NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON

The Washington Nationals fell to the St. Louis Cardinals, 11-8, in the second game of this three-game series...The Nationals and Cardinals will face off in the rubber match tonight...The Nationals will cap this 10-game homestand with a four-game series against the Chicago Cubs starting Thursday.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE DAY

Today - September 5 - marks Major League Baseball's annual celebration of **Roberto Clemente** (H.O.F. 1973)...**Ryan Zimmerman** is Washington's nominee for the 2018 Roberto Clemente Award, the most prominent individual award for Major League players...The Roberto Clemente Award is the annual recognition of a player who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.

- The Nationals will recognize Zimmerman as part of Roberto Clemente Day ceremonies...As part of the league-wide celebration, the Roberto Clemente Day logo will appear on the bases and official dugout lineup cards and a special tribute video will be played in ballparks.

ON-BASE MACHINE

Bryce Harper has reached base safely in 11 of his last 15 plate appearances dating to Sept. 1 vs. Milwaukee (8th inn.)...During this stretch, he has eight walks, three hits (1B, 2B, HR) and five RBI...Harper has drawn at least one walk in eight straight games, tied for the second-longest streak of his career (10 G, 2x).

- Since the All-Star break, Harper ranks in the National League in RBI (2nd, 35), doubles (T3rd, 13), runs (T4th, 31), on-base percentage (3rd, .431) and OPS (8th, 1.011).
- On the season, he ranks in the NL in homers (T2nd, 31), RBI (7th, 89) and OBP (8th, .384).

DOING JUAN SOTO THINGS

Juan Soto has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games and is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with two doubles, one homer, nine RBI, nine walks and five runs scored during this stretch.

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 397 PA) in on-base percentage (.419) and OPS (.931).
- He leads all National League rookies (min. 397 PA) in slugging percentage (.512) and batting average (.299).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies in walks (1st, 68), runs (2nd, 63), RBI (2nd, 54), home runs (3rd, 16), doubles (T3rd, 20) and hits (T3rd, 98).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in walks (T2nd, 68), OBP (3rd, .419), runs (T5th, 63) and OPS (7th, .931).
- Among all NL hitters (min. 397 PA), he ranks in OBP (1st, .419), OPS (6th, .931), AVG (9th, .299) and SLG (12th, .512).

TURNING THE HITS

Trea Turner has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 games dating to Aug. 21...During this stretch, he is 19-for-58 (.329) with two doubles, two homers, six RBI, seven walks, three stolen bases and 11 runs scored...Turner has not been held hitless in back-to-back games since Aug. 4-5.

- Turner leads the Nationals with 40 multi-hit games this season and his career-high 154 hits are sixth in the National League.

SAVING GRACE

In 24 outings dating to July 4, **Matt Grace** has pitched to a 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) while striking out 25 batters and issuing just six walks...He has surrendered just five extra-base hits during this stretch (4 2B, HR).

- Among National League left-handed relievers, Grace ranks in walks per 9.0 IP (4th, 1.90), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.18), opp. OBP (8th, .282) and WHIP (10th, 1.12).

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

NATIONALS HISTORY

September 5 (8-4 on this date)

2012 - For the second straight night, Washington launched six homers, including a pair from **Bryce Harper**, during its 9-1 home win over the Chicago Cubs. **Gio Gonzalez** blanked Chicago for 7.0 innings to run his consecutive scoreless innings streak to 16.0. Gonzalez also matched **R.A. Dickey** for the MLB lead with 18 wins. The Nationals, who homered six times the night prior, became the first team in MLB history to hit six or more homers in two straight home games.

#57 - TANNER ROARK - RHP

Right-hander is one of MLB's top unheralded pitching performers...Is 58-49 with a 3.53 ERA in 138 career starts...He has eclipsed the 13-win mark in each of his seasons as a full-time starter (2014, 2016-pres.)...Since 2014, he ranks fifth among MLB starting pitchers in hard-hit rate (25.6%), according to FanGraphs.com...Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 53 of his 138 starts, going 31-11 with a 1.71 ERA in those 53 starts...Helped Team USA bring home the Gold Medal in the 2017 World Baseball Classic...Is stellar with the glove, having committed just two errors in 134 games (66.7 IP) since the start of 2015 - a .985 fielding percentage.

AGAINST THE CARDINALS: Faces the Cardinals for the second time this season...Allowed three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings of work in Washington's 5-4 win on Aug. 16 at St. Louis...Was his fifth win in a row...In six games (4 starts) against St. Louis he is 2-2 with a 5.57 ERA (13 ER/ 21.0 IP).

LAST START: Suffered the loss after tossing 6.0 IP and allowing four earned runs on six hits while striking out three and walking none in Washington's 4-1 loss against the Milwaukee Brewers on August 31.

2018 NOTES

- Has not issued a walk in his last three starts...Has 11 strikeouts in those three outings.
- From July 25-Aug. 25, he pitched to a 1.61 ERA (8 ER/44.2 IP) over seven games...Opposing batters hit .204 (33-for-162) and collected just seven extra-base hits (4 2B, 3 HR) over the stretch...He had 36 strikeouts, five walks and a 0.85 WHIP along the way...Washington went 6-1 in those starts.
- Ranks third in the NL in opp. OBP (.233), tied for third in WHIP (0.89), fourth in SO/BB ratio (7.80) and 11th in ERA (2.13) since July 25.
- Ranks fifth in the National league having induced 15 double plays...His 17 quality starts are tied for sixth in the National League.
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 11 of his 27 starts...His 11 starts of at least 7.0 IP rank tied for fourth the National League.
- Tossed 17.0 scoreless innings from July 13-31, the second-longest streak by a National in 2018 and the 16th-longest streak among National League starters this season.
- Earned his third straight win, tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball in Washington's 2-1 win against Cincinnati on Aug. 5...Struck out two batters without issuing a walk...Allowed seven hits.
- Continued his run of strong pitching with 7.0 innings of four-hit, one-run ball as the Nationals topped the Mets, 25-4, on July 31...Recieved as many runs of support (19) as he did in his last eight starts combined...Struck out seven batters without issuing a walk...Lone run came via solo home run in the seventh inning.
- Received 35 total runs of support in 15 starts from May 5 to July 25 (3.27 runs of support per game)...Prior to the start on July 31 (19 runs of support), his 4.11 run support average this season was seventh lowest in the National League...Following that start, his 5.21 runs of support was the 11th-highest in the National League.
- Earned his fourth win of the season, his first since June 6 at TBR, on 7/25 at MIL...Struck out a season-high 11 batters while tossing a season-high 8.0 scoreless innings...He gave up just three hits and one walk in the 7-3 victory over MIL.
- Allowed one earned run on seven hits in 6.0 innings of work on June 28 at Philadelphia...Struck out five batters and issued three walks...Was the fewest earned runs allowed in a start since May 26 at Miami.
- He tossed 6.0 IP, giving up three runs on six hits while walking two and striking out five on June 12 at New York (AL)...He completed at least 6.0 IP for the 11th straight start dating to April 13.
- Matched a season-high nine strikeouts on May 5 vs. PHI, but was saddled with the loss.
- Struck out a season-high nine batters in 5.0 innings pitched on April 8 vs. New York.
- Opened the season with 7.0 strong innings on April 2 at ATL...Allowed one earned run on four hits while striking out six and walking one as Washington topped Atlanta, 8-1...Right-handed batters went 0-for-6 with one strikeout against him.
