### TRIBE HEADLINES

» **The Tribe won its 90th game of the season last night, reaching the 90-win mark for the 22nd time in club history...**the Indians have now recorded 90+ victories in three consecutive seasons for the third time in franchise history (1999-2000 and 1950-55)

» **Cleveland is heading to its fourth Postseason in the past six campaigns...**the club's 544-424 (.562) record since the start of 2013 is the best in the A.L. (2nd-best in MLB - LAD, 562-408).

» The Indians have gone 48-26 (.649) vs. the A.L. Central, marking the 3rd-best intradivisional record in MLB (BOS - 51-23, .689; ATL - 48-25, .658)...the club's 2.86 ERA vs. the Central is the lowest by any team against their own division.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** (207K/200.0IP) and **COREY KLUBER** (216K/210.0IP) are the fourth pair of teammates in franchise history with 200+ strikeouts and 200.0+ innings in a single season...also marks the second time in Indians history the Tribe has two such pitchers in consecutive years (1967-68, 2017-18).

### MODEL OF CONSISTENCY

» The Indians are headed to their fourth Postseason in their past six campaigns, all under the management of **Terry Francona**.

» Cleveland has posted a record above .500 in each of the past six seasons, marking the club's longest such streak since doing so in eight straight campaigns from 1994-2001...also represents the 2nd-longest active streak in the American League (NYY - 26 straight seasons) and the 5th-longest in MLB.

» Last night's victory marked the Tribe's 90th of the season...combined with 102 wins in 2017 and 94 wins in 2016, Cleveland has recorded 90+ wins in three consecutive seasons for the third time in franchise history, after also doing so from 1999-2001 and the franchise-long streak of six consecutive seasons from 1950-55.

» Since Francona's tenure began in 2013, the Indians hold the best record in the American League (2nd-best in MLB).

### PLAYOFF PRIMER

» The Indians clinched their third consecutive A.L. Central division title on September 15, their earliest clinch date since doing so on September 8, 1999.

» Boston's victory vs. Baltimore on Monday ensured that they will hold home-field advantage throughout the Postseason...since Houston won and Oakland lost on Sept. 25, the Astros have officially clinched the A.L. West and the #2 seed in the A.L. bracket.

» The Indians and Astros, the American League's last two representatives in the World Series, will officially meet in the ALDS for their first-ever Postseason matchup...Games 1 & 2 will be held in Houston on October 5 & 6, while Cleveland will host Game 3 on October 8 and Game 4 (if necessary) on October 9.

### ROYAL FAREWELL

» The Indians are in Kansas City this weekend to close out the 2018 regular season with four games against the Royals...Tribe has posted an 11-6 record through the first 17 contests of the season series, outscoring the Royals 95-61 in that span.

» Cleveland has gone 6-3 at home and 5-3 in Kansas City this season...the Indians have a 156-167 (.486) record at Kauffman Stadium since the park opened in 1973...this includes a 28-26 (.519) mark since 2013, and the club's 28 wins in that span are the most by any opponent in this ballpark...overall, Tribe owns a 369-334 (.525) record vs. KC, dating back to 1969.

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» Powered by a 10-run 7th inning, the Tribe leveled this series at a game apiece with a 14-6 win last night.

» The Tribe's 10-run frame marked the club's first time scoring 10+ runs in an inning since September 30, 2012 vs. Kansas City (B5th), as well as the club's first such inning in the 7th-or-later since August 9, 2005 at Kansas City (11R, T9th).

» **JOSH DONALDSON** slugged his fifth career grand slam and recorded his second consecutive multi-hit effort, finishing his night 2-for-4 with two runs scored, a double and four RBI.

» **JASON KIPNIS** went 2-for-3 (32nd multi-hit game) and put the Indians on the board with a solo homer in the 3rd...**GREG ALLEN** (2-2, 2R, RBI) and **ADAM ROSALES** (2-2, 3R) recorded multi-hit games off the bench, as Allen capped off the scoring in the 7th inning with an RBI-double.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** notched his career-best 13th win of the season, holding the Royals to one run on three hits, with zero walks allowed and five strikeouts...tossed 6.2 innings, ending the regular season with 200.0 innings pitched for the first time in his career...paired with **COREY KLUBER** (216K/210.0IP), marks the fourth time in franchise history that the Indians have two pitchers with 200K and 200.0IP.

### KLUBER DAY

» **COREY KLUBER** is due to take the mound for the Tribe in the penultimate game of the 2018 regular season tonight at KC.

» Will pitch on regular four days' rest after winning his 20th game in his last start on September 24 at Chicago-AL...struck out 11 batters across 7.0 shutout innings, allowing four hits and one walk...became the first Indians pitcher with 20+ wins in a season since **Cliff Lee** went 22-3 in his 2008 Cy Young campaign.

