ROBO TO THE RESCUE | YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» For the second time this homestand, the Tribe won in their final at-bat of the game, defeating Detroit 2-1 last night thanks to **ROBERTO PÉREZ's** solo home run in the bottom of the 8th...Indians improved to 6-5, marking the team's first time over .500 this season.

» The longball marked Pérez's 20th career home run...of those 20 homers, 10 of them have come in the 7th inning or later...last night's longball also marked his 7th career go-ahead homer.

» One day after notching his 500th career hit, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** got the Tribe on the board with his second home run of the season, a solo shot in the 1st...marked the Indians' 11th 1st-inning run of the season...the club enters today T2nd in the American League (T6th in MLB) in 1st-inning runs, as well as T1st in the A.L. and T2nd in MLB with three 1st-inning home runs.

» After having his turn in the rotation pushed back a day due to back soreness, starting pitcher **JOSH TOMLIN** held the Tigers to four hits in 5.0 shutout innings, with two walks and three strikeouts, but did not factor into the decision...Tomlin allowed just one baserunner in his final two innings of work and lowered his season ERA from 24.00 to 9.00.

MONSTERS OF THE MOUND

» Cleveland's starting pitchers have allowed two-or-fewer runs in nine of 11 starts this season, the most such starts in MLB...Tribe starting pitching also ranks 5th in the American League and 6th in MLB with a 3.03 ERA (23ER/68.1IP)...since April 4, Indians starters have allowed just six runs in 41.1 innings, leading MLB with a 1.31 ERA in that time span.

» Overall, pitching dominance has been a key part of the club's success this season...entering tonight's game, Tribe pitchers rank 3rd in the A.L. and 7th in MLB with a 2.99 ERA (33ER/99.1IP).

» In 2017, the Indians led MLB with a 3.30 team ERA...Cleveland's 3.60 ERA over the past three seasons (2015-2018) leads the A.L. and ranks 3rd in MLB, behind Chicago-NL (3.48) and Los Angeles-NL (3.49).

WINNING ONE-BY-ONE

» With last night's 2-1 victory, the Tribe has won three games in a row for the first time this season...also marks the second streak of three consecutive one-run wins by a team in 2018, alongside Boston's streak from March 30-April 1...San Francisco had a three-game streak that went from October 1, 2017-March 30, 2018.

» The Indians have played seven one-run games so far, with a 3-4 record in those contests...team is tied with Tampa Bay for the most one-run games in the Majors this season...Tribe's three wins in one-run games are tied with Arizona and San Francisco for the 3rd-most in MLB, behind Boston (5) and Milwaukee (4).

NOT LEFT OUT

» Cleveland has faced a left-handed starting pitcher in four of the team's last six games, going 3-1 in the matchups against southpaws.

» Tribe has scored 14 of their 31 runs (45 percent) this season vs. LHP...those 14 runs are tied for the 3rd-most in the American League and T7th-most in MLB...team's four home runs off of LHP is T4th in the A.L. and T9th in MLB...this comes despite a .169 (20-118) team batting average against lefties.

» Cleveland is scheduled to face another pair of southpaws in this weekend's series against Toronto...team went 36-24 against left-handers in 2017 and ranked 6th in MLB with a .270 team batting average vs. LHP.

HOME COOKING

» The Indians have opened their 2018 home slate with a 4-1 record on this 10-game homestand...last season, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 32-9 (.780) at home, including wins in 21 of their past 24 regular-season games here.

» In addition, Cleveland currently leads MLB with a .182 opponent batting average at home, and ranks 2nd with a 1.00 home ERA.

» This current 10-game homestand (vs. KC, DET & TOR) matches the longest the Tribe will play this season, along with another 10-gamer from July 6-15 (vs. OAK, CIN & NYY).

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1980:** Joe Charboneau made his Major League debut, going 1-for-4 with a home run in the Indians' 10-2 loss to the Angels in Anaheim...went on to hit .289 (131-453) with 17 doubles, 23 home runs and 87 RBI in his rookie campaign, en route to being named the 1980 American League Rookie of the Year...a perennial fan favorite, Charboneau spent his entire Major League career with the Tribe, batting .266 in 201 games from 1980-1982.

