RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals look for a three-game series sweep of division-rival Cincinnati today...St. Louis held on for a 6-4 win on Saturday backed by three home runs, **Yadier Molina's** 3-run double, **Michael Wacha's** 11th career win over the Reds, and **Jordan Hicks** first career save...St. Louis began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 3.0 games back of the 1st place Brewers...the Redbirds are 6-4 in their last 10 games and 11-9 over their previous 20.

RED HOT BIRDS: St. Louis has won 13 straight contests against the Reds since September 14, 2017, which is their 2nd-longest win streak against Cincinnati in franchise history, behind an 18-gamer from July 4, 1930-May 23, 1931.

STREAKING: The Cardinals won their 11 straight at Great American Ball Park yesterday, setting a new franchise record for their longest winning streak ever in Cincinnati. The longest road win streak by any team in Cincinnati is held by the Brooklyn Dodgers (19) from June 22, 1947-May 22, 1949. The Cardinals' longest road win streak against the same opponent is 18 against the Pittsburgh Pirates at Forbes Field from May 7, 1964-April 15, 1966.

CHICKS DID THE LONG BALL: The Cardinals have homered in 44 of their first 62 games, going 32-12 (.727 win pct.) in those games (3-15 when not homering)...among NL clubs, only Milwaukee (33-8; .804) has a better winning pct. when going yard...St. Louis' 77 home runs are 5th-most in the NL (MIL is 1st w/ 81).

SECOND HOME: **Yadier Molina** has incredible success at Great American Ballpark with a career .322 average to go with 14 home runs and 57 RBI. Molina has racked up his highest numbers at GABP over all other road ballparks in hits (118), home runs, RBI, doubles (26) and extra base hits (40).

MOLINA MILESTONES: **Yadier Molina** yesterday doubled for the 339th time in his career, tying him with **Ray Lankford** for 9th all-time in Cardinals history (**Jim Bottomley** is 8th with 344)...the three-run double also gave Molina 100 career RBI against Cincinnati and 57 RBI at Great American Ball Park, tying him for 2nd among all visiting players in GABP history with **Albert Pujols** (**Lance Berkman** leads with 58 RBI).

YOUNG GUN: Yesterday, **Jordan Hicks** (21.276) became the 3rd-youngest Cardinal in franchise history and the first since **Rick Ankiel** (20.076, 10/3/99 vs. CHI) to earn a save. The outing also marked Hicks' career-high third appearance in three days and was his first when striking out the side this season.

MR. CARDINAL: The St. Louis Cardinals organization, the St. Louis community and baseball fans everywhere were saddened Wednesday to learn of the passing of Hall of Famer **Albert Fred "Red" Schoendienst** at the age of 95. "Red was one of the greatest Cardinals of all time, and a beloved member of the Cardinals organization for over six decades," said Cardinals Principal Owner & Chief Executive Officer **William O. DeWitt, Jr.** "His influence on this organization cannot be overstated. Red was a great player, a great manager, and a wonderful mentor to countless players, coaches, and members of the front office. He was also a fan favorite who connected with millions of Cardinals fans across multiple generations. He will be sorely missed." Schoendienst was the oldest living member of the National Baseball Hall of Fame.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Cardinals Manager **Mike Matheny** was born in Columbus, Ohio...graduated from Reynoldsburg High School (1988)...his daughter, Katie, played women's ice hockey at The Ohio State University.

Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** and Reds pitcher **Austin Brice** were Marlins teammates in 2016.

Cardinals pitcher **Michael Wacha's** uncle, **Dusty Rogers**, was a Reds first round draft pick in 1984 and played in their minor league organization for five seasons (1984-88).

Cardinals pitcher **Mike Mayers** graduated from nearby Grove City (Ohio) High School.

Cardinals Interpreter **Carlos Villoria** is related to Reds Hall of Fame infielder **Dave Concepción**.

Reds Executive Advisor to the CEO **Walt Jocketty** served as the Cardinals General Manager for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, the Cardinals compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06)...the Cardinals recorded seven straight winning seasons under Jocketty, including a pair of 100+ win seasons ('04-05)...named MLB Executive of the Year (2000, '04, '10).

Reds Player Performance Special Asst. **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Reds interim manager **Jim Riggleman** spent 18 seasons (1976-90, 2005-07) in the Cardinals system as a minor league player (1976-81), minor league coach (AA-Arkansas, 1981), minor league manager (High-A-St. Petersburg, '82-84 & AA-Arkansas, '85-88), Director of Player Development ('88-89), St. Louis First Base Coach (1989-90) and minor league fielding coordinator (2005-07).

Reds assistant pitching/bullpen coach **Ted Power** pitched in 23 games for St. Louis in 1989.

Reds catching coach **Mike Stefanski** played parts for six seasons in the Cardinals minors (1996-2001)...originally acquired by St. Louis from Milwaukee for catcher **Marc Ronan** (Nov. 19, 1995).

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons for St. Louis from 1986-90.

Reds Special Assistant to the General Manager, Player Personnel **Cam Bonifay** worked for the Cardinals as a special assistant, evaluating the American League East from October of 2007-08.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **Marty Maier** spent 24 seasons with St. Louis as an area scout, Latin American coordinator, asst. director of scouting, scouting director and special asst. to the GM.

Reds pro scout **Bruce Manno** worked in the Cardinals front office for six seasons as Director of Player Development (2002-06) and Senior Director of Pro Scouting & Special Assistant to the General Manager (2007) before joining Atlanta.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds during his final professional season in 2010.

Reds broadcaster **George Grande** was a Cardinals play-by-play announcer for two seasons (1991-92).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds, and a shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...is father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds President and Chief Executive Office **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were investors in the Cardinals from 1995-2006...their interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

Reds Media Relations Intern **Ben Barnette** was a 2015 Cardinals Spring Training Intern and 2016 Memphis Redbirds (AAA) Media Relations Intern.
