TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians' 33-28 record through 61 games sits two games ahead of the 102-win 2017 club (31-30)...Cleveland is the only divisional leader in MLB with a lead larger than 1.5 games, as they enter play tonight with a season-high 5.0-game lead over second-place Detroit.

» Cleveland owns a 15-3 record in its last 18 games vs. Detroit, posting a 1.91 team ERA (34ER/160.0IP) in that span.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is set to make his first start this season against the Detroit Tigers...he posted a 4-0 record with a 0.76 ERA (2ER/23.2IP) in four starts vs. the Tigers in 2017.

» **YONDER ALONSO** is batting .360 (18-50) over his past 15 games with two homers, four doubles, 12 RBI and nine runs scored.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians opened their three-game set at Comerica Park with a dramatic 4-1 victory over the Tigers.

» With the score tied 1-1 in the top of the 9th inning, **JASON KIPNIS** delivered a two-out, three-run homer to give the Tribe their margin of victory...marked Cleveland's fourth go-ahead home run this season in the 9th inning or later, as well as the first since **GREG ALLEN**'s walk-off solo homer on May 27 vs. Houston.

» **YONDER ALONSO** collected three of the Indians' seven hits and drove in the Tribe's first run with an RBI-double in the top of the 4th inning.

» **TREVOR BAUER** earned his 5th win of the season with another dominant performance against Detroit...after allowing back-to-back doubles to open the game, Bauer did not yield another run, finishing the game with one run allowed on seven hits over 8.0 innings of work...also fanned 12 batters, finishing with double-digit strikeouts for a third consecutive start...**CODY ALLEN** worked a scoreless 9th inning for his 12th save of 2018.

BAUER UNPACKED

» **TREVOR BAUER**'s commanding performance last night improved him to 3-0 in three starts this season vs. Detroit with a 1.17 ERA (3ER/23.0IP).

» Bauer has also struck out 10-or-more batters in each of his last three starts, a career-long streak...he is one of just six pitchers in Indians franchise history to turn the trick, joining **COREY KLUBER** (done 3x), **CC Sabathia**, **Chuck Finley**, **Sam McDowell** (done 5x) and **Bob Feller** (done 2x).

» Bauer now owns a team-high 109 strikeouts, good for 4th-most in the American League...he also ranks 3rd in the A.L. with 11.4 strikeouts per 9.0 innings and 6th with a 2.62 ERA.

MOTOWN MATCHUP

» The Indians and Tigers are squaring off this weekend in the third of six scheduled series between the clubs, including their second set here at Comerica Park.

» The Tribe owns a 6-2 record against the Tigers through eight matchups...the teams first met from April 9-12 at Progressive Field, where Cleveland recorded a four-game sweep, outscoring Detroit 18-5...the Tigers took two of three contests in Detroit from May 14-16, snapping an 11-game losing streak vs. the Indians.

» Cleveland has gone 15-3 vs. Detroit since July 7, 2017, allowing three-or-fewer runs in all 15 of their wins...over that span, Tribe pitching has posted a 1.91 ERA (34ER/160.0IP).

» The Indians own an overall franchise record of 1090-1120 (.493) against the Tigers in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901)...the two clubs have combined for six of the last seven A.L. Central division titles.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» This afternoon's contest marks the second of 16 consecutive scheduled games against A.L. Central opponents, Cleveland's longest divisional stretch of the season...with the exception of the team's recent two-game set vs. Milwaukee, 23 of the Tribe's 25 contests from May 28 - June 20 are set to come against divisional opponents.

» Cleveland has gone 15-8 thus far against the A.L. Central, going 4-2-1 across seven completed series...the club's .652 intra-divisional winning percentage is currently 4th-best in the American League (5th in MLB)...the Tribe is 4-6 in divisional road games, compared to 11-2 at Progressive Field.

» **Lake County (A): 25-36, 7th (-14.0 G)** » 6/8: **L, 4-5 at Great Lakes** » Today: **7:05 at Great Lakes**
Jesse Berardi was 2-for-4 with a pair of singles...Ernie Clement (1-3) and Ulysses Cantú (1-4) both had doubles.

KIP'S BIG NIGHT

» **JASON KIPNIS** provided last night's most critical at-bat, belting a go-ahead, three-run homer with two outs in the top of the 9th inning...marked his fifth career go-ahead homer in the 9th-or-later and his first since a two-run shot in the top of the 9th inning on May 16, 2015 at Texas.

