THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-0 thus far on their 11-game homestand, sweeping the Orioles in four games, followed by a victory over the Royals last night...tonight they will play the second of three with Kansas City...after this series, the Twins will host Tampa Bay for four games from Thursday-Sunday, leading up to the break...the Twins have gone 25-20 at home this season (9-3 in their last 12).

TWINS MAKE IT FIVE STRAIGHT: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 3-1, their fifth straight victory, tying a season-high (May 4-8)...José Berríos (9-7) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on six hits in 7.0 innings pitched with no walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits (1 extra-base hit), three singles-a-piece from both Joe Mauer and Eduardo Escobar.

#ACCEPTTHISROSIE: Eddie Rosario is one of the five AL final vote candidates, along with Giancarlo Stanton, Andrew Benintendi, Jean Segura and Andrelton Simmons...the Twins have had six previous final vote nominees: Lew Ford (2004), Torii Hunter (2005), Francisco Liriano (2006), Pat Neshek (2007), Delmon Young (2010) and Brian Dozier (2015), none of which ever won the vote...since May 1, Rosario is hitting .324 (84-for-259) with 19 doubles, 15 home runs, 42 RBI, 17 walks and a .945 OPS...below are his AL ranks on the season:

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the fifth of 19 games this season...they have gone 2-2 against KC this season...a win tonight would secure the series win, which would mark their first since May 19-21, going 0-3-1 since.

☞ Eddie Rosario has hit safely in nine straight vs. the Royals...in his last 13 games vs. KC, he is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with 11 RBI.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .319 (236-for-739) with 44 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 121 RBI and a .404 on-base percentage in 199 career games against the Royals...he leads all actives in walks vs. KC.

INSIDE THE STREAK: The current five-game winning streak is tied for longest this season, previously done May 4-8...their last six-game win-streak came August 6-11, 2017...other notes during the streak:

- ☞ Twins have out-scored opponents 29-10 and out-hit 50-37.
- ☞ Twins are hitting .294 (50-for-170) with 10 doubles, six home runs and 5.8 runs-per-game...349 (15-for-43) with runners in scoring position.
- ☞ Pitchers have posted a 2.00 ERA (45.0 IP, 10 ER) with an opponent batting average of .222...starters have posted a 1.69 ERA (32.0 IP, 6 ER) with opponents hitting .209.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Twins have gone 14-7 in their last 21 home games, including a six-game winning streak that dates back to June 24 vs. Texas...it marks their longest winning streak at home since August 17-31, 2017, when they won seven straight.

ALL-STAR FLASHBACKS: Notables on past All-Star games played on this day:

- ☞ In 2012 at Kauffman Stadium, the NL beat the AL 8-0...Joe Mauer was the Twins lone representative, playing 2.0 innings at first base, singling off Arizona's Wade Miley in his only plate appearance.
- ☞ In 2007 at AT&T Park, Twins representatives Justin Morneau and Torii Hunter both went 0-for-2 off the AL bench and Johan Santana pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief with two strikeouts in a 5-4 AL victory.
- ☞ In 2001 at Safeco Field, Cristian Guzman made a pinch hit appearance and struck out in his one at-bat...Joe Mays pitched 1.0 perfect inning of relief...Eric Milton did not appear.
- ☞ In 1990 at Wrigley Field, Kirby Puckett represented the Twins in his fifth of 10 career All-Star appearances...he pinch hit for Ken Griffey, Jr. in the eighth inning and singled off Cincinnati's Randy Myers in his only plate appearance.

MALL BALL: This afternoon the Twins hosted a surprise downtown wiffle ball home run derby for Twin Cities residents, visitors and Twins fans on the newly renovated Nicollet Mall...players that attended include Eduardo Escobar, Jorge Polanco, Ehre Adrianza, Eddie Rosario, Kyle Gibson, José Berríos, Fernando Rodney and Robbie Grossman.