» Kluber will face the Royals for the fifth time this season, posting a 3-1 record and 3.24 ERA (9ER/25.0IP)...last faced Kansas City on Sept. 5 at Progressive Field (W, 6.2IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 10K).

» Has dominated against the A.L. Central this season, compiling an 11-2 record and 2.27 ERA (24ER/95.0IP) in 15 starts...owns the 3rd-lowest ERA vs. the Central this season (min. 60.0IP), behind **MIKE CLEVINGER** (1.95 ERA) and **TREVOR BAUER** (2.04 ERA).

### STURDY STARTERS

» Tribe starters also have recorded 98 quality starts this season, tops in MLB and Cleveland's most in a single campaign since notching 108 in 1968...overall this year, Indians starters rank 2nd in the A.L. and 3rd in MLB with a 3.39 ERA (HOU - 3.19, LAD - 3.21).

» Cleveland starting pitchers rank 2nd in MLB with 1,085 strikeouts (HOU - 1,085), while they have allowed just 240 walks (T4th-fewest in MLB with Oakland)...Tribe starters' 240 walks allowed is the 2nd-lowest total by the Indians starting staff in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-) behind the 1981 rotation (235BB)...the Tribe rotation's 4.39 K/BB ratio currently stands as the highest in MLB history.

» Indians pitchers have recorded 30 starts with at least 10 strikeouts, tied with Houston for the most in MLB this season and T3rd-most in MLB history, alongside the 2002 Diamondbacks (ARI - 35 in 2001 and CAL - 32 in 1973).

### A PRODIGIOUS BLAST...

» **JOSH DONALDSON**'s grand slam last night marked the Tribe's 11th slam of the season, tied with Cincinnati for tops in MLB...marks the Tribe's 3rd-most grand slams in a single season, as well as the most since hitting a franchise-record 14 in 2006.

» Cleveland hitters are batting a combined .350 (43-123) with the bases loaded this season, the top team batting average in the Majors and the Tribe's best bases-loaded batting average since the 2006 club posted a .382 (58-152) mark.

» The Indians have hit 214 homers overall this year, T5th-most in MLB with Milwaukee...the Tribe's 66 games with two-or-more homers is 3rd-most in the Majors (NYY - 77G & MIL - 67G), as well as tied with the 2000 Indians for the single-season franchise record.

### ...AND A 35.1% CHANCE OF RAIN

» **JOSH DONALDSON** went 2-for-4 with a grand slam last night, the fifth slam of his career...after starting his Indians career 0-for-7, Donaldson is batting .351 (13-37) over his last 46 plate appearances, with two doubles, two homers and seven RBI.

» Since being reunified with his former Toronto teammate, **EDWIN ENCARNACION** has taken flight, batting .372 (16-43) with a double, a triple, three homers, 11 RBI and nine runs scored in 13 games since Sept. 11...Encarnacion's 14 RBI overall in September are 2nd-most on the Tribe, behind **JASON KIPNIS** (19 RBI).

### KIPPING AWAY

» **JASON KIPNIS** slugged his 18th home run of the year last night, marking his 2nd-highest single-season output (23HR in 2016).

» Since August 26, Kipnis is batting .303 (27-89) with seven doubles, seven homers, 26 RBI and 15 runs scored...his RBI total in that span is 2nd-most in the American League, behind **OAK's Stephen Piscotty** (28), as well as 5th-most in the Majors.

### DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 48-26 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 16-5-2 in series play...the Indians' .649 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB behind Boston (BOS - 51-23, .689 vs. A.L. East) and Atlanta (48-25, .658 vs. N.L. East).

» In 71 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.86 ERA (211ER/665.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB.

**TONIGHT'S START**

» Kluber is scheduled to make his 33rd and final start of the 2018 regular season in tonight's contest...will mark his 201st career appearance and 196th start.  
 » Will be pitching on regular four days' rest after notching his career-best 20th win of the season in his last start on September 24 at Chicago-AL...fanned 11 batters in 7.0 shutout innings (4H, 1BB), becoming the first Indians pitcher to reach 20 wins in a season since **Cliff Lee** went 22-8 in his 2008 Cy Young campaign.  
 » Kluber has dominated the A.L. Central this year, owning an 11-2 record and 2.27 ERA (24ER/95.0IP) in 15 starts, the 3rd-lowest ERA vs. the division (min. 60.0IP).  
 » He has tossed 7.0-or-more innings in 20 starts this season, the 2nd-most among MLB starting pitchers (NYM's **Jacob deGrom** - 21).  
 » Kluber has walked 32 batters in his 32 starts this season, tied with Seattle's **Marco Gonzales** for the 2nd-fewest walks allowed among qualified starting pitchers this season, behind St. Louis' **Miles Mikolas** (29)...**Kluber enters play tonight averaging 1.37 walks per 9.0 innings, the lowest rate in the American League.**

**VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL**

» Kluber is due to face the Royals for the fifth time this season and has posted a 3-1 record and 3.24 ERA (9ER/25.0IP) in his four starts...this includes a 1-1 mark and 6.35 ERA (8ER/11.1IP) in two starts this season at Kauffman Stadium.  
 » Last faced Kansas City on September 5 at Progressive Field, holding the Royals to one run on two hits, with one walk and 10 strikeouts in 6.2 innings.  
 » Tonight will mark Kluber's 15th start against an opponent from the A.L. Central division...has posted an 11-2 record and 2.27 ERA (24ER/95.0IP) in his 14 prior starts.  
 » He is holding A.L. Central hitters to a .201 batting average, the 2nd-lowest mark against the division this year (min. 60.0IP), behind Minnesota's **José Berrios** (.193).  
 » Kluber's 2.27 ERA vs. the A.L. Central is the 3rd-lowest against the division this season (min. 60.0IP), behind teammates **MIKE CLEVINGER** (1.95 ERA) and **TREVOR BAUER** (2.04 ERA).

**STRENGTH AND POWER**

» Kluber recorded his 200th strikeout of the season and eclipsed 200 innings this year on Sept. 18...marks his fifth consecutive season reaching those marks, **becoming the only pitcher in Indians franchise history with 200+ strikeouts and 200+ innings pitched in five consecutive seasons.** - *Jordan Bastian, MLB.com*

» Five seasons with 200-or-more strikeouts matched **Bob Feller** (5, 1938-46) for the 2nd-most such campaigns in Tribe history, behind **Sam McDowell** (6, 1965-70)...all five of Kluber's 200+ punchout campaigns have come consecutively, the 2nd-longest streak in franchise history, behind **McDowell's** run of six such seasons from 1965-70.  
 » After earning his 20th win in his last start, Kluber became the sixth pitcher in Indians franchise history (11th time) with 20+ wins, 200+ strikeouts and 200.0+ innings, as well as the first since Hall-of-Famer **Gaylord Perry** did so in 1974 (21-13, 322.1IP, 216K).

**K IS FOR KLUBER**

» Kluber recorded his 1400th career strikeout in the 5th inning of his last start on September 18 vs. Chicago-AL...**coming in his 199th career game, became the second pitcher in MLB history to reach 1400 strikeouts within his first 200 career games, after Randy Johnson (196G).** - *STATS LLC*  
 » He fanned 11 batters in his last start on Sept. 24 at Chicago-AL, marking his 46th career outing with 10+ strikeouts (seventh this season)...**Indians starters have recorded a franchise-record 30 such starts this year, tied with Houston for tops in MLB...**also marked Kluber's 33rd career start with 10+ strikeouts and one-or-fewer walks allowed, the 8th-most such outings by a pitcher in the *Baseball Reference* Play Index era (1908-).

**ON THE ROAD**

» Kluber will make his 16th road start of the season in tonight's contest, compiling a 9-4 record and 3.72 ERA (38ER/92.0IP) in his 15 prior outings.  
 » Across his last five road starts against A.L. Central division opponents, has posted a 4-1 record and 2.94 ERA (11ER/33.2IP) in those outings.

**2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS**

» Kluber has won 18-or-more games each of the last three seasons (2016-), marking the first Indians pitcher with 18-or-more wins in three straight seasons since **Gaylord Perry** (1972-74)...also marks the fourth pitcher since 2000 to do so, alongside **Randy Johnson** (2000-02), **CC Sabathia** (2009-11) and **Justin Verlander** (2009-11). - *STATS LLC*  
 » Kluber was named to the 2018 American League All-Star team, but did not pitch after receiving an injection in his right knee following his July 12 start vs. New York-AL...marked his third career All-Star selection (third consecutive).  
 » Had his career-long walkless innings streak snapped at 46.1 innings on June 15 vs. Minnesota, after issuing a free pass in the 4th inning...**streak marked the longest such run by a Tribe pitcher since Paul Byrd's stretch of 48.0 innings from April 26-June 6, 2007...**also had his quality start streak snapped at 14, the longest streak of quality starts to begin a season by a Tribe starting pitcher since Hall-of-Famer **Stan Coveleski** began the 1918 campaign with a string of 16 consecutive quality starts.  
 » Tossed his 16th career complete game in his first start of the year on March 29 at Seattle...**marked the first Opening Day complete-game by a Cleveland pitcher since Jake Westbrook on April 4, 2005 at Chicago-AL (1-0 loss), and the first such complete game in MLB since Clayton Kershaw threw a complete-game shutout on April 1, 2013 vs. San Francisco...**struck out eight batters, the 2nd-most by a Tribe starter on Opening Day over the last 14 seasons (2005-18), behind **Justin Masterson** (10K on April 5, 2012 vs. Toronto).
