SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Eric Lauer** worked 6.0 IP for the first time since May 22 at WSH and tied his career-high of seven strikeouts (2x, last: May 22 at WSH)...owns a 3-1 record with a 2.33 ERA (10 ER, 38.2 IP) when he works 5.0-or-more innings.
 - Made his first career start against an American League opponent.
- **Freddy Galvis** is riding a four game hitting streak, going 9-for-17 (.529) with a home run and four RBI in that time...recorded his 14th double of the season.
- **Franmil Reyes** is hitting .277 (13-for-47) with three doubles and two homers in the month of June.
- **Raffy Lopez** logged his first double of the season...is batting .240 (12-for-50) at home with three homers.
 - Has reached base safely in six of his last seven games.

OAKLAND NOTES

- **Paul Blackburn** tallied a season-high four strikeouts in his first career start against the Padres...is 1-1 with a 4.37 ERA (11 ER, 22.2 IP) in three career interleague starts (all last year).
- **Stephen Piscotty** is hitting .296 (16-for-54) with 13 RBI over his last 16 games after batting .222 with 17 RBI over his first 48 contests.
- **Jed Lowrie** has hit nine of his 10 home runs off right-handed pitchers, eight have come on the road...is 7-for-18 (.389) over his last four games with two doubles and three RBI.
- **Mark Canha** went 2-for-3 tonight and recorded his ninth multi-hit game of the season.