SAVING CODY ALLEN

» Cleveland closer **CODY ALLEN** worked a perfect 9th inning last night for his 3rd save of the season.

» Marked Allen's 125th career save, moving him into sole possession of 3rd place on the all-time franchise list, four shy of 2nd-place Doug Jones (129) and 14 behind leader Bob Wickman (139).

TIGER BY THE TAIL

» The Indians and Tigers are in the middle of the first of six scheduled series between the clubs this season, including a 10-game slate at Progressive Field.

» During the 2017 campaign, the Indians posted a 13-6 record against Detroit, winning the season series for a second consecutive year (first time doing so since 2007-08).

» Since the start of 2016, the Tribe has gone 29-10 against the Tigers, including 11 straight victories from April 22 - July 5, 2016.

» The Tribe enters tonight on a nine-game winning streak against Detroit, holding the Tigers to three-or-fewer runs in each of those contests with a 0.78 ERA (7ER/81.0IP) in that span.

» Cleveland owns an overall franchise record of 1086-1118 (.493) against the Tigers in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901-)...the two clubs have combined for six of the last seven A.L. Central division titles.

COOKIE TIME TONIGHT

» Cleveland will send **CARLOS CARRASCO** to the mound to face the Tigers tonight...Carrasco has won both of his starts this season, posting a 2-0 record and 5.40 ERA (7ER/11.2IP).

» Last faced the Tigers on September 11, 2017, tossing 6.0 shutout innings (7H) and striking out nine batters in the Tribe's 11-0 win at Progressive Field...overall compiled a 4-1 record and 1.82 ERA (8ER/39.2IP) in six starts against Detroit last season

» Carrasco is 10-7 with a 3.88 ERA (50ER/116.0IP) with 25 career games (20 starts) vs. the Tigers...has struck out seven-or-more batters in each of his last four starts vs. Detroit, which is tied with Corey Kluber for the longest streak among active starting pitchers.

» Went 12-2 with a 1.94 ERA (23ER/106.2IP) in 16 starts against the A.L. Central division in 2017...has won 11 consecutive decisions against divisional opponents, a span of 12 starts...streak is the 2nd-longest active intradivisional winning streak, behind **Zack Greinke's** 14-decision streak against the N.L. West (STATS-LLC, Mike Pocta - STO).

CENTRAL FOCUS

» The Tribe is playing their second consecutive series against a divisional opponent as they open their 76-game divisional slate.

» **Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 35-9 record (.795) against A.L. Central teams, taking wins in each of their last 13 series vs. divisional opponents...per STATS LLC, this streak is tied with the 1993 Atlanta Braves and the 2004-05 Chicago White Sox for the longest of its kind in the divisional era (1969-)...thanks to Mike Pocta of STO for research assistance.**

» Dominant pitching has been critical to the Indians' divisional success, as the team has posted a 1.75 ERA (51ER/262.0IP) in its last 29 divisional games, allowing two-or-fewer earned runs in 23 of those contests.

» Thanks to a three-game win streak, the Indians are over .500 for the first time this season and remain tied for 1st place in the A.L. Central for the second consecutive day...the Tribe spent 132 days in 1st place last season, including every day from June 26 onward.

LOOKING FOR A SPARK

» After recording 10-or-more hits in 59 games last season (51-8 in those contests), the Indians are now the only team in MLB yet to reach double-digits.

» The Indians rank last in MLB with a .158 team average (55-for-349) and 55 hits...they rank 6th in the American League with 12 home runs this season, while they are tied for the A.L. lead with 10 steals (T3rd in MLB).

» All four of the Indians' wins on this homestand have come with the team recording exactly four hits...in 2017, the Indians recorded just one victory with less than five hits, which came vs. Kansas City on September 17 (3H, won 3-2)...Cleveland is the first team in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) to record four wins over the first 11 games of the season in which they collected four-or-fewer hits.
