## **WASHINGTON NATIONALS (4-5)**

- -RF Bryce Harper opened up the scoring with a two-run home run off RHP Matt Harvey in the first inning...He added two singles and two walks...Six of Harper's nine hits this season have been home runs...Harper's six home runs lead Major League Baseball and his 12 RBI rank second.
- -In the bottom fourth inning **C Pedro Severino** doubled to left field and drove in **SS Trea Turner** to put the Nationals within one run, 4-3...He has reached base safely in 10 of 14 plate appearances (5 H, 3 BB, 2 HBP) since joining the Nationals.
- -With a single in the fourth and seventh inning **2B Howie Kendrick** has reached safely in his first eight games...He has hit safely in seven of his eight games.
- -RHP Shawn Kelley tossed a perfect sixth inning with one strikeout...He has retired all nine batters he's faced this season.

## **NEW YORK METS (7-1)**

RHP Matt Harvey threw 5.0 IP and allowed nine hits and four earned runs with two strikeouts and one walk...He allowed a 2-run home run to RF Bryce Harper in the first inning...It was Harvey's 11<sup>th</sup> home run allowed to the Nationals over the course of his career.

- **1B Adrián González** went 1-for-5 with four RBI...His grand slam in the top of the third inning gave the Mets a 4-2 lead...The home run was his first home run of the season...It was his sixth career grand slam and his first since July 24, 2016 at St. Louis (Mayers)...The grand slam was González's fifth career home run at Nationals Park.
- **2B Asdrúbal Cabrera** hit his first home run of the season in the top of the fifth inning to give the Mets a 5-3 lead...The home run was Cabrera's first since September 30, 2017 at Philadelphia (Morgan)...It was his third career home run as a visiting player at Nationals Park.
- **-LF Yoenis Céspedes'** (1-6, 1 RBI) singled in pinch hitter **Juan Lagares** in top of the 12<sup>th</sup> inning to give the Mets a 6-5 lead...The RBI was Céspedes' eighth of the season.
