NATIONALS NEWS

THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY

The Washington Nationals scored a franchise record (MON/WSH) 25 runs on a Nationals record (2005-pres.) 26 hits en route to the 25-4 win over the New York Mets on Tuesday night...The 21-run margin of victory was a franchise mark and the largest differential in the Major Leagues since Philadelphia topped Cincinnati, 22-1 on July 6, 2009.

- Washington became the 17th team in Major League history (since 1900) to score at least 25 runs in a game...The 25 runs were the most in a Major League game since Texas topped Baltimore, 30-3 on Aug. 22, 2007.
- According to *Stats Inc.*, the 25 runs were the most by a team without a DH since Aug. 18, 1995 when the Chicago Cubs scored 26 at Colorado...Washington also became the first non-DH team to have all starters score multiple runs since the New York Yankees on May 24, 1936 against the Philadelphia Athletics.
- The Nationals clubbed 12 extra-base hits (5 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR), their most in a single game this season and tied for the second-most by a team in MLB in 2018.

MURPH IS MASHING

Daniel Murphy recorded his first multi-home run game of the season on Tuesday night...He clubbed a two-run shot in the second inning and a three-run blast in the third...He recorded a career-high six RBI, as well.

- In 17 games dating to July 8, **Daniel Murphy** is 22-for-53 (.415) with a .475 on-base percentage (22 H, 7 BB) and a .660 slugging percentage (4 2B, 3 HR)...He has struck out just six times over this stretch.
- Murphy has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games, going 14-for-36 (.389) with two doubles, three homers, 13 RBI, three walks and five runs scored.
- In 43 games against his former club, Murphy is hitting .391 with 13 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 43 RBI, 16 walks and 30 runs scored.

STATS ABOUT SOTO

With 13 home runs as a teenager, **Juan Soto** is tied with H.O.F. **Mickey Mantle** (1951) for the sixth-most home runs by a teenager in Major League history...Next on the list is H.O.F. **Ken Griffey Jr.** who hit 16 during the 1989 season...Only nine players in MLB history have hit at least 10 home runs during their teenage years.

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 255 PA), in batting average (.313), on-base percentage (.418), slugging percentage (.567), and OPS (.985).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies this season in home runs (2nd, 13), walks (3rd, 39), runs (3rd, 43), RBI (5th, 36), hits (5th, 68) and doubles (T5th, 14).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in on-base percentage (3rd, .418), runs scored (T6th, 43), slugging percentage (7th, .567), walks (T8th, 39), home runs (T8th, 13) and batting average (8th, .313).
- Among all National League hitters (min. 255 PA) in 2018, he ranks in OPS (1st, .985), on-base percentage (2nd, .418), batting average (6th, .313) and slugging percentage (8th, .567).

EATON'S HEATIN'

Adam Eaton has reached base safely in 13 of his last 16 games...During this 16-game stretch, he is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with three doubles, one homer, six RBI, two HBP, 10 walks, two stolen bases and 10 runs scored...He has a .426 on-base percentage during this stretch.

- In 23 games dating to June 29, he is hitting .317 (26-for-82) with a .429 on-base percentage (26 H, 14 BB)...He has reached base safely in 19 of the 23 games.
- Since June 29, Eaton ranks third in the National League in on-base percentage (.429).

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper's 25 home runs are tied for second in the National League and are first among all National League outfielders...His 40 extra-base hits are tied for sixth among National League outfielders...Harper's 84 walks pace the National League.

BULL-PENNINGS

Since July 9, Washington's bullpen ranks second in the National League and third in Major League Baseball with a 2.61 ERA (14 ER/48.1 IP).

- On the season, Nationals relievers rank in the National League in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 2.89), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 2.99), WHIP (3rd, 1.20), and hits per 9.0 IP (6th, 7.89).
- Nationals relievers have allowed just 24.8 percent of inherited runners to score (31-for-125), the second-best mark in the National League and fourth-best mark in Major League Baseball.

