The Brewers are going for their sixth sweep of the season and their third at home.....a victory today would mark the first sweep of the Twins since the Brewers took a 3-game series in Milwaukee from 6/24-6/26, 2011.

Milwaukee 5-0

The Brewers recorded their 50th win of the season with a 2-0 victory over the Twins yesterday.....Milwaukee is the first team to reach 50 wins in the National League this year.....the 2018 Brewers are tied with the 1982 squad for the second-fastest team in franchise history to reach 50 wins, doing so in their 85th game.....the 2014 Brewers recorded their 50th win in their 82nd game.

Sweet 16

With a win today, the Brewers would be 16 games over .500 for the first time since 8/19, 2014, when the team owned a record of 71-55.

Let's Go Streaking!

The Brewers have hit a home run in a season-high 9 consecutive games.....the team has smashed 14 home runs in that span.

RHP Jhoulys Chacín will make his 19th start of the season.....Chacín last started last Saturday at Cincinnati and received no decision in the Brewers' 12-3 defeat (5ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 5k).....he left the game with a 3-1 lead.....the team is 12-6 in his starts.....he has 5 quality starts.....opponents are batting .243 (87-for-358, 7hr).....he is 1-4 with a 3.94 ERA in 6 career starts (32ip, 14er) against the Braves, including 0-2 with a 3.75 ERA in 2 starts last season (12ip, 5er).
