### BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Lost a game when recording 11 hits for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time this year (also 7/12 at BOS)...Matched a season high with 13 runners left on base (also 5/3 (Game 1) at CLE)...Fall to 11-25 in games vs. left-handed starters, the most such losses in the Majors (35-28 vs. RHPs)...Lost for first time since the All-Star break (now 3-1).
- LUIS SANTOS** made his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB start and allowed a run over 2.0 innings...Gave up 3 hits and allowed a walk while recording 3 strikeouts...Has at least 1 strikeout in all 16 of his career MLB appearances for a 9.45 SO/9 (28 SO/26.2 IP).
- LOURDES GURRIEL Jr.** got the Jays on the board with a solo HR in the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning...Was his 5<sup>th</sup> home run and his 4<sup>th</sup> solo shot...Became the 13<sup>th</sup> player in Blue Jays history to homer 5+ times in his first 33 MLB games (12<sup>th</sup> with 16+ RBI and 14<sup>th</sup> with 33+ hits)...Also walked and singled to extend his multi-hit streak to 6 games, **becoming the 3<sup>rd</sup> rookie in team history with a multi-hit streak of 6+ games (Al Woods - 7G in 1977; John Olerud - 6G in 1990)**...Has hits in each of his last 12 starts, batting .408 (20-for-49) with 2-2B, 3-HR and 9-RBI over that span...Now batting .288 for the year...His .281 AVG coming into tonight ranked T-5<sup>th</sup> among AL rookies (min. 100 PA).
- JUSTIN SMOAK** singled twice and doubled in his 3-for-5 evening...Was his 7<sup>th</sup> 3+ hit game this season, surpassing Yangervis Solarte for the team lead...Has now gone 18-for-51 (.353) with 5-2B, 5-HR, 11-RBI and 7BB/12K over his last 13 contests (.431 OBP, 1.176 OPS).
- DEVON TRAVIS** went 2-for-5 on a pair of singles...Is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with 3-XBH and 8-RBI over his last 16 games...Has boosted his batting average from .141 to .244 since 5/22.
- KENDRYS MORALES** had a pair of singles and drove in a run...Has gone 36-for-112 (.321) with 7-2B, 7-HR and 13-RBI over his last 36 contests.
- JAIME GARCIA** retired all 9 batters he faced (3K) for his 2<sup>nd</sup> longest career relief outing (4.0 on 9/21/16 at COL).

### TWINS NOTES:

- Earned their 1<sup>st</sup> win of their road trip and are now 1-3 to start the unofficial second half...Evened their season series with the Jays, 2-2, and improved to 13-12 vs. AL East opponents this season...Have homered in 10 straight games vs. Toronto (19 HR)...Recorded 13+ hits for the 7<sup>th</sup> time this year (4<sup>th</sup> time in July).
- ADALBERTO MEJIA** was recalled from Triple-A Rochester prior to the game to make his 2<sup>nd</sup> start of the season...Allowed a lone run over 5.1 innings (1ER, 1BB, 3K)...Was his longest start since 5.1 IP on 7/17/17 vs. NYY...Earned his first W since 7/3/17 vs. LAA.
- LOGAN MORRISON** drove in 2 runs with a 3<sup>rd</sup>-inning double, then added another RBI with a solo HR to lead off the 5<sup>th</sup>...Was his 12<sup>th</sup> HR of the season...Marked his 3<sup>rd</sup> 3-RBI game of the season (last: 6/16 at CLE).
- MAX KEPLER** notched his 13<sup>th</sup> home run of the year with a two-run blast in the 5<sup>th</sup>...Has hit 7 HR vs. AL East teams...Has homered in back-to-back games for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time this season (also 7/6-7 vs. BAL).
- EDUARDO ESCOBAR** opened the scoring with an RBI triple in the 1<sup>st</sup> inning...Was his 3<sup>rd</sup> triple of the season (last: 6/13 at DET)...Entered tonight with 52 XBH, 5<sup>th</sup> most in the AL...Drove in another run in the 4<sup>th</sup> inning and finished the night 2-for-3 with a walk and 2-RBI.
- JOE MAUER** singled twice, doubled, scored a run and recorded an RBI in a 3-for-5 night...Has 5 3-hit games this season, all of which have come since 6/29...Over that time, has hit .349 (29-for-83) with 6-2B, 2-HR and 17-RBI.
- MITCH GARVER** had a pair of singles and a double as part of his 3-for-4 effort...The 3 hits tied a season high (3<sup>rd</sup> time)...Was his 11<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season and his 5<sup>th</sup> since 6/23...Over that span, has gone 16-for-45 (.356) with 4-XBH and 7-RBI while walking 10 times (9K) for a .473 OBP (1.028 OPS).
