THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Kansas City and 1-1 vs. New York-AL...tonight they will complete their homestand with the third of three vs. the Yankees...after tonight's game, the Twins will make their final roadtrip of the season with four at Kansas City Thursday-Sunday, three at Detroit September 17-19 and three at Oakland September 21-23.

THE JOE MAUER GAME: The Twins beat the Yankees last night by a score of 10-5, snapping their eight-game losing streak to the Yankees...Tyler Duffey was the Opening Pitcher, allowing one run on 2.0 innings pitched...Kohl Stewart was the Primary Pitcher, allowing three runs on two hits in 3.1 innings pitched, earning his first major league win...the Twins had 13 hits, two from Joe Mauer who hit his fifth career grand slam in the fifth inning.

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins are playing the seventh and final game vs. the Yankees this season...the Twins win last night snapped their eight-game losing streak to New York (excludes the 2017 AL Wild Card Game)...a win tonight would give the Twins their first series victory over the Yankees since taking two of three at Target Field July 17-19, 2017; they have lost two straight series since then, both in New York.

☞ They have not won two straight games vs. NYY since winning three straight July 13-14, 2013 and May 30, 2014.

YANKEES WITH TWINS TIES:

☞ Aaron Hicks was drafted by the Twins 14th overall in the 2008 First-Year Player Draft...he was traded to the Yankees in exchange for John Ryan Murphy in November of 2015...Murphy was traded to Arizona in exchange for left-handed pitcher Gabriel Moya in July of 2017.

☞ Lance Lynn was signed by the Twins in March and was traded to New York with cash in exchange for right-handed pitcher Luis Rijo and Tyler Austin on July 30.

☞ Third base coach Phil Nevin was acquired by the Twins from Chicago-NL in August of 2006, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Adam Harben...Nevin played 16 games for the Twins down the stretch, hitting .190 (8-for-42) with one home run and four RBI.

EXTRA-BASE MAUER: Joe Mauer recorded his 597th extra-base hits last night tying Tony Oliva for fourth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

MINNESOTA, NICE: The Twins have gone 42-31 at home this season, compared to 24-47 on the road...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 23-11 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the fifth best home winning percentage in baseball (.676), trailing Boston (.765), Tampa Bay (.757), Oakland (.743) and Chicago-NL (.686).

BAT MAN ROBBIE: Robbie Grossman is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with six doubles, six RBI, 11 walks and a .452 on-base percentage in his last 20 games, since August 5...since that date his OBP ranks seventh best in baseball (minimum of 50 at-bats)...additionally, he has 22 doubles on the season, matching his single-season career-high, done in 2017...he has 88 hits (career-high 94 in 2017), has 39 RBI (career-high 45 in 2017).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/BASEBALL HISTORY: In 1986, the Twins replaced Manager Ray Miller with Tom Kelly...the Twins won the first game managed by Kelly over the Texas Rangers 4-2 in the Metrodome...TK went on to becoming the winningest Manger in Twins history, going 1140-1244, winning two World Championships ('87 & '91) and had his number 10 retired by the Twins in 2012...additionally, in 1993, Paul Molitor drove in his 100th run of the year in the Blue Jays 4-1 win over California...he became the oldest player in major league history to record his first 100-RBI season.
