**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals are 31-18 post All-Star Break and 32-18 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in the NL since the All-Star Break (31), while St. Louis .633 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 21-of-its-last-30 games overall. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had 9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have 3rd-most wins (79) in the NL.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals are at 15 games over .500 entering play today and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 2.5 games. The Cardinals have 6 games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

**THE HOME STRETCH:** The Cardinals, who have matched the Cubs for fewest home games played amongst all N.L. teams, will be home for 13 of their remaining 19 regular season games...the Cardinals 37-31 (.544) home mark is 5th among N.L. teams.

**WINNING SEASONS:** The Cardinals need three wins to record their 11th consecutive winning season, something they've done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

**CENTRAL CASTING:** The Cardinals 38-29 (.567) mark against N.L. Central teams, is 2nd only to the Pirates (35-25; .583) amongst divisional foes. In addition to this week's three-game series with Pittsburgh, the Cardinals have three games remaining with both the Brewers & Cubs...they're 8-8 vs. Milwaukee and 9-7 vs the Cubs this season.

**THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER:** The Cardinals have 13 games (LAD-4, at ATL-3, MIL-3, at CHI-3) remaining with teams currently in contention for playoff positions...the SF Giants (3 games) are the only remaining team on the Cardinals slate that is under .500.

**WAINO RETURNS:** The Cardinals activated **Adam Wainwright** (right elbow inflammation) from the 60-day disabled list today and he will draw the start in tonight's series opener with Pittsburgh, his first start for St. Louis since May 13. Wainwright, 37, who was unscored upon in six injury rehabilitation appearances (17.0 IP), owns a career-mark of 147-84 with a 3.30 ERA, including a 1-3 record and 4.00 ERA in four starts this season. Wainwright fanned seven in 5.0 shutout innings for Memphis (AAA) in his final rehab start on Sept. 1 at Nashville, throwing 90 pitches. In his 14th season, all with the Cardinals, Wainwright enters tonight's start ranked 5th all-time among Cardinals in wins (147) and 2nd in strikeouts (1,598). Wainwright missed a total of 105 games while on the disabled list.

**BACK TO THE FUTURE:** With his perfect 9th inning yesterday in Detroit, **Carlos Martínez** converted his 2nd save of the season (4th career), both coming on the recent road trip...Tsunami closed out a 7-6 win at Washington with 2.0 scoreless innings last Wed. (9/5) and since joining the bullpen last month, Martínez is 1-0 with a 0.96 ERA (9.1 IP/1 ER) with 2 saves & 4 holds...Carlos appeared in 20 games as a reliever during his rookie season of 2013 and appeared in 12 games during the Redbirds postseason run, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP/5 ER), appearing in five of the six games during the 2013 World Series.

**THE BIG BEAR:** In six games since Sept. 3, **Marcell Ozuna** leads the National League in total bases (25), co-leads in home runs (5, Trevor Story), ranks 2nd in .OPS (1.346), 1st in slugging (.962), and 10th in batting average (.385). Ozuna has 11 home runs and is slugging .540 in 40 games since the All-Star Break (10 home runs w/ .385 slugging in 90 games before).

**POWER PLAY:** St. Louis has homered in 103 of 143 games this season, going 70-33 (.680 win pct.) in those games (9-31 when not homering)...their 70 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-79)...St. Louis' 188 home runs are 2nd-most in the NL and trail the Dodgers (200)...280 of the Cardinals 670 runs scored (42%) this season have come via the long ball.

#### PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

**Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates **Ivan Nova** and **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

**Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

**Matt Adams** was born in Philipsburg, Pa...graduated from Philipsburg-Osceola High School...attended Slippery Rock University (2007-09).

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

**Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

**Francisco Pena's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

**Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

**Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004), **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and **Austin Gomber** (June 2, 2018) made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searge** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) & Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

- Makes his 5th start of the season (282nd career start) and the 349th career app. His 349th career game passes Todd Worrell (1985-89, '92) for 8th in Cardinals history.
- Activated from the 60-day disabled list today. Missed previous 105 games with right elbow inflammation.
- Has missed a total of 129 games with three stints on the DL this season: left hamstring strain (3/26-4/4) and right elbow inflammation (4/20-5/12 and 5/14-9/9).
- Is two strikeouts away from reaching 1,600 for his career. Ranks 2nd among Cardinals all-time strikeout leaders, trailing only Bob Gibson (3,117).
- Needs 7.2 innings pitched to become first pitcher to throw 1,000 career innings at Busch Stadium III, and 5th Cardinal to throw 1,000 innings at a home stadium, joining Jesse Haines (1554.0 at Sportsman's Park/Busch Stadium I), Bill Sherdel (1100.1 at Sportsman's Park/Busch Stadium I), Bob Gibson (1182.0 at Busch Stadium II) and Bob Forsch (1402.1 at Busch Stadium II).
- The only other active pitchers to have thrown at least 1,000 innings at a home stadium are Clayton Kershaw (1104.2 at Dodger Stadium) Justin Verlander (1249.2 at Comerica Park) and Felix Hernandez (1383.1 at Safeco Field).
- Has 78 wins at Busch Stadium. A win tonight would tie LHP Bill Sherdel (1918-30) for 5th all-time in Cardinals history.
- Has 174 career appearances at home and 174 career appearances on the road.
- Missed 18 games with right elbow inflammation from 4/20-5/12.

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Made his sixth rehab appearance across three levels while recovering from right elbow inflammation, scattering 12 hits with 23 strikeouts over 17.0 scoreless innings.
- Last pitched for St. Louis on May 13 at San Diego.

- Earned his only win of the season in a 5-3 victory at CHI (4/17) at Wrigley Field, allowing 1 UER with 5 strikeouts in 5.0 IP. Temperature at first pitch was 35°.
- Marked his 15th career win vs. the Cubs (T10th all-time in Cardinals history) and his 11th career win at Wrigley Field (3rd all-time in Cardinals history).
- Reach 1907.1 career innings in 4/17 start, passing Slim Sallee (1905.1) for 6th-most all-time in franchise history.
- Passed 1,900 innings pitched for career in his 4/11 start vs. MIL, becoming the 15th active pitcher to do so.
- Made his 5th career home opening start on 4/5 and took the loss against Arizona, tossing 3.2 innings, his second shortest home Opening Day start (2012, CHI).

**CAREER**

- Ranks 6th among all Cardinals pitchers in franchise history with a 3.30 ERA and 7th with 1,909.2 innings pitched.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 239 career games, the most in Cardinals history (surpassed Bob Gibson & Tim Lincecum's 198 on 6/15/16) and the most for any tandem since Tom Glavine and Javy Lopez had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (Elias).
- Owns the most career wins at Busch Stadium III at 78 and has 3rd-lowest ERA at 2.83 (min. 200 IP).
