CARDINALS NOTES

- **Jack Flaherty** made his eighth start of the season, first against the Padres in 2018 (1-0) and second career start vs. the Padres (1-0)...is making his 3rd straight home start (1-1)...had allowed 10 runs in his last two starts after holding his opposition to seven runs in his first five games...recorded his second hit of the season (last: 5/20/18 vs. PHI)...has held his opponents to only one run in 5-of-8 starts this season.
- **José Martínez** tallied his 10th three-hit game of the season, now leading the National League...extended his hitting streak to nine games (17-32, .531), one shy of his career-high in 2017...has reached base safely in each of his last 11 games...hit his 5th home run in the month of June, his most in any career calendar month...has hit all 10 HR off RHP this season after splitting his 14 home runs between RHP (7) and LHP (7) in 2017.
- **Marcell Ozuna** hit his first home run on an 0-2 count this season (6th career)...also his first home run this season on a two-strike count...extended his hitting streak to five games (7-20, .350) and has hit safely in 9 of his last 10 games (15-38, .395)...has an RBI in three straight games...has back-to-back multi-hit games (20, season).
- **Tommy Pham** has hit safely in six straight games (8-26, .308) tying his season high streak for 2018.
- **Sam Tuivailala** threw his 4th wild pitch of the season, establishing his new single-season mark.
- **Yadier Molina** collected his 11th multi-hit game of the season and second in last three games.
- **Jedd Gyorko** has hit 9 HR in 15 career games against the Padres (his former team)...with 5 of those 9 at Busch Stadium...last home run was hit against the Padres a month ago (5/11 at PETCO Park).
- The **Cardinals** have tallied 11 or more hits in three of their last four home games...have hit three home runs in 3-of-their-last-4 games and have hit 3 or more HR in nine games this season...are 18-4 in games in which they homer at Busch Stadium...are 6-1 when **Marcell Ozuna** homers in a game.

PADRES NOTES

- **Jordan Lyles** made his seventh start (20th app.) of the season, second against the Cardinals in 2018 (0-2) and fourth career start (8th app.) vs. the Cardinals (0-3)...lost his first matchup vs. STL at PETCO Park on May 10, allowing two runs over 5.0 innings but took the loss...both of his wins this season have come in San Diego...has allowed 11 hits in consecutive games (6/5 vs. ATL)...tonight was his longest outing of the season in which he did not walk a batter (6.0 IP)...surrendered two home runs in 4 of his last 5 starts.

- **Cory Spangenberg** hit his 4th home run (out of six total) against N.L. Central opponents this season...hit his 3rd home run in the month of June, his most since hitting five in August 2017...has three home runs in his last six games.
- **Raffy Lopez** snapped an 0-for-10 with a single in the 2nd inning.
- **Travis Jankowski** has hit safely in each of his last four games vs. STL (7-18, .389)...his seven hits vs. STL this season are the 4th-most by a non-divisional opposing player (Jay Bruce, NYM 8; Yoenis Céspedes, NYM 8; Eddie Rosario, MIN 8).
- **Hunter Renfro** recorded his first RBI since June 3 vs. CIN.
- The **Padres** have played 68 games this season, tied with the Texas Rangers (27-41) for the most in MLB...have been held to two runs or less in 26 games this season, T3rd-most among MLB teams this season (Miami 30, Baltimore 27) entering today...surrendered three or more home runs for the 9th game this season (1-8)...have lost their first game of a new road series for the 6th straight time after starting the season 4-0 in those games (4-6).
