ONE AND DONE

» The Indians were shut out yesterday by the Royals, falling by a 1-0 final score.

» Marked the first time the Tribe was shut out since July 14, 2017 at Oakland (5-0 loss)...also was Indians' first 1-0 loss since July 4, 2017 vs. San Diego.

» **TREVOR BAUER** was sharp in his second outing of the season, holding the Royals hitless through 4.2 innings and tossing 8.0 innings total (3H, 1R/ER, 2BB, 7K, 100 pitches).

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** and **FRANCISCO LINDOR** each recorded a pair of hits, marking the second game this season in which more than one Tribe batter recorded a multi-hit effort...the Indians have had just six total multi-hit games this year, tied with Kansas City for the fewest by any MLB team so far.

» **Encarnacion's** first hit snapped an 0-for-13 skid, and **Lindor's** double in the 6th marked his first extra-base hit of the season.

RUBBER ROUNDUP

» The Indians are 0-2 in rubber matches so far in 2018, falling 5-4 on April 1 at Seattle and 3-2 on April 4 at Los Angeles-AL.

» In 2017, Tribe went 36-18 overall in series finales and 19-8 in home series finales...Tribe also had a 10-6 record in rubber games, including a 6-4 mark at home.

ROYAL REVIEW

» Yesterday's loss vs. Kansas City dropped the Tribe's record to 13-8 (.619) over the Royals since the beginning of last season (8-4 at home in that span)...since Terry Francona became Tribe manager in 2013, the Indians own a 56-41 (.577) record vs. KC...the Indians will host the Royals again in the next meeting between the clubs, a three-game set from May 11-13.

» Dating back to August 18, 2017, Tribe pitching has held the Royals to two runs or fewer in 10 of their last 13 matchups...the Indians staff has posted a 1.77 ERA (23ER/117.0IP) in that stretch.

STREAKY CLEAN DEFENSE

» The Cleveland defense committed its first error of the season in yesterday afternoon's contest, a throwing miscue by **ROBERTO PÉREZ** in the 5th, snapping a seven-game errorless streak.

» **The Indians' seven-game errorless streak to start the season marked the club's longest such streak in the Baseball Reference Play Index era, since 1908.**

» Seven errorless games also tied the club's longest streak of 2017...last year, Cleveland's 76 errors were the second-fewest in MLB, behind Miami (73)...Tribe also led the American League and ranked 3rd in MLB with a .9869 fielding percentage (76E/5845 TC).

CLOSE CALLS

» The Tribe has been embroiled in a number of close contests this season, as six of the first eight games of the season have been decided by one run.

» In 2017, the Indians played in 35 one-run games, posting a record of 20-15 (.571)...thus far in 2018, the Indians are 2-4 in such contests...Cleveland's six one-run ballgames already this season rank as the most in MLB.

LOOKING FOR A SPARK

» After recording 10-or-more hits in 59 games last season (51-8 in those contests), the Indians are one of just three teams in MLB (also Kansas City and Tampa Bay) yet to reach double digits in the 2018 campaign.

» The Indians rank last in MLB with a .161 team average (43-for-267) and 29th with 43 hits...they rank T8th in the American League with eight home runs this season, while they lead the A.L. with nine steals (T2nd in MLB).

TODAY'S TRANSACTION

» The Indians placed **LONNIE CHISENHALL** on the 10-day disabled list with a right calf strain and recalled **TYLER NAQUIN** from Triple-A Columbus.

» Chisenhall left yesterday's game in the 2nd inning...missed nearly two months last season with that same ailment.

» Naquin was the Tribe's Opening Day starter in left field and had two hits (1HR) in 12 at-bats prior to being sent to Columbus on Friday when **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** was activated from the D.L.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1975:** Frank Robinson becomes the first African-American manager in MLB history, guiding the Indians to a 5-3 win over the Yankees at Cleveland Municipal Stadium...Robinson batted second and served as designated hitter in his managerial debut, hitting a solo homer in his first at-bat as Tribe player-manager...this historic moment is immortalized with a statue of Robinson in Heritage Park at Progressive Field, which was dedicated on May 27, 2017...Robinson's #20 was also retired that afternoon...he was also inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1982, as a player.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» This series vs. Kansas City and the Tribe's subsequent four-game set against Detroit serve as the beginning of the Tribe's 76-game slate against divisional foes.

