**TODAY'S GAME:** After a 5-1 homestand, the Giants are off to a good start on this 10-game road trip that includes stops in Washington (1-0), Miami and Los Angeles-NL...the Giants enter today's game having won seven of their last eight games and just 1.5 games back of the first-place Diamondbacks in the NL West.

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Dereck Rodriguez** will make his second Major League start today...he allowed one run and five hits in 6.0 innings of a 6-1 victory last Sunday vs. Philadelphia...Rodriguez is the son of Hall of Fame catcher Ivan Rodriguez, who finished his career with the Nationals and is here this weekend.

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** The Giants are 29-6 (.829) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 35 games, the Giants are 18-3 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-14 otherwise...SF is 22-3 (.880) when scoring at least five runs a game.

**NBA CHAMPS:** Congratulations to the Golden State Warriors, winners of their third championship in four years...Golden State became just the ninth team in NBA history to achieve a Finals sweep.

**#BAYAREAUNITE:** The Bay Area has seen six championships between the Giants (2010, 2012, 2014) and Warriors (2015, 2017, 2018) since 2010...according to Stats, LLC, the last time a metropolitan area won six-plus titles in a nine-year span was Boston from 2003-11 (Patriots twice, Red Sox twice, Celtics once, Bruins once)...the last time the Bay Area did so was 1973-81 (A's twice, Raiders twice, Warriors once, 49ers once).

**CRAWFORD SINCE MAY 1:** Beginning May 1, Crawford has hit safely in all but four of his last 34 games, batting a MLB-best .425 (54-for-127) with 14 doubles, five homers and 25 RBI...he's raised his batting average by 138 points from .189 to his current .327 mark, which ranks as the fourth-best in the National League.

**SCORE FIRST:** The Giants are 20-9 (.690) this season when they score the games first run.

**NO REST FOR THE WEARY:** Yesterday was the start of 17-straight games without an off day for the Giants, matching their longest stretch of the season...in fact, the Giants are at the beginning of a stretch in which they play in 36 of the next 38 days leading up to the All-Star Break...SF's only off days in this span are June 25 and July 12.

**ROAD WOES:** San Francisco is just 13-20 (.394) on the road this season, the third-lowest winning percentage in the NL...the Giants have lost each of their last five road series and will be seeking their first road series win since sweeping the Braves in Atlanta from May 4-6.

**IN THE BULLPEN:** Giants relievers the last eight games have combined to allow four runs (three earned) on 16 hits, eight walks and 38 strikeouts in 30.2 innings pitched (0.88 ERA).

**IN A PINCH:** Giants pinch-hitters have combined for a .270 batting average (27-for-100) with six doubles, three homers and 15 RBI...that .270 clip is the third-best in the National League behind Chicago (.305) and Milwaukee (.282).

### This Date in Giants History: June 9, 2015

**Chris Heston** threw the first no-hitter of the season in his 14th career start, a 5-0 Giants win over the Mets...Heston struck out 11 and walked none, but hit three batters with pitches...it was the fifth no-hitter by a Giants pitcher in seven years.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez**  
**6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992)**  
**1-0 Record, 1.93 ERA**

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make second Major League start (third appearance) today.
- Won his first career start in the Giants' 6-1 victory over the Phillies on June 3, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings...threw his curveball about 17 MPH slower than he threw his fastball and it gave the Phillies a lot of trouble...he threw 16 of 23 for strikes and they made six outs against it without getting a hit (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Became the first Giants pitcher to earn his first win in his first Major League start since **Ryan Sadowski** did it on June 28, 2009 at MIL...prior to Rodriguez, the last Giants pitcher to win his first MLB start was **Joe Martinez** on Aug. 5, 2009 at HOU.
- Made his Major League debut on May 29 at COL when he replaced **RHP Jeff Samardzija**, who left the game after 1.0 inning with a tight right shoulder...pitched 3.1 innings, allowing four runs (one earned) on five hits...was removed from the game after being hit in the shin by a 108-mph comebacker...was diagnosed with a shin contusion.
- Made nine starts for Sacramento this season, his first at the triple-A level...went 4-1 with a 3.40 ERA (19er, 50.1ip).
- Struck out 53 batters in 50.1 innings of work...his 53 strikeouts led the Rivercats and ranked tied for ninth in the PCL at the time of his call up.
- Allowed 11 home runs over his nine starts with triple-A Sacramento.
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee and posted a 9.00 ERA (6er, 60ip) in four games (one start).
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez, who is here this weekend watching his son for the first time.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.
- Went 23-25 with a 3.56 ERA in 81 career games (61 starts) in the Twins' system.
