NATIONALS NEWS

MAD MAX

The Washington Nationals snapped their three-game losing streak on Saturday afternoon, topping the Colorado Rockies, 6-2...**Max Scherzer** struck out 11 batters in 7.0 innings of work, allowing just two earned runs on one hit...He retired the final 20 batters he faced following a **Charlie Blackmon** home run in the first inning.

- Scherzer's 11 strikeouts marked his third game of 10+ strikeouts in 2018...He is the 13th pitcher in Major League history to record at least 10 strikeouts in three of the team's first 15 games of the season.
- Following Sunday's series finale against the Rockies, the Nationals will embark on a 10-day, nine-game road trip that will include games against the New York Mets (3 G), Los Angeles Dodgers (3 G) and San Francisco Giants (3 G).

START ME UP

Derek Lilliquist's starting pitching staff leads the National League (5th in MLB) with a 3.18 ERA and 106 strikeouts (2nd in MLB)...Additionally, the staff ranks in the National League in opp. AVG (1st, .211), opp. OBP (1st, .270), hits per 9.0 IP (1st, 7.05), WHIP (1st, 1.08), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 3.93, strikeouts per 9.0 IP (2nd, 10.52), and opp. SLG (3rd, .377).

- Max Scherzer** (5th, 2.33), **Gio Gonzalez** (11th, 2.20), and **Stephen Strasburg** (12th, 2.21) rank in the top 12 in ERA in the National League.
- Scherzer paces the NL with 38 strikeouts, while Strasburg (T8th, 21) and Gonzalez (10th, 20) join him in the top 10.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT THE BULLPEN

Nationals relievers have allowed just two of 16 inherited runners to score this season...Their 12.5% inherited runners scored percent ranks second in the National League and fourth in Major League Baseball...They are one of two National League teams (and one of five in MLB) to allow two or fewer inherited runners to score.

- Henry Blanco's** bullpen has also been strong when it comes to striking out batters...Washington's relievers lead the National League and rank second in Major League Baseball with 11.54 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (behind NYY - 13.34)...Their 62 strikeouts rank fourth in the National League.
- Sean Doolittle** and **Sammy Solis** are tied for seventh in the National League with 13 strikeouts.

LEADING MAN

Bryce Harper clubbed his sixth home run of the season last Sunday, a two-run shot in the first inning off **Matt Harvey**...His six home runs and 1.143 OPS lead Major League Baseball while he is tied for first with 17 walks...Harper ranks among National League hitters in runs scored (3rd, 14), slugging percentage (2nd, .688), RBI (4th, 13), and on-base percentage (5th, .456).

- Of his 14 hits this season, seven have been extra base hits (2B, 6 HR)...Moreover, Harper has 17 walks and just 10 strikeouts through the first 15 games of the season.

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick saw his hitting streak snapped at 10 games on Friday Night...He clubbed his first home run of the season on Thursday night, a solo shot in the fifth inning off Chad Bettis...The home run extended his hitting streak to 10 games.

- Kendrick has reached base safely in 10 of 12 games of the season...He was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded five multi-hit efforts along the way, while seven of his 15 hits have been extra base hits (6 2B, HR).
- Kendrick is tied for sixth in the National League with six doubles.
- Since joining the Nationals prior to the 2017 trade deadline, Kendrick is hitting .299 with 14 doubles, two triples, eight homers, 31 RBI, four stolen bases and 24 runs scored in 64 games...He has posted a .344 on-base percentage and a .498 slugging percentage.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Since being recalled on April 2, **Pedro Severino** has posted a .455 on-base percentage (8 H, 5 BB, 2 HBP)...He has hit safely in six of his nine games played, including five of his last six games.

- In seven starts, he is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two doubles, three RBI, five walks, one stolen base and three runs scored...He has recorded two multi-hit efforts and driven in runs in three of the eight starts.

FUN IN THE FIRST

Washington's offense has scored at least one run in the first inning in nine of 15 games...In total, the Nationals have scored 18 runs in the first inning, ahead of the Arizona Diamondbacks (16) for the most in Major League Baseball.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 15 (6-4 on this date)

2011 - Tied at 3-3 in the bottom of the 10th against the Brewers, Jayson Werth reached on an error and later advanced to second base on a heads-up play and stole third. Werth later scored on Adam LaRoche's fielder's choice giving the Nationals the 4-3 walk-off win.

IN THE COMMUNITY

April 15: Jackie Robinson Day

On Sunday the Nationals, Major League Baseball and the entire baseball family will pay homage to the contributions of **Jackie Robinson** and his enduring impact on society and the game of baseball. The Nationals are honored to be joined by Medal of Freedom winner and civil rights icon, Congressman **John Lewis**, who will be throwing out the ceremonial first pitch.

