VS. TORONTO

The Mariners and Blue Jays meet for the finale (2-4) of 7 games this season...Seattle claimed 2-of-3 earlier this season in Toronto (May 8-10), including James Paxton's no-hitter on May 8...the Mariners are 15-14 vs. Toronto at Safeco Field since 2010:

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners conclude a 2-team, 7-day, 7-game homestand with the finale (0-3) of four games vs. the Toronto Blue Jays...went 1-2 against Houston to open the homestand...following today's game, will embark on a 2-state, 3-city, 10-day, 10-game road trip to Texas (3 G), Houston (4 G) and Oakland (3 G)...today's game will be televised on ROOT SPORTS NW and broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 8-17 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8-game straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 23 of their last 47 games, 30 of their last 56, 34 of their last 62, 39 of their last 68 and 41 of their last 72...Seattle is 50-36 in its last 86 games, 55-39 over its last 94 games and 60-43 in its last 103 games...Seattle is 20-18 during the day and 43-30 at night...Seattle is 35-24 at Safeco Field, 28-24 on the road.

- Whiff** - Edwin Díaz has struck out his first batter faced 24 times this season, trailing only Adam Ottavino-COL (25) for most in the Majors...Díaz has struck out his first batter in 45.3% (24x53) of his appearances this season.
- As Easy as 1-2-3** - Edwin Díaz retired the Astros in order in the 9th inning Monday for his 40th save of the season...in 24 of his 40 saves, he has faced the minimum 3 batters in an outing of exactly 1.0 inning, the most such saves in the Majors...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 17 saves of 1.0 inning and 3 batters faced.
- First Things First** - Dee Gordon is batting .355 (33x93) with 21 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 walk and 2 HBP when leading off a game this season...his 33 hits to lead off a game are the most in the Majors.
- Close Games** - the Mariners are 41-17 (.707) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 27-14 (.659) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 14-3 (.824) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- Four Score** - the Mariners are 44-13 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 19-35 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 3 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (56-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining New York-AL (58-0) and Oakland (53-0).
- Bullpen Bullies** - Edwin Díaz has not allowed an earned run over his last 14.0 innings spanning 14 appearances (6/25-c), while Alex Colomé has an active 12.2 scoreless innings streak over 13 games (6/30-c).

KEEP IT CLOSE...after 3 straight one-run games from July 24-27, 7 of the Mariners last 8 games since July 28 have been decided by at least 3 runs...the Mariners are 2-6 in those 8 games since July 27...when the Mariners play games decided by 2 or fewer runs, they have a .659 (41-17) winning percentage, tops in the Majors.

KEEP THEM OFF THE BOARD...the Mariners have been held to 3 or fewer runs in 18 of their last 23 games dating back to July 6...over the last 23 games, Seattle is 7-16...despite the recent stretch, the Mariners have the 2nd-best record in the Majors when limited to 3 or fewer runs at 19-35 (.352), trailing only Colorado (16-28/.364)...the Mariners have the Majors' best record when scoring 2 or fewer runs at 11-24 (.314).

START AT THE BIG INNING...since July 24, the Mariners have scored a run in 24 of 98 innings with an at-bat...in those 24 innings with at least 1 run scored, the Mariners have been held to 2 runs or fewer 22 times: exactly 1 run 19 times, exactly 2 runs 3 times, 3 runs once and 7 runs once...the Mariners scored 3 runs in the 8th on July 28 at Los Angeles-AL and 7 runs in the 1st on July 29 at the Angels.

HIT MACHINE...Jean Segura has reached base safely in 11 of his last 14 games vs. the Blue Jays, including 7 multi-hit contests, batting .350 (21x60) with 8 runs scored, 6 doubles, 1 RBI, 4 walks and 3 stolen bases...since 2016, Segura's .350 average vs. the Jays is the 8th-highest in the Majors, trailing Josh Reddick (.404/19x47), Logan Forsythe (.400/26x65), José Altuve (.387/20x52), Melky Cabrera (.378/17x45), Albert Pujols (.373/31x83), Francisco Lindor (.356/26x73) and Mike Trout (.354/28x79).