» Three of Kipnis's four home runs this season have come with men on base (two three-run HRs, one two-run HR)...dating back to May 28, 2017, the Indians have won each of their last 12 games in which Kipnis homers (24 of the last 25 dating to July 8, 2016).

» Since May 25, a span of 13 games, Kipnis is batting .308 (16-52) with three homers, three doubles, six runs scored and eight RBI.

YONDER APPRECIATED

» **YONDER ALONSO** paced the Tribe offense in last night's victory, going 3-for-4 with an RBI-double that plated Cleveland's first run...marked his third three-hit performance of 2018, as well as his 12th multi-hit effort.

» Over his last 15 games, Alonso has posted a .360 batting average (18-50) with two homers, four doubles, 12 RBI and nine runs scored...his 12 RBI since May 22 are T2nd on the Indians and T14th in the American League.

» His RBI-double made him the fifth Tribe batter to reach 35 RBI this season...Cleveland is the only MLB team boasting five batters with 35-or-more RBI, as no other club has more than three such hitters.

YOU ARE THE SUNSHINE OF MY LIFE

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is slated to make his 13th start of 2018 this afternoon...marks his first start against Detroit this season.

» **Clevinger was dominant against the Tigers in 2017, going 4-0 across four starts with a 0.76 ERA (2ER/23.2IP)**...he allowed just one run over 12.0 innings in two starts at Comerica Park, including 6.0 shutout frames in his most recent start here on September 1, 2017 (Game 2).

» Has had success against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2-0 record with a 2.60 ERA (8ER/27.2IP) in four divisional starts.

» Clevinger enters play today ranked 5th in the A.L. with a 2.38 ERA on the road and 6th with a 2.17 ERA in day games.

STARTING STRONG

» The Indians' starting pitching has been an asset throughout the season, and Tribe starters enter play today with a 3.49 ERA (2nd in A.L., 5th in MLB).

» Cleveland has posted 27 starts of 7.0-or-more innings this season, the most in MLB...the club's 39 quality starts in 2018 are 2nd-most in the Major Leagues (Houston - 49).

» Including **TREVOR BAUER**'s 12-strikeout performance last night, Indians starters have recorded 12 starts this season with double-digit strikeouts, T2nd in MLB...Bauer's five starts with double-digit strikeouts are T2nd in MLB, while **COREY KLUBER** is T4th with four such starts.

A NICE RELIEF

» The Tribe bullpen has posted scoreless outings in three of the team's last five games...the Indians are 15-5 this season when the bullpen allows no runs...Cleveland relievers have also struck out 10.6 batters per 9.0 innings over the past 10 games (31K/26.1IP).

» **CODY ALLEN** has converted each of his last seven save attempts, and now ranks T9th in the American League with 12 saves...his 134 career saves sit just five shy of matching **Bob Wickman** (139) for the all-time franchise lead.

SCORE TACTICS

» The Indians enter play tonight with 301 runs scored, 4th-most in the American League (7th in MLB)...their 199 runs since May 1 are the most in MLB.

» Cleveland also ranks 3rd in MLB this season with 90 longballs, trailing only New York-AL (100) and Boston (93)...the Indians and Yankees are the only MLB teams boasting five players with 10-or-more home runs.

» The Tribe also places among MLB leaders with a .440 team slugging percentage (3rd), 214 extra-base hits (4th), a .761 team OPS (4th) and 119 doubles (T8th).

TODAY'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to start the middle tilt of this three-game series in Detroit...will mark his 57th career appearance and 44th start.
 » This afternoon will mark his first appearance of the season vs. Detroit...last faced the Tigers on September 13, 2017 at Progressive Field, earning the win (5.2IP, 6H, 3R, 1ER, 2BB, 6K)...posted a 4-0 mark and 0.76 ERA (2ER/23.2IP) in four starts against the Tigers in 2017.
 » **LAST TIME OUT:** Clevinger will be pitching on extended five days' rest after making his last start on June 3 at Minnesota...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 7-5 loss, after surrendering four runs on seven hits (two home runs), with three walks and three strikeouts over 6.0 innings.
 » Maintains a 2-0 record and 2.60 ERA (8ER/27.2IP) in four starts vs. the A.L. Central division this season.
 » Clevinger has thrown 100-plus pitches in each of his last seven starts, a career-long streak that is the 3rd-longest active run among all Major League starters, behind teammate **Trevor Bauer** (13G) and Washington's **Stephen Strasburg** (8G).
 » Enters today ranking among the American League pitching leaders in road ERA (2.38, 5th) and day ERA (2.17, 6th).