OPPONENT

COLORADO ROCKIES

Henry Blanco spent the 1999 season with the Colorado Rockies...**Ian Desmond** spent seven Major League seasons in Washington from 2009-15...This will be his his first action against his former team, as he was on the disabled list during the 2017 matchups.

THE SERIES

The Nationals and Rockies will play four games this weekend in D.C. and will not match up again until the final series of the season, Sept. 28-30 at Colorado...The Rockies have won six of the last eight games at Nationals Park since Aug. 27, 2016.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#37 - STEPHEN STRASBURG - RHP

Tall, powerful right-handed pitcher is a three-time All-Star who is Washington's all-time (2005-present) leader in wins (85) and strikeouts (1,301)... On May 10, 2016, he inked a seven-year contract extension that will keep him with the Nationals through the 2023 season...

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: Faces the Colorado Rockies for the ninth time and first since 2016...Is 4-4 with a 3.97 ERA and 56 strikeouts with just nine walks in those nine starts...Has allowed four home runs.

LAST START: Allowed just three hits while striking out eight batters and walking two in 8.0 shutout innings on April 10 vs. ATL...It was his longest outing since Sept. 10, 2017 at PHI (8.0 IP)...Earned his second win as Washington topped Atlanta, 4-1.

2018 NOTES

- Is tied for eighth in the National league with 21 strikeouts.
- Since Aug. 19, 2017, he leads Major League Baseball with a 1.22 ERA (10 ER/74.0 IP) among pitchers with at least 10 starts...Among National League pitchers during this stretch, he leads in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.60), opp. AVG (.183), opp. OBP (.235), opp. SLG (.260) while ranking second in strikeouts (84) and home runs allowed per 9.0 IP (0.49).
- Opened his 2018 season by tossing 6.1 innings while allowing one earned run as Washington topped Cincinnati, 13-7, on March 31...The lone earned run came via fourth inning home run by **Scott Schebler**.

2017 NOTES

- Put together a strong first half of the season en route to being named an All-Star for the third time in his career.
- Was a finalist for the National League Cy Young Award...Capped 2017 being named National League Pitcher of the Month in September.
- Ranked third in the National League (4th in MLB) with a career-best 2.52 ERA...Ranked second in the NL in FanGraphs.com WAR (5.6).
- Also ranked in NL in HR/9.0 IP (1st, 0.67), opp. SLG (1st, .317), opp. OPS (2nd, .581), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opp. OBP (3rd, .265), & opp. AVG (3rd, .204).
- Coupled with Max Scherzer (2nd, 2.51) and Gio Gonzalez (5th, 2.96), Strasburg (3rd, 2.52), helped the Nationals become the first team with three starting pitchers ranking in the top five in the NL in ERA in 21 years (since the 1996 Atlanta Braves), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*.
- On May 27 at San Diego, he struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 shutout innings.
- On Aug. 19 at San Diego, he returned from a three-week stint on the disabled list...He went 5-1 with a 0.84 ERA (5 ER/53.2 IP) in his final eight starts of the regular season following reinstatement...He racked up 63 strikeouts, allowed just 10 walks and surrendered only one home run.
- All told, went 6-1 with a 0.86 ERA in 10 starts after the All-Star break...Via *Elias*, it was the second-lowest post-ASB ERA in MLB history for any pitcher with at least 10 starts...Jake Arrieta had a 0.75 ERA after the break in 2015.
- Recorded a 35.0 scoreless innings streak from that first start back from the DL in San Diego (Aug. 19) that ran until Sept. 17, when an unearned run ended the historic stretch...It was the longest consecutive scoreless innings streak in franchise history (Nationals/Expos) and, per *Elias*, the longest for any player in the Major Leagues since 2015 (**Greinke**, 45.2 IP; **Kershaw**, 37.0 IP).
- Was dominant in the NLDS...Was saddled with the loss in Game 1 despite striking out 10 batters in 7.0 innings without allowing an earned run.
- He pushed aside a virus that had made him ill for much of the week, to rack up 12 strikeouts (re-setting his own Postseason franchise record for single-game strikeouts) over 7.0 scoreless innings in Washington's Game 4 victory.

CAREER NOTES

- Is 80-43 with a 3.09 ERA in 174 starts since Sept. 6, 2011...When starting, Washington is 119-68 (.636) since his debut.
- Since 2012, he ranks among active pitchers in opp. SLG (3rd, .351), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 10.44), opp. AVG (6th, .224), strikeouts (7th, 1,193), opp. OBP (7th, .280), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.43), and ERA (8th, 3.10).