STREAKING...Alex Colomé has an active season-high 12.2 scoreless innings streak...during this stretch, dating back to June 30, he is 1-0 with 9 holds in 13 relief appearances...he has limited opponents to a .213 (10x47) average, while walking 4 and striking out 16...his 12.2 scoreless innings streak is the 9th-longest active streak in the Majors, while also ranking the 5th-longest by a Mariners pitcher this season...his active scoreless inning streak is the 3rd-longest in his career, trailing only a 21.2 innings streak (16 G, 8/4-9/5/15) and a 21.0 innings streak (19 G, 5/4-6/15/16).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ FILE...Edwin Díaz recorded his Major League-leading 40th save of the season on Monday...he becomes the 4th pitcher in single-season club history to notch at least 40 saves, joining Fernando Rodney (48, 2014), Kazuhiro Sasaki (45, 2001) and J.J. Putz (40, 2007)...Díaz has 87 strikeouts this season, 3 shy of setting a single-season career-high; he had 89 strikeouts last season after recording 88 punchouts in his rookie campaign of 2016 (appeared in 49 games after being called up to the Majors in June)...with his next strikeout, Díaz will join Dick Radatz (1962-64 w/BOS) as the only primary relievers in Major League history to record at least 88 strikeouts in each of their first 3 seasons.

WHAT A RELIEF...the Mariners lead the Major Leagues in saves (42) and rank 3rd in holds (78)...since 1973, only 6 clubs have led the Majors in saves and holds in the same season, most recently the 1992 Oakland Athletics...Edwin Díaz leads the Majors with 40 saves, while Juan Nicasio is T9th in MLB with 19 holds, and Alex Colomé is T11th with 18 holds.

ELECTRIC EDDIE...Edwin Díaz leads the Majors with 40 saves, while ranking 2nd among all relievers with 87 strikeouts (Josh Hader-MIL, 99)...of Díaz's 40 saves, 21 have come in 1-run games, most in the Majors this season (Craig Kimbrel-BOS, 12, and Blake Treinen-OAK, 12)...his 21 1-run saves are only 2 shy of equaling the Major League single-season record, set by Francisco Rodriguez in 2008 (23)...the Mariners are 48-0 when Díaz enters with a lead this season, including 23-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead...Díaz is 21-for-23 in 1-run save opportunities (91.3%) with a 0.77 ERA (2 ER, 23.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 5 walks.

AS YOU KNOW...Nelson Cruz has hit 154 home runs in 4 seasons with the Mariners...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that Cruz's 154 home runs trail only one Mariners player for the most homers in any 4-year span?...Cruz trails only Hall of Famer Ken Griffey Jr., who had 4 separate 4-year spans of at least 162 home runs: 209 (1996-1999), 179 (1997-99, 2009), 178 (1995-98) and 162 (1994-97)...Cruz ranks ahead of Griffey's 151 homers from 1993-96 and Alex Rodriguez's 148 homers from 1997-2000...STATS LLC.

ABOUT LEAKE...

- Michael Raymond Leake.
- 30-year-old right-hander is making his 22nd start of the season, 27th Mariners start, 260th career appearance (255th career start) and 4th career appearance/start vs. Toronto today.
- A native of San Diego, California, graduated from Fallbrook (CA) High School.
- Played in 3 seasons (2007-09) at Arizona State University... went 16-1 with a 1.71 ERA (27 ER, 142.0 IP) with 162 strikeouts and 24 walks in 19 games (18 starts) in his junior season (2009), earning *Baseball America* First-Team All-American, Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and First-Team All-Pac-12.
- Selected by Oakland in 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft...did not sign.
- Selected and signed by Cincinnati out of the 1st round (8th overall pick) in the 2009 MLB Draft.
- Is 10-13 with a 5.21 ERA (129 ER, 222.2 IP) in 39 career G (37 GS) in August.

LAST OUTING...took the loss despite a quality start as the Mariners fell 2-5 to the Astros on July 31...allowed 3 runs on 8 hits and 0 walks while striking out 4 across 6.0 innings pitched...held Houston scoreless until the 5th inning before allowing 1 run to score on an RBI single by Josh Reddick...the Astros would plate 2 more runs on a homer by Evan Gattis in the top of hte 6th inning.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY...10 of his last 13 starts (5/22-c) have been quality starts, including 3 outings of 8.0 innings while allowing 2-or-fewer earned runs...his 42.0 innings pitched in June were tied with Jacob deGrom-NYM for most in the Majors...among ML starters, only **James Paxton** (43.0 IP in May) has tossed more innings in a single calendar month this season.

