CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

JOSÉ QUINTANA tied his single-season career-high with his 13th win of the season ... has a quality start in nine of his 10-career starts against the Brewers ... improves to 6-2 with a 1.60 ERA (12 ER/67.1 IP) against Milwaukee in his career, the lowest mark of any active pitcher ... has six starts of at least 6.0 scoreless innings this season.

- © Retired nine-straight batters to start the game and then nine-straight again from the fourth through sixth innings.
- © The Cubs are 9-1 in his 10 starts against the N.L. Central at Wrigley Field since joining the club last season.

VICTOR CARATINI (2-for-3, 2B, 2 RBI) is 5-for-9 with six RBI in his last three games ... has an extra-base hit in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.

NOTES: The Cubs are 30-13 in their last 43 home games.

- © The Cubs have six shutouts this season against Milwaukee, their most ever against the Brewers ... marks only the fourth time since 1913 that the Cubs have recorded at least six shutouts in a single season vs. a single opponent (last, seven shutouts in 1928 vs. Cincinnati).
- © The Cubs are 11-7 vs. Milwaukee this season, including 6-2 at Wrigley Field
- © The Cubs lead the majors with 16 shutouts this season.
- © Ben Zobrist (0-for-3, R, SB) stole his first base since July 6 vs. Cincinnati ... has three stolen bases on the year, surpassing his total of two from last season.
- © Javier Báez (1-for-2, BB, R) has walked in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also done August 24-25 vs. Cincinnati).

MILWAUKEE BREWERS NOTES

JHOULYS CHACÍN allowed a season-low one hit, the seventh time this season that a Brewers pitcher has allowed just one hit in an outing of at least 5.0 innings ... is 0-2 with a 3.72 ERA (4 ER/9.2 IP) in his last two starts, both against the Cubs ... has taken a decision in each of his last 10 outings.

- © Retired the final 11 batters he faced.

NOTES: The Brewers were shutout for the 11th time this season and first time since June 18 at Pittsburgh.

- © The Brewers have totaled three or fewer hits in nine games this season, four of which have come against the Cubs.
- © The Brewers fell to 13-2 this season when allowing three or fewer hits (last loss, May 15 at Arizona)
- © Christian Yelich (0-for-3, BB) has reached base in 27-straight games, the longest active streak in the N.L. ... ties his career-high set in 2014.
- © Lorenzo Cain (1-for-4) has hit safely in five consecutive games against the Cubs and is 21-for-66 (.318) against Chicago this season.
- © Jesus Aguilar (1-for-4) has a hit in 11 of his last 13 games (12-for-49).