VS. DETROIT | DIVISION RECORD

» Clevinger will make his seventh career appearance and sixth start vs. the Tigers today...has compiled a 4-1 record and 2.28 ERA (7ER/27.2IP) across his prior outings.
 » Won all four of his appearances (all starts) vs. Detroit in 2017, posting a perfect 4-0 record and 0.76 ERA (2ER/23.2IP), with 23 strikeouts and 10 walks in those outings.
 » Last faced the Tigers on September 13, 2017 at Progressive Field, tossing 5.2 strong innings and allowing three runs (one earned), with two walks and six strikeouts.
 » Has won his last four starts vs. the Tigers, dating back to July 2, 2017...his four-decision win streak vs. Detroit is tied for his longest such streak against a single opponent, alongside a similar active streak against **Kansas City**.
 » His 2.28 career ERA vs. Detroit is his second-lowest against any A.L. Central opponent, behind a 2.17 ERA (9ER/37.1IP) vs. **Kansas City**.
 » Will make his fifth start of the season against an A.L. Central division opponent today...has compiled a 2-0 record and 2.60 ERA (8ER/27.2IP) across his four prior starts...marks just his second outing vs. a divisional opponent on the road, with his first such outing coming in his last start on June 3 at Minnesota.
 » Owns a career mark of 10-5 with a 3.09 ERA (39ER/113.2IP) in 26 intradivisional outings, including 19 starts.

ON THE ROAD

» Clevinger will make his sixth road start of the season today...two of his four wins this season have come on the road, where he is 2-1 with a 2.38 ERA (9ER/34.0IP) in five outings...his 2.38 road ERA is significantly lower than his 4.12 ERA (20ER/43.2IP) at Progressive Field.
 » Won his first start of the year on April 2 at Los Angeles-AL, tossing 5.1 shutout innings (4H, 2BB, 5K)...threw his first career complete-game shutout at Baltimore on April 21...did not factor into the decision on May 6 at New York-AL despite striking out a career-high 10 batters...his start on May 18 at Houston marks his lone road loss so far this year and he has not won a road decision since his CGSO on April 21 at Baltimore.
 » In 2017, went 7-3 with a 2.45 ERA (17ER/62.1IP) in 12 games (11 starts) on the road...owns a 10-6 career road mark and 3.41 ERA (46ER/121.1IP) in 26 appearances (21 starts).

COMPLETE CLEVINGER

» **Clevinger tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...**...held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts.
 » His two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since **Carlos Carrasco** allowed one hit in a CGSO at **Kansas City** on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).
 » Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1 innings pitched on April 8 vs. **Kansas City**.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS & POSTSEASON RECAP

» Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.
 » His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...also finished 4th on the Tribe in wins.
 » Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-86) batting average...became the first CLE pitcher since **John Denny** in 1981 with three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.
 » **Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.**
 » Began the season with Triple-A Columbus and spent three stints with the Indians (May 7-June 6, June 17, June 22-end)...ranked 5th in the International League in ERA at the time of his first recall on May 7...in seven starts with the Clippers, went 3-2 with a 2.65 ERA (10ER/34.0IP).
 » **POSTSEASON:** Appeared in relief in Games 2 & 4 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees...allowed two earned runs on one hit (1HR) in 0.2 innings (2BB, 2K) in the Tribe's 9-8 victory in Game 2 at Progressive Field...tossed 0.2 innings again in Game 4 in The Bronx (1H, 1R, 2BB, 1K), as the Indians lost 7-3.
 » Has no record and a 6.43 ERA (5ER/7.0IP) in six career Postseason appearances.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Clevinger is in his fourth season in the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College (FL)...acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever **Vinnie Pestano** on Aug. 7, 2014...added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.
 » Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by **Baseball America**...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).
 » Made his Major League debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win over the Reds...struck out **Joey Votto** in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA 31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.
 » **Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...**went 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).
