**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Both the Giants and Diamondbacks are coming off 6-1 wins that completed three-game sweeps yesterday, the Diamondbacks over the Marlins and the Giants defeating the Phillies...the Giants will need a sweep to catch the D-Backs in the loss column.

**GIANTS SWEEP PHILLIES:** The Giants limited the Phillies to just one run in 27.0 innings this weekend, with that lone run coming yesterday off the bat of RHP Jake Arrieta, who hit a solo homer off RHP Dereck Rodriguez in the 3rd inning...according to Stats Inc., it was the first time in MLB history a team held an opponent to one run in a three-game series with the one run coming on a homer from a pitcher.

**ON THE MOUND: LHP Derek Holland** seeks his fourth win of the season tonight as he faces the Diamondbacks for the second time in his career... Holland, who has allowed four runs or fewer in each of his last 10 starts, was the unlucky loser in his earlier matchup with Zack Godley and the Diamondbacks on April 9, a 2-1 loss.

**WINNING WAYS:** A win tonight and the Giants would extend their winning streak to a season-best five games...the Giants would also climb back to the .500 mark for the first time since May 20.

**HOT AT HOME:** The Giants are 17-10 (.630) at AT&T Park, winning each of their last five games and 11 of their last 15...San Francisco's .630 home winning percentage ranks as the fourth-best in MLB behind Boston (.714, 20-8), New York-AL (.710, 22-9) and Philadelphia (.679, 19-9).

**FEELING THE DRAFT:** The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft begins today through Wednesday...the Giants have the second overall selection today, their highest pick in 33 years since they drafted **Will Clark** second overall in the 1985 draft...the Giants' estimated timings of today's first two picks are: 4:17 p.m. PT (#2) and 7:40 p.m. PT (#45).

**MEDIA AVAILABILITY: John Barr**, Giants' Vice President & Assistant General Manager, Scouting & International Operations, will be available to the media tonight in the back of the press box at the conclusion of today's first two rounds.

**GIANTS TRANSACTION:** It was announced earlier today that the Baltimore Orioles claimed LHP D.J. Snelten off waivers from the Giants.

**NUMBER OF THE DAY - 5:** The Diamondbacks are 19-0 when scoring at least five runs this season...they're the only unbeaten team in MLB...the Giants are 19-3 (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** The Giants are 26-6 (.813) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 32 games, the Giants are 15-3 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-13 otherwise.

**STARTING STRONG:** Giants starting pitchers enter this series having thrown three-straight quality starts, just the second time all season they've accomplished that (also: April 17-19 at Arizona)...Giants starters have allowed just one run in their last 22.0 innings.

#### This Date in Giants History: June 4, 2009

The Giants beat the Nationals, 5 - 1, in the first half of a doubleheader...**Randy Johnson** allowed two hits and one run in 6.0 innings to win his 300th game in the Major Leagues...he became the first pitcher since Tom Seaver in 1985 to join the 300 win club on his first try and the second-oldest, after Phil Niekro.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#45 LHP Derek Holland**  
**6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)**  
**3-6 Record, 4.94 ERA**

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 12th start in a Giants uniform...has posted a 3-6 record with a 4.94 ERA (32er, 58.1ip) over his first 11 starts.
- Earned the win in his last start on May 30 at Coors Field...threw 5.0 innings, allowing four runs on eight hits in the Giants' 7-4 victory.
- Has pitched well over his last four starts posting a 2-2 record with a 3.86 ERA (10er, 23.1ip).
- Over his last four starts, his curveball has been his best pitch...opposing hitters are 4-for-21 against it (.190) and just 2-for-15 (.133) if you take out the start in Colorado, where it's harder to throw a good curveball (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Opponents are hitting just .213 (16-for-75) off him at AT&T Park this season...over his career he's allowed just 20 hits in 100 at-bats (.200) on the Shores of McCovey Cove, which is the fifth lowest career opponent average at AT&T Park among active pitchers (minimum 25 innings) (Stats, LLC).
- Has received two runs of support or fewer in seven of his 11 starts.
- Has allowed 27 extra-base hits, which is tied for the fourth-most in the National League (16 doubles, two triples, nine home runs)...however, he's allowed just two extra-base hits over his past two starts.
- Has struggled in the 1st inning, allowing a .366 (15-for-41) opponents average and 10 runs over his 11 starts.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .154 clip (6-for-39) while righties are hitting .264 (47-for-178) off him with 25 extra base hits (14 doubles, two triples and nine home runs).
- Has faced the Diamondbacks once in his career...suffered the loss, despite having one of his best starts of the season on April 9...allowed two runs on two hits with eight strikeouts in the Giants' 2-1 loss to the Diamondbacks.
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.

**2017: 4-9, 3.32 ERA / Career: 104-76, 3.01**

**NOTES:** The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill tomorrow for his first start of the 2018 season...has missed all of 2018 with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand...the outing was supposed to be the final tuneup for Bumgarner before he started on Opening Day...made just two rehab starts, one with triple-A Sacramento (3.2ip, 1bb, 8so, 47 pitches) and one with Class A Advanced San Jose (4.2ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 7so)...went 0-3 with a 2.89 ERA in four starts against Arizona last season and will be seeking his first win against the Diamondbacks since July 10, 2016 (a span of five starts without a win vs. ARI).