GOING FOR DISTANCE...his 3 starts this season of at least 8.0 innings pitched and 2-or-fewer runs allowed (5/27 vs. MIN, 6/7 at TB and 6/23 at BOS) are T3rd-most in the Majors (8 others), trailing only Trevor Bauer-CLE (4) and Max Scherzer-WAS (4).

GETTING LOOSE...through Leake's first 25 pitches in a game, opponents are batting .324 (44x136) with a .361 OBP, but in pitches 26 through 100+, Leake has limited batters to a .258 average (101x391) with a .302 OBP.

GIVE 'EM A CHANCE...has exited 15 of his 22 starts with a lead (12 games) or a tie score (3 games)...in 3 of his other 7 starts, exited trailing 1-3 after 6.0 IP, 0-3 in the 6th inning and 2-3 after 6.0 IP...the Mariners are 14-8 in his 22 starts this season.

HELLO, SEATTLE...since making his Mariners debut on Sept. 1, 2017, is 11-8 with a 3.85 ERA (71 ER, 166.0 IP) in 27 starts (17 quality starts)...during that span, Leake leads Mariners starters in innings pitched and quality starts...in 20 of his 27 Mariners starts, Leake has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed 3 or fewer earned runs...the Mariners are 17-10 in Leake starts since his Mariners debut.

STAYING GROUNDED...is ranked 5th in the American League with a ground ball rate of 49.4%, trailing only Lance McCullers Jr.-HOU (55.4%), Dallas Keuchel-HOU (54.4%), Alex Cobb-BAL (50.0%) and Charlie Morton-HOU (49.8%).

TAKING HIS TURN...since making his Major League debut in 2010, has made 255 starts, T12th-most among all pitchers...among all pitchers since 2010, ranks 14th in innings pitched (1580.1).

2017 SEASON RECAP...went 10-13 with a 3.92 ERA (81 ER, 186.0 IP) with 130 strikeouts and 37 walks in 31 starts...was acquired along with cash considerations and international slot money from STL on Aug. 30, 2017 in exchange for minor league infielder Rayder Ascanio...went 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER, 32.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts and 2 walks in 5 starts with Seattle.

DURABLE...made 30 starts in each of the past 6 seasons...is one of 4 pitchers in the Major Leagues to make at least 30 starts in every season from 2012-17, joining Jon Lester, Max Scherzer and Ian Kennedy.

GOING FOR DISTANCE...recorded 3 starts in 2017 of at least 8.0 IP and 1-or-fewer runs allowed (4/7 vs. CIN, 5/24 at LAD and 6/30 vs. WAS)...only 6 pitchers in MLB made more such starts last season (Corey Kluber, 8, Chris Sale, 4, Carlos Martinez, 4, Zach Greinke, 4, Jacob deGrom, 4 and Carlos Carrasco, 4).

QUICK RISE...became the 21st player since the MLB Draft began in 1965 to appear in the Major Leagues before playing in a minor league game (last: Xavier Nady, SD, 2000)...became just the 13th pitcher to reach the Majors before appearing in the minor leagues (last: Ariel Prieto, Oakland, 1995)...made his MLB debut on April 11, 2010 vs. Chicago-NL with Cincinnati after being selected by the Reds with the 8th overall pick in the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft...appeared in 6 games (5 starts) with the Peoria Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League in 2009.

CAREER...has appeared in 9 Major League seasons with Cincinnati (2010-15), San Francisco (2015), St. Louis (2016-17) and Seattle (2017-c)...has a career record of 91-84 with a 4.00 ERA (702 ER, 1580.1 IP) with 1,066 strikeouts and 371 walks in 260 career games (255 starts)...made his Major League debut in a start on April 11, 2010 vs. Chicago-NL with Cincinnati...selected by Oakland in the 7th round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft but did not sign...selected and signed by Cincinnati in the 1st round (8th overall pick) of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Arizona State University.