» Success against the A.L. Central has proven critical to Cleveland's consecutive division championships...after posting a club-high 49 intra-divisional wins in 2016 (49-26 .653), the Tribe broke that record last season, going 50-26 (.658) in divisional matchups.

» Cleveland enters play today tied for 4th place in the A.L. Central, 1.5 games behind leader Minnesota (4-3).

COLD AS ICE, TAKE TWO

» Yesterday's 34-degree first pitch marked the coldest first-pitch temperature since the 2016 home opener vs. Boston (also 34 degrees)...the predicted high today is 33 degrees, and per today's hourly forecast, the expected temperature at 1:10PM is 32 degrees, which would make it the coldest regular-season game in Progressive Field history...the current coldest is 33 degrees, recorded on April 5 & 7, 1996 vs. Toronto.

» Since 1994, the Tribe is 11-7 at home in games with a first-pitch temperature under 40 degrees, and 14-10 overall...however, the club has struggled in sub-35 degree weather, going 4-5 at home and 5-7 overall.

» The 2018 MLB season has begun on a rather cold foot...overall, there have been 17 games with a first-pitch temperature of 40 degrees or colder, including two games with 27-degree temperatures (April 6, ATL at COL and April 8, SEA at MIN).

HOME COOKING

» Last year, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» **Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 29-9 (.763) at home, including wins in 18 of their past 22 regular-season games here.**

» In the Tribe's last 21 games vs. divisional foes, they own a 16-5 (.762) record, allowing two-or-fewer runs in 16 of those contests.

SUNSHINE SUNDAY

» The Indians will send **MIKE CLEVINGER** to the mound in the rubber game of this three-game set...will mark the 27-year-old's second start of the season.

» Clevinger dominated Los Angeles-AL in his season debut on April 2, shutting out the Angels for 5.1 innings and allowing just four hits while striking out five batters.

» Dating back to August 26, 2017, has won four of his last five home decisions, across three starts and three relief appearances.

» Clevinger's first start of 2017 on May 7 was the rubber game of a three-game series against Kansas City...held the Royals to one hit over 5.1 innings, as the Tribe won the game 1-0 and the series 2-1...**overall, started three rubber games last season, all on the road, going 3-0 with a 1.62 ERA (3ER/16.2IP) against Kansas City (May 7), Baltimore (June 22) and Detroit (July 2).**

MISC. BATTING NOTES

» Today is **YONDER ALONSO's** 31st birthday...has played in five games at the Major League level on his birthday and hit safely in all five, batting .421 (8-for-19) with a home run, two doubles and three RBI...also owns a .455 on-base percentage, .684 slugging percentage and 1.139 OPS on his birthday.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play today with 499 career hits, looking to become the 7th current Indians player to reach the 500-hit milestone...his 364 hits since the start of 2016 are 2nd-most on the Indians, behind **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (367).

LOOKING AHEAD | DETROIT SERIES PREVIEW

» Rock and Motown meet again starting tomorrow, as the Detroit Tigers come to Progressive Field for a four-game series this week, April 9-12...marks the first four of 19 total matchups between the A.L. Central rivals.

» Tribe went 13-6 against the Tigers in 2017 and won the season series in consecutive years for the first time since 2007-2008...overall Cleveland is 1084-1118 (.492) against Detroit in a series that dates back to 1901.

TODAY'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to close out this weekend series this afternoon against Kansas City...will mark his 46th career appearance and 33rd career start.
 » Will be pitching on extended five days' rest after making his season debut on April 2 at Los Angeles-AL, the organization that originally drafted him in 2011.
 » Won his first start of the year, holding the Angels to four hits across 5.1 shutout innings and striking out five while walking two batters...marked his eighth career start with 5.0-plus shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed.
 » Faces the Royals today for the sixth time, making his fifth start...has compiled a 3-0 record and 2.42 ERA (6ER/22.1IP) across his prior appearances against Cleveland's A.L. Central division rival.
 » **Two of his four career starts and his relief appearance against the Royals have all been scoreless, and his 2.42 career ERA against Kansas City is his second-lowest against a divisional opponent, behind his 2.28 ERA against Detroit.**

LAST TIME OUT IN L.A.

