SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The Padres have won four straight games for the first time this season...the last time the club has won four-or-more straight games was when they won four in a row from July 26-29, 2017.
- Brett Kennedy earned his first career major league win, tossing a career-high 6.0 innings...he and Robert Stock are the first Padre rookies to record their first major league wins in back-to-back games since Clay Condrey and Doug Nickle (Aug. 31-Sept. 1, 2002).
 - In the past four games, Padres rookie starters (Nix, Lucchesi, Lauer and Kennedy) have combined for a 0.69 ERA, allowing 18 hits and two earned runs in 26.0 IP.
- Luis Urías recorded his first career major league home run.
- **Franmil Reyes** belted his second homer in as many games...is riding a six-game hitting streak, batting .438 (7-for-16) with four home runs in that time.
 - o His home run in the fourth inning had an exit velocity of 114.1 mph.
- **Wil Myers** tallied his 10th home run of the season and first since July 22 at PHI...his .624 SLG vs. COL is his highest against any one club and his 15 homers, 42 RBI and three triples are the most he's had against any team.
- **Travis Jankowski** has hit in 14-straight games in which he's started since July 31, the longest hitting streak of his career (.345, 19-for-55) and the longest hitting streak by a Padre this season in a starting role.
- **Hunter Renfroe** is riding a career high eight game hitting streak, batting .353 (12-for-34) over that time with two doubles, three home runs and nine RBI since August 23 at COL.
- Rowan Wick made his major league debut, striking out the side on eight pitches.

- The Rockies have gone 25.0 innings without an extra base hit and have lost five of their last seven games.
- Antonio Senzatela pitched his third quality start of the season and has worked at least 5.0 innings in seven of his eight games started this year...owns a 4-1 record and 3.55 ERA (13 ER, 33.0 IP) in 10 career games, four starts vs. the Padres.
- **Charlie Blackmon** recorded his 42nd multi-hit game of the season...is batting .322 (19-for-59) this year against SD with two doubles, a triple and a home run.
- Trevor Story swiped his 22nd stolen base of the season.