NATIONALS HISTORY

August 1 (5-7 on this date)

2009 – **Cristian Guzman** went 2-for-5 with a double and RBI in an 11-6 loss at Pittsburgh. In doing so, Guzman tallied two or more hits and at least one RBI in a franchise-record (Montreal/Washington) seven straight games from July 24-August 1.

IN THE COMMUNITY

August 4: Harris Teeter Food Drive

The Nationals will collect non-perishable food items for the annual Harris Teeter Food Drive outside Center Field Gate on August 4 and 5. Fans who donate at least four items will receive two tickets to a Nationals home game (while supplies last). All items collected benefit the Capital Area Food Bank. Donation collections will begin three hours before first pitch.

NEW YORK METS

Nationals second baseman **Daniel Murphy** spent seven seasons (2008-15) with the New York Mets...Washington's hitting coach **Kevin Long** served as New York's hitting coach from 2015-17 and bench coach **Chip Hale** served as their third base coach from 2010-11.

THE SERIES

The Nationals and Mets will play 19 times in 2018 (9 in D.C., 10 in N.Y.)...The series returns to Nationals Park for the first time since April 5-8.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#46 - TOMMY MILONE - LHP

A veteran of seven Major League seasons joined the Nationals as a non-roster invite to 2018 Major League Spring Training...Milone returns to the organization that drafted him in 2008 and developed him into a Major Leaguer in 2011...Was dealt to Oakland in Dec. 2011 in the package that returned Gio Gonzalez...Went on to appear in 141 games, making 121 starts for Oakland, Minnesota, Milwaukee and the New York Mets.

AGAINST THE METS: Faces the Mets for the first time since 2011, when he was a member of the Washington Nationals...Went 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA in two starts against him in his rookie campaign...He appeared in 11 games (five starts) for New York in 2017, going 0-3 with an 8.56 ERA.

LAST START: Made his 2018 Major League season debut on July 26 at Miami...Allowed three earned runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings of work as the Nationals topped the Marlins, 10-3...Struck out six batters without issuing a walk.

2018 NOTES

- Began the season with Triple-A Syracuse...Made 20 starts, going 7-4 with a 4.19 ERA (51 ER/109.2 IP) before having his contract selected on July 26.
- Over his last four Minor League starts, he has pitched to a 1.50 ERA (4 ER/24.0 IP) while holding opponents to a .155 batting average (13-for-84)...He has struck out 26 batters and walked five over this four-game stretch.
- In his 20 starts for Triple-A Syracuse he has struck out 113 batters while issuing just 24 walks in 109.2 innings pitched.
- At the time of the promotion, his 113 strikeouts lead Washington's Minor League system and ranked fourth in the International League...He ranked among International League pitchers in starts (T1st, 20) and WHIP (5th, 1.14).

2017 NOTES

- Began the season with MIL before joining the NYM on May 7.
- Made three starts for NYM before he was placed on the 15-day disabled list with a sprained left knee in May.
- Was activated from the DL on Aug. 19...Made two more starts with the Mets before transitioning into the bullpen.
- Earned his first save since 2015 on April 25 vs. CIN by working the final 3.0 innings.

2016 NOTES

- Went 3-5 with a 5.71 ERA in 19 games (12 starts) with MIN.
- Went 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in seven starts at Triple-A Rochester.
- Was on the 15-day disabled list from Aug. 12-Sept. 8 with left biceps tendinitis.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 12-6 with a 3.22 ERA in 24 starts at Triple-A Syracuse before his contract was selected by WSH on Sept. 3, 2011... Was an International League All-Star...Led the International League in WHIP (1.03) and was among the leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 155), wins (T3rd, 12) and ERA (6th, 3.22)...Finished 1-0 with a 3.81 ERA in five Sept. starts for WSH in first big league action.
- When starting in 2011, the Nationals went a perfect 5-0...In his MLB debut on Sept. 3 vs. NYM, he did not get a decision, but in first big league plate appearance, pulled a three-run homer on the first offering from RHP Dillon Gee...Became the first National (2005-pres.) to hit a homer in first big league plate appearance.
- Earned initial MLB win by tossing 5.2 innings of one-run ball in the Nationals' 10-1 victory on Sept. 15 at NYM.
