept this season.
- **ALEX COBB** suffered his 11th loss of the season, dropping to 2-11...this as the 13th time this season he has received three-or-fewer runs of support...he went 5.0 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits, including two home runs...this is the fifth time this season he has surrendered multiple home runs in a start.
- **MANNY MACHADO** (2-for-3) singled in the first inning and now has a hit in 68 of his 87 games this year...extended his hitting streak at Target Field to eight games and has hit safely in 18 of 20 games in Minnesota, hitting .422 (35-for-83)...extended his current hitting streak to four games, hitting .364 (4-for-11)...entering the game his 104 hits were tied for sixth most in the AL...recorded his team leading 31st multi-hit game with a double in the sixth inning, is 19th double of the season.
- **JONATHAN SCHOOP** (2-for-4) extended his hitting streak to six games, hitting .417 (10-for-24) during the streak.
- **CHRIS DAVIS** (1-for-4) recorded his ninth home run of the season...struck out twice in the game, bringing his career strikeout total to 1,308, he holds the Orioles record in the category.