» Clevinger dominated in his season debut on April 2 at Los Angeles-AL, tossing 5.1 shutout innings and allowing just four hits while striking out five batters and walking one.
 » **Marked the 8th start of his career in which he tossed 5.0-plus shutout innings and allowed fewer than four hits**...had seven such starts last season, including May 20 at Houston and August 12 at Tampa Bay, both 3-0 wins in which he tossed a career-best 7.0 innings.

VS. KANSAS CITY | A.L. CENTRAL SUCCESS

» This afternoon's start against Kansas City will represent Clevinger's fifth start and sixth appearance against them...owns an overall record of 3-0 and a 2.42 ERA (6ER/22.1IP) against the Royals.
 » Clevinger's three wins vs. Kansas City are his second-most against any team in the A.L. Central, behind his four career victories against Detroit.
 » Started three times against the Royals in 2017, posting a 2-0 record and 2.16 ERA (4ER/16.2IP) in those outings...his first start of 2017 was a 1-0 win over Kansas City on May 7, in which he allowed one hit over 5.2 shutout innings (4BB, 5K)...did not factor into the decision in his next start against them on May 26 (5.0IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...**tied his career high with nine strikeouts in his final start against Kansas City on August 26, holding the Royals to four hits in 6.0 shutout innings.**
 » Went 7-3 against the A.L. Central in 2017, with a 2.13 ERA (13ER/55IP) in 13 games (9 starts)...four of his six victories during his career-long six-game win streak (Aug. 26-Sept. 27) came against a divisional opponent.
 » Overall in his career, is 8-5 with a 3.24 ERA (31ER/86IP) in 22 appearances (15 starts) against division rivals.

AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD

» Clevinger went 5-3 with a 3.79 ERA (25ER/59.1IP) in 15 games (10 starts) at Progressive Field last season...owns a 7-4 record and 3.71 ERA (36ER/87.1IP) overall at home.
 » Last three appearances at home have been in relief, on Sept. 26, Sept. 27 and Sept. 30 of last season.
 » Most recent start at home was Sept. 13, 2017, in which he led the Tribe to a 5-3 win over Detroit, tossing 5.2 innings and allowing three runs (one earned) on six hits, with six strikeouts.
 » Entering his first start of the season on April 2, had pitched the same number of innings at home as away from Cleveland...that tally now stands at 87.1IP at home and 92.2IP on the road.

SUNSHINE IN SPRING

» Clevinger went 2-0 with a 3.79 ERA (8ER/19.0IP) in six Cactus League starts (12H, 4HR, 4BB, 25K).
 » **His 25 strikeouts marked a new Spring Training career best, and ranked T2nd on the Tribe (with Corey Kluber) and T4th in the Cactus League, as well as T7th in MLB**...his six starts ranked T3rd among Arizona-based pitchers and T5th in MLB.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.
 » **His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th**...also finished 4th on the Tribe in wins.
 » Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on May 20 at Houston, a feat he went on to replicate on August 12 at Tampa Bay...**struck out nine batters on June 27 against Texas, a new career best**...matched his strikeout feat again on Aug. 12 at Tampa Bay and Aug. 26 vs. Kansas City.
 » Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-for-86) batting average...also became the first Indians pitcher since John Denny in 1981 to have three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.
 » **Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.**
 » Made three appearances out of the bullpen to end the season, from September 26-30 (3.2IP, 3H, 1ER, 4K).
 » Began the season with Triple-A Columbus and spent three stints with the Indians (May 7-June 6, June 17, June 22-end)...ranked 5th in the International League in ERA at the time of his first recall on May 7...in seven starts with the Clippers, went 3-2 with a 2.65 ERA (10ER/34.0IP).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Clevinger is in his fourth season with the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College of Florida...**acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever Vinnie Pestano on Aug. 7, 2014**...was added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.
 » Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by *Baseball America*...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).
 » Made his Major League debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win over the Reds...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA (31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.
 » **Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015**...had a breakout season, going 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).
