THE O-ZONE: Outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** began the season 0-for-8, but hit safely in the next eight games and is currently tied with former Miami teammate **Derek Dietrich** for the National League lead with 14 hits. His eight-game hit streak is T-2nd in the N.L. and one off the pace of Arizona's **Chris Owings** (9).

STRANDED! **Bud Norris** stranded the bases loaded in the 10th inning last night, marking the second time in a week the newly acquired pitcher has done so, both against the Brewers. Norris currently ranks 2nd in MLB in inherited runners with nine, trailing only former Cardinal, **Sam Freeman** (ATL, 10).

SWING AWAY: **Marcell Ozuna** is one of two players in MLB who have played in 10 or more games this season and has yet to draw a walk (43 plate appearances). The only other player is also in the stadium tonight, **Jonathan Villar** of the Brewers, who has yet to walk in 35 total plate appearances over his first 10 games played.

HEATING THINGS UP: Rookie relief pitcher **Jordan Hicks** has been lighting up the speed gun according to MLB Statcast. The 21-year old flamethrower currently has the eight fastest pitches in MLB this season topping out at 101.6 MPH (wo-seam fastball) and has the highest average speed for a two-seam fastball (99.5 MPH) and sinker (98.9 MPH).

WORKING MY WAY BACK TO YOU: Cardinals relief pitcher **Luke Gregerson** (10-day D.L., left hamstring strain) made his second rehab appearance in Palm Beach (A) last night, pitching 1.0 inning in relief (6th inning), allowing one single to Blue Jays rehabbing outfielder Anthony Alford and struck out two batters tossing 19 pitches (12 strikes).

TRIFECTA: **Dexter Fowler**, **Tommy Pham**, and **Marcell Ozuna** have started in the outfield in all 10 of the Cardinals games so far this season. The last time St. Louis started the same three outfielders in the first 10 games of the season was 1983, featuring **Lonnie Smith**, **George Hendrick**, and **David Green**.

SIX IS A SERIOUS NUMBER: Since **Mike Matheny** took the helm of the Cardinals in 2012, the Cardinals are 41-1 when scoring six or more runs against the Brewers. Their only loss was last season vs. the Brewers on Flag Day when they trailed 6-0 after and inning and a half and rallied before losing 7-6.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: Cardinals pitchers have hit 10 homers off the Brewers of the 51 home runs they have allowed to pitchers in their history...**Adam Wainwright** and **Blue Moon Odom** (OAK, 1964-76) are tied for most of any pitcher with three. Tonight's starting pitcher, Carlos Martinez, has 26 hits since the start of 2016, most of any MLB pitcher over that period.

HOPS: **Kolten Wong** has 12 stolen bases in 14 career attempts vs. the Brewers, his most against any MLB opponent and the highest stolen base percentage (85.7%) of any player against the Brewers since he debuted in the league in 2013. Wong also has posted his career bests against the Brewers in hits (65), runs (37), doubles (16), extra base hits (24) and RBI (31).

TAKE YOUR BASE: **Matt Carpenter** has reached base safely in all 10 games to begin 2018, T3rd-longest active in MLB (**Marcus Semien**, **Freddy Galvis**, 11, 1st)...his multi-walk game on 4/5 was the 100th of his career, 11th-most in Cardinals history and five behind **Keith Hernandez** (10th, 105 games)...his 99 multi-walk games since his first full season in 2012 are ranked 6th in all of MLB.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Cardinals pitcher **Brett Cecil** and Brewers first baseman **Eric Thames** were Blue Jays teammates for parts of two seasons (2011-12).

Cardinals shortstop **Paul DeJong** graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) High School.

Cardinals pitcher **Carlos Martínez** and Brewers infielder **Jonathan Villar** were teammates for the Dominican Republic during the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Cardinals pitcher **Luke Gregerson** was a USA squad teammate of Brewers outfielders **Ryan Braun** (2013) and **Christian Yelich** (2017) during the last two World Baseball Classics.

Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** was previously a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder **Christian Yelich** (2013-17) and pitcher **Dan Jennings** (2013-14).

Cardinals pitcher **Bud Norris** and Brewers pitcher **Josh Hader** were traded for each other during the 2013 Trade Deadline (July 31, 2013, Orioles sent Hader, outfielder **L.J. Hoes** and a 2014 Competitive Balance Round A pick to the Astros for Norris).

Cardinals outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and Brewers pitcher **Jhoulys Chacin** were Rockies teammates for five seasons (2009-13).

Cardinals pitcher **Greg Holland** was teammates with Brewers outfielder **Lorenzo Cain** (2011-15) and pitcher **Jeremy Jeffress** (2011-12) while in Kansas City.

Cardinals manager **Mike Matheny** was selected by Milwaukee in the 8th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...played five seasons in a Brewers uniform (1994-98), where he made his Major League debut (April 7, 1994 vs. Oakland).

Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach for six seasons (2003-08)...oversaw a Brewers staff that ranked second in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, the lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's **Matt Wise** (September 23, 2004).

Cardinals first baseman **José Martínez** recorded his first career Major League hit and RBI (9/8 vs. Milwaukee) with an infield single off right-hander **Ben Rowen**.

Cardinals Sr. Special Assistant to the GM **Red Schoendienst** played parts of four seasons for the Milwaukee Braves (1957-60).

Cardinals infielder **Greg Garcia** made his Major League debut against Milwaukee (April 28, 2014) with a pinch-hit at-bat (walk). Cardinals pitcher **Carlos Martínez** made his Major League debut (May 3, 2013) at Milwaukee.

Cardinals Director of Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB draft.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Brewers Bullpen Coach **Lee Tunnel** pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987...appeared in two games in the 1987 World Series.

Brewers Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for St. Louis (1995).

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

CAREER

- His 75 GDP induced since 2015 rank 2nd among MLB pitchers trailing Texas' Martin Perez (81).
- Has won 43 games over the past three seasons (2015-present), ranking 6th-most among National League pitchers.
- Of his 102 career starts, 68 have been 6.0 innings or more and 61 of those registered as quality starts.
- Two-time N.L. All-Star: Selected in 2017 (player vote) and 2015 (Final Fan Vote).
- Switched uniform number from 44 to 18 in 2015 to honor his late friend and teammate Oscar Taveras.
- Pitched for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic
- Registered 608 strikeouts in his first 100 career starts, most among pitchers in Cards history (Lance Lynn had 581 in first 100 starts) (*Elias*).

- Established career-bests in starts (32), innings (205.0), strikeouts (217) and opponent BA (.232) in the first of a five-year contract extension signed before the season.
- Ranked among NL leaders in shutouts (2, 1st), batters faced (858, T1st), innings (2nd), strikeouts (4th), quality starts (20, T4th), starts (T5th), opponent batting average (8th), SO/9 IP (9.53, 9th), H/9 IP (7.86, 9th), WHIP (1.22, T10th), and ERA (3.64, 14th).
- Also ranked in the Top 10 among N.L. pitchers in opp. OBP (.302, 10th), baserunners/9 IP (11.33, 10th) and walks (71, T7th).
- His 217 strikeouts were the 9th-highest single-season total in Cardinals history and most by a Dominican-born pitcher in Cards history, besting Jose DeLeon's 208 in 1988.
- Is the 7th Cardinal to reach 200 strikeouts, joining Bob Gibson (9x), Adam Wainwright (3x) Jose DeLeon (2x), Chris Carpenter (1x), Steve Carlton (1x) and Sam Jones (1x).
- Selected to the 2017 NL All-Star team by player vote, the second of his career (2015, Final Fan Vote). Joined Dizzy Dean (1934) as the only two Cardinals with 4 strikeouts in an All-Star Game.
